A Gem of a Thrill!

Seven Dwarfs Mine Train offers a first-of-its-kind roller coaster experience of incredible delights.

Seven Dwarfs Mine Train opens as the crowning jewel of New Fantasyland™ at Magic Kingdom® Park, soon to give you an exciting glimpse into a glorious mine where a million diamonds shine.

But diamonds aren't the only things that sparkle on this rockin', rollicking roller coaster. There are other surprises in and around the mine to look forward to. So many that Dave Minichiello, Walt Disney Imagineering Creative Director, can't even begin to narrow down the best.

"It's the overall experience," Dave said of the new family roller coaster. "Seeing this amazing story in this new way. Between that and the new ride vehicle...it will surprise and delight.

"The attraction uses a first-of-its-kind ride system that swings left and right as it speeds along the track. The unique movement builds even more excitement with each twist and turn, especially as it travels outside the mine." Inside, the mine cars keep a steady pace to music from the Oscar®-winning Disney classic Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs, which the American Film Institute named the best American animated film of all time.

Your Seven Dwarfs Mine Train adventure begins with three areas to explore before you enter your mine car.

First, you'll help sort jewels by shape and color. The next spot is a jewel-washing area with magical water spigots, followed by the vault where the Dwarfs store their gems.

"The ceiling is covered in jewels," said Dave. "The farther into the mine you go, the more jewels you see."

Then, you'll enter the vault containing a barrel for each of the Seven Dwarfs. If you spin one, Dwarf animation appears. And according to Dave, if you spin all seven at once, there's an extra surprise!


As the interactive areas immerse you in the story, the roller coaster ride itself offers more thrills, taking you through the rolling hills of the countryside toward what appears to be an abandoned mine shaft.


"But somewhere in the mine are the Dwarfs, working," Dave said.

One of the first to be seen is Dopey, who is in a mine car surrounded by a sea of jewels. Sneezy carries a stack of buckets filled with gems when he suddenly feels a sneeze coming on. Happy and Bashful are hard at work while Sleepy dozes on the job, to the chagrin of Grumpy.

Doc is on the platform, measuring the sparkling gems when the clock chimes quitting time. As the roller coaster speeds toward him, Doc bellows his famous "Heigh-Ho!" with the other Dwarfs chiming in, dropping all their tools to head home.

As they march off, the roller coaster prepares to take its last drop, offering one of the most gorgeous aerial views of *Magic Kingdom*. Park, Dave said. It's one of several amazing vantage points from a ride that's sure to make your smile shine, too.







Artistry on Parade

The new *Disney Festival of Fantasy* Parade is here!



Walt Disney believed in a world where imagination comes to life in festive, innovative ways. So when Cast Members set out to create a brand-new *Magic Kingdom* daytime parade, they made sure "magic" was written all over it.

The result is the *Disney Festival of Fantasy* Parade, which just started creating its enchantment on *Main Street, U.S.A.* It's a celebration of imagination that tells beloved Disney stories in a stunning, larger-than-life spectacle.

"We thought that it would be really great if the Characters exploded out of Fantasyland® and said, 'Come to our new land and come help us celebrate!'" said Steven Davison, Creative Director and Vice President of Parades and Spectaculars, Walt Disney Parks and Resorts, Creative Entertainment.

The parade includes an array of vibrant costumes, dozens of enchanting Characters and nine beautifully grand floats, from a pirate ship complete with smoking cannons to a retro-Victorian futuristic, mechanical Maleficent dragon that seems more creature than float.

One of the most eye-catching sights is the *Peter Pan* float, which features a colorful glimpse of Never Land and a fresh take on the Lost Boys, inspired by the Broadway hit *Newsies*. "The playful costumes of the parade work as an extension of the floats," said Randy Wojcik, Senior Show Director, also of Walt Disney Entertainment.

"They really just make this gorgeous, dramatic statement out on the parade route," Randy said of the costumes as a whole. "What I like about them is the relevancy of each costume, yet they still tie in to the Disney brand. In perspective, just the scale and magnitude of the costumes are state-of-the-art designs we've never seen in a Disney Park."



Richard Sherman told Disney Historian Stacia Martin that the answer "came all of a sudden when we said…all these people grow up to be people and start having big differences and defiances and wars…but in the small world of children, everybody loves each other."

In his recent autobiography, *Moose: Chapters from My Life*, Robert Sherman points out that "It's the most translated, most performed song in the world." Robert's book reveals a third verse, written at the request of Disney Legend Tony Baxter for the attraction's 45th anniversary: "It's a world of wonder / A world of worth / And in years to come / We'll know peace on Earth / We will open our eyes / And we'll all realize / It's a small world after all."






A Car Master Rolls In to Car Masters Weekend






