



Dear Guest,

Thank you for choosing a *Disney Cruise Line* vacation. We are pleased that you have joined us aboard the *Disney Magic*.

Due to Schengen Visa & Immigration requirements, Immigration officials in Iceland will inspect the passports of all Guests.

So that you may fully enjoy your time aboard and in the ports-of-call, as well as to comply with this Immigration regulation, all Guests must bring their passport to Preludes located on Deck 4, Forward between 2:00 pm and 6:00 pm today 07/03/15, or Guest Services, located on Deck 3, Midship, between 6:00 pm - 12:00 midnight. Your passports will be retained at Guest Services to be presented to Immigration officials and a passport receipt will be provided.

A representative of your family must submit the passport(s) for your family along with the citizenship document receipt attached to this letter. This receipt must be filled out with the following information:

- Stateroom number
- Your last name
- Your signature

Once your passport(s) has been presented At Preludes, the Host and Hostess will hand you back the receipt with the number of passport(s) received.

On July 7th, 2015, while we are at sea, all Guests, will be required to present themselves in person for a full Immigration inspection in the Walt Disney Theatre. Further details will be provided to you in regards to your assigned Immigration inspection time.

All passports will be returned during this Immigration inspection. You will need to present your passport receipt in order to collect your passport at the Walt Disney Theatre on July 7th 2015.

Kindly note that you will not need your passport for going ashore in Iceland, your Key to the World Card will suffice.
