

When spring is in the air, magic blooms—especially at Epcot®. From March 5–May 18, over 70 Disney Character topiaries along with thousands of gorgeous blooms will return, blanketing Epcot® with the colors of springtime. And back by popular demand, 11 Outdoor Kitchens will serve up an assortment of delectable dishes.

Epcot® Food & Beverage Executive Chef Jens
Dahlmann loves how well cuisine is such a perfect
addition to the festival. "It's about flowers, but it's
also about gardening, growing your own vegetables, cooking fresh from the garden and preserving.
I love outdoor living, barbecuing, spring festivals and
celebrating the seasons."

Fan favorites will return, like shrimp and grits, watermelon salad with pickled onions and the smoked pig slider complete with coleslaw and homemade sauces. All three are Jens' favorite festival picks.





There will also be several exciting new things in store, too. Get set for Kumquat Pie, a fruity treat that makes its debut this year, along with the whimsical flair of Piggylicious Bacon Cupcakes. "There will also be a new Outdoor Kitchen that features a garden-to-table concept showcasing ingredients that are easy to grow at home," added Jens. "All the food will be outstanding, freshly cooked and completely delicious."

University and much more. "Mike and Sulley will be featured, attracting kids young and old
to the garden and the adjoining play area," said Eric Darden, Manager of

"There will also be a Florida fresh garden featuring different crops from around the state."

To add to the fun, Kermit and Miss Piggy will make their grand debut as the festival's newest Character topiaries (see page 6).

Overall, Eric told us that the Character topiaries are the biggest draw to the festival. With that in mind, they will be getting a makeover this year—so to speak. The topiaries will look even more like their counterparts you know so well from real life.

"This will make all the garden areas—especially the entrance of the Park—even more inviting," Eric said. "Goofy will be there with a butterfly net.

Joining him will be Minnie—and her hair bow of ladybugs—along with Daisy holding a butterfly." Many favorites will return too, like Tinker Bell's Butterfly House, the English Tea Garden and Disney Pixar's Cars

Playground and Backyard Play Garden. You never know which of your favorite Characters you'll see growing next!

Enjoying a pleasant walk and a pleasant talk with the hit-making Herman's Hermits pop legend

"I can't imagine a better place to go in the spring than here, with all the flowers and all," pop music legend Peter Noone told us.

Peter, lead singer for Herman's Hermits—the chart-topping band whose hits include the #1 smashes "I'm Henry VIII, I Am" and "Mrs. Brown, You've Got a Lovely Daughter"—loves to explore Epcot® each day he headlines at the Flower Power Concert Series during the Epcot® International Flower & Garden Festival.

"I get up in the morning every day and walk around the Park six or seven times before the show," he explained in his delightful Manchester, England, accent. "I walk into the Park along with the other Guests. I'll eat at United Kingdom, France or Morocco. Then I just walk up [to America Gardens Theatre] and do the show. It's a friendly atmosphere. At Epcot®, people are more than fans, they're like friends."

Peter Noone and Herman's Hermits get new fans every day. "Our band actually sold more records last year than we've sold since 1967. We do family-friendly music. There may have been times when that wasn't considered 'cool,' but we're still here and still going!"




It's time to trim the branches, Each leaf and every twig, It's time for topiaries with the frog and with the pig!

To create them, artists designed the Characters especially for the topiary design by Walt Disney Parks & Resorts Horticulture. Small models, or maquettes, were sculpted for use as reference while creating the wire frame upon which the materials would be intertwined, trimmed and lovingly transformed into magical shrubberies to rival Kermit's favorite color.









From the Dwarfs' cottage, you will find yourself on a rollicking, musical ride where a million diamonds shine. It's fast but family-friendly, and includes a one-of-a-kind train where the cars will rock from side to side as you explore the mine!

You can run! You can walk! You can run!

Olympic Medalist Jeff Galloway has been running for over 55 years, but you don't have to be an elite athlete to run one of the Walt Disney World® 5K or 10K races, half marathons or full marathons. As a Passholder, you can take advantage of early Passholder entry dates, too!

GOOFY MYTH: People really shouldn't run long distances.

JEFF GALLOWAY: According to anthropologists, that is how we survived. The need for running and walking are embedded in our genetics and biomechanics. By gradually going from walking into running—and adding walk breaks—you can adapt, rebuild and become more efficient at any age. The simple training plan of walking breaks during a run greatly reduces body stress and the risk of injury.

GOOFY MYTH: You need Jack Skellington's physique to run a race.

JEFF: At the *Walt Disney World* Marathon and other events, you'll see all kinds of body shapes. Anyone starting an exercise program MUST check with their physician first and then get the proper training. That's where run/walk/run comes in. It allows the cardiovascular system to gradually adapt without becoming overstressed.

GOOFY MYTH: Running is bad for your joints.

JEFF: Neither I nor my orthopedic consultants could find a single study proving that running harms your joints. That applies to everyone, including folks who might not resemble what some might perceive as the typical runner.

GOOFY MYTH: Running means sprinting until you can't stand it.

JEFF: That wasn't even done in the first Olympic marathon in history. At the 1896 Olympic marathon in Athens, all the competitors walked for significant portions.

GOOFY MYTH: Running through Disney Parks is no big deal.

JEFF: Not only do you see a lot of the main **Walt Disney World** locations, you also see really interesting, behind-the-scenes glimpses that most never see. Nighttime races offer yet a different kind of magic. It's like getting a special key to the kingdom.

Now...are you as curious as Alice running after the White Rabbit?


