An Overview of San Juan

Originally called "La Ciudad Amurallada", San Juan was founded in 1521. In 1508 Juan Ponce de León founded the original settlement, "Caparra", now known as "Pueblo Viejo." a year later, the settlement was abandoned and moved to the site of what is now called "Old San Juan." San Juan is the second oldest city in the Americas. To protect the transportation of gold, silver and jewels, on the route from America to Spain, the Spaniards built a series of forts in the Caribbean. A massive wall and forts were built around San Juan to protect it from the enemy. San Juan was used as a stopover for ships that came from Spain to the colonies and as a stronghold to prevent the enemy from taking control of the island.

In 1898 the U.S. Army landed on the island during the Spanish-American war. Puerto Rico was later ceded to the U.S. as part of the Treaty of Paris that ended in conflict. In 1917, the U.S. Congress granted Puerto Ricans U.S. citizenship. Two decades later, President Franklin D. Roosevelt provided agricultural development, public works and electricity to the island. Puerto Rico has been a U.S. commonwealth since 1952. There have been three referenda on statehood, including one in 1998, but the voters prefer their current status as opposed to becoming the 51st U.S. state. Islanders enjoy citizenship and pay no federal income taxes, but they cannot vote in presidential elections.

San Juan continues to thrive as the business center of the island and the region. It's a manufacturing and processing hub, with petroleum refineries and the famed Bacardi rum distillery. Its port is one of the most active in the Caribbean both for cruise and cargo ships.
