

Dear Disney Wonder Guest -

We trust that you are having a truly Magical cruise!

We would like to remind you that **United States Immigration requires that EVERY guest, including children, present themselves in person** for Immigration inspection upon arrival in Key West tomorrow morning. All guests should present Birth Certificates, Resident Cards, or Passports as proof of citizenship, yet you will **not** require a Customs Declaration Form. **EVERY Guest will have to attend whether or not they decide to get off the Ship for the day.**

Once you have completed the Inspection, you will be allowed to immediately disembark the ship and enjoy your day in port. **Be advised that EVERY Guest will need to bring their KTTW card with them, as Immigration officials will put a sticker on them as proof of attendance.**

Guests participating in Port Adventures will be required to present themselves to Immigration Officials **BEFORE** proceeding to the meeting point designated on your Port Adventures ticket.

Please refer to the attendance schedule below to ensure that any delays are avoided and you are able to fully enjoy your time ashore in port.
