Two representatives of the cruise division of Walt Disney visited Quebec last week. A possible passage of a giant cruise ship does not take place before 2019.

During their visit, these lobbyists met with Mayor Labeaume, the authorities of the Port of Québec and the leaders of the Québec City Tourism. They were also treated to a tour of the main attractions of the city. "A first step has been taken, welcomed Marie-Andrée Blanchet, public relations consultant to the Port of Quebec. We will continue the efforts, but be aware that the competition is strong. "

Long term

The latter added that the cruise lines and itineraries are usually curly two years in advance. So, Quebec can target the year 2019 "at best" to host the Walt Disney ship on the St. Lawrence River. "It's a work in the long term," added Ms. Blanchet.
