We hope you've enjoyed your Walt Disney World® stay. Below are a few important things to remember as you get ready to embark on an unforgettable voyage with Disney Cruise Line®.

The Bell Services Team at your resort will begin luggage pick-up at **8:00 AM** on the morning of your sailing. Please place the luggage you wish transferred to the ship inside your resort room (with Disney Cruise Line luggage tags attached) near the entrance door. You do not need to be present for your luggage to be collected. Please remember to pack a day bag to carry with you and include photo identification, proof of citizenship, cruise documentation and medication. Should you need additional Disney Cruise Line luggage tags, they may be obtained at your Bell Services Desk.

All guests with Disney Cruise Line ground transfers are invited to meet with our Disney Cruise Line representative in **the River Roost Lounge at the Port Orleans Resort – Riverside** at least 15 minutes prior to departure. The motorcoach departure time is **11:45 AM**.

Photo identification for all guests 18 and older will need to be presented to the Disney Cruise Line representative as you board the motorcoach.

Upon check-in at Port Canaveral, you will need to provide proof of citizenship for all members of your party, your completed cruise documents and the form of payment for your onboard account. Please be prepared to provide the following completed forms from your Guest Travel Booklet if you have not completed the online check-in:

- Embark-Departure Form
- Cruise Contract
- Payment Authorization Form
- Onboard Airline Check-In Form – for guests meeting eligibility guidelines.
