FACTS TO KNOW

- Port Adventures are not operated by Disney Cruise Line and are carefully selected to provide the best available experiences ashore. These excursions offer something for every interest and skill level.
- The Guest Services Desk is open 24 hours, located Deck 3, to assist with your tour bookings when the Port Adventures Desk is closed.
- Some excursions may not be appropriate for expectant mothers and Guests under medication or Guests who have previous or current heart, neck or back injuries.
- Guests are advised that all Port Adventures, pricing, itinerary, availability, duration and timing are subject to change without notice.
- Tour duration times are estimated and may vary considerably due to circumstances such as traffic or overcrowding of venues.
- Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase extras such as souvenirs.
- On Port Adventures that are stroller accessible, lightweight strollers are recommended.
- Effective January 1, 2015, Bahamian legislation requires a 7.5% Bahamian Value Added Tax (VAT) be added to all goods and services offered in The Bahamas and at Disney's Castaway Cay. Costs incurred on certain components of Port Adventures are also subject to this VAT, so Guests may expect a slight increase in the total cost of these experiences.
- On certain tours, electric wheelchairs are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in electric scooters. Several tours are restricted for collapsible wheelchairs.
- You should never feel that gratuities are expected from you. However, it is customary to leave a few extra dollars in recognition of exceptional excursions guides and drivers. It is always up to you to determine the amount.
- For the consideration of your fellow Guests please ensure you are punctual for all Port Adventure meet times.
- Guests that are prone to sea sickness should take precautionary measures before embarking their vessels.
- Passports, with applicable VISA/ESTA, are required for any tour entering another country. It is mandatory for all Guests participating on this excursion to bring their government issued passport. This requirement is for Guests of All Ages. **Guests without passports will not be able to participate in these Port Adventures.**
- Although street and beach vendors may appear loud and pushy as they attempt to sell their goods to vacationing families, Guests should not feel in any way intimidated by this typical behavior.



CANCELLATION POLICY

Disney Cruise Line does not maintain their facilities or modes of transportation and is not responsible for any injury or property damage/loss that Guests may incur in connection with a Port Adventure.

All Port Adventures are subject to the Disney Cruise Line Cruise Contract. All Port Adventures are subject to availability and/or cancellation based on weather, itinerary changes, and attendance. Cancellations can be made up to 3 days prior to cruise departure date. After that time all reservations are final and non-refundable. All prices are subject to change without notice.

SECURITY NOTICE

All Guests (including children) who wish to disembark or embark the ship are required to present their Key to the World card at the gangway. A photo ID is also required for those Guests who are 18 years of age and older.

Guests under the age of 18 are required to have a parent, guardian or other responsible adult sign an authorization form if they wish to go ashore unaccompanied. Authorization forms are available at Guest Services.


Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult on Port Adventures, except for specific "teen only" Port Adventures.

PORT ADVENTURE ACTIVITY LEVEL

 **Mild** These excursions involve periods of walking for short distances over relatively level surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestone and limited steps. Standing or sitting for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Boarding tour vehicles via gangway or steps will be required. Distance from gangway to tour vehicle will vary port to port.




























 **Moderate** Uneven/steep terrain or water activity in slight current. These excursions are fairly active and involve periods of walking over even and uneven surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestones, steps, and in some cases steep terrain. Standing for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Moderate water activities involve extended periods in a slight current, and may require climbing a ladder during beach or swimming stops.

 **Active** Good physical condition required. These excursions are considered active and may involve constant effort or extended periods of walking long distances, numerous steps, inclines, cobblestone surfaces, and other rough terrain throughout the excursion. Participants should be in good physical condition to fully enjoy these excursions.

B17 BARBADOS BEACH BREAK



All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$30 (ages 10 and up) \$16 (ages 3 to 9)

Travel to **Harbour Lights Beach Club** (approx. 15 min) and head to your **beach chair** and **shared umbrella** while enjoying a **welcome drink** (approx. 3 hours). Food and additional beverages are available for purchase. Return to the ship (approx. 15 min).

B12 MONKEY ENCOUNTER & ISLAND ADVENTURE



All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$52 (ages 10 and up) \$36 (ages 3 to 9)

Travel to the **Highland Adventure Centre** for a drink before descending into the **Wildlife Reserve** for the **Green Monkey Experience**, where monkeys and other wildlife are free to roam (approx. 60 min). Monkey sightings cannot be guaranteed. Reboard your bus and travel through **historic Hometown** and the "Gold Coast." Return to the pier.

B06/B28 BEST OF BARBADOS



All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$60 (ages 10 and up) \$36 (ages 3 to 9)

Travel to **Orchid World** (approx. 35 min) for a visit before heading to **Gun Hill Signal Station** and **Sunbury Plantation House** to view the collections of antiques and memorabilia. Return to the port (approx. 40 min). **ADULT ONLY DEPARTURE ALSO AVAILABLE.**

B27 BEAUTIFUL BARBADOS



All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$56 (ages 10 and up) \$43 (ages 3 to 9)

Scenic travel to **St. Nicholas Abbey** (approx. 50 min) for a tour of this stunning Jacobean mansion before viewing the rum distillery (approx. 75 min). Travel to **Codrington College** (approx. 30 min) for a visit (approx. 30 min). Return to the port.

B08 EXPLORE BARBADOS BY LAND ROVER



Ages 5 and Up 3 to 3.5 Hours \$67 (ages 10 and up) \$57 (ages 5 to 9)

Board a **Land Rover** and take the road less traveled around Barbados before stopping at **Bathsheba** for a photo stop and beverage (approx. 20 min). Continue on to **Cattlewash** for island views and travel through **Hometown** and back to Bridgetown Harbor. Return to the ship. Guest weight may not exceed 260 pounds.

B07/B29 DISCOVER BARBADOS



All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$67 (ages 10 and up) \$50 (ages 3 to 9)

Travel to **St. John's Church** (approx. 45 min) for a visit before continuing on to **Bathsheba** (approx. 25 min) for a photo stop. Continue on to **St. Nicholas Abbey** (approx. 35 min) to tour the parish of St. Peter and the rum plantation (approx. 60 min). Travel back to the port. **ADULT ONLY DEPARTURE ALSO AVAILABLE.**

B18 SWIM WITH TURTLES



Ages 5 and Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$74 (ages 10 and up) \$64 (ages 5 to 9)

Begin with an approximate 15-minute drive to your awaiting vessel. Take a short transfer to board your powerboat to the snorkel site at Turtle Bay (approx. 25 min). Receive snorkel instruction, equipment and required vest before heading into the water (approx. 35 min) among Green and Hawksbill turtles. Turtle sightings are not guaranteed. Sail along the West Coast (approx. 40 min) on your way to the Berwyn Shipwreck to snorkel (approx. 40 min). Enjoy some beach time or additional swimming (approx. 40 min) before returning to the ship.

B16 TIAMI SAIL & SNORKEL



Ages 5 and Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$70 (ages 10 and up) \$60 (ages 5 to 9)

Take a short transfer to board your **catamaran** and head along Barbados' coastline to a sheltered bay (approx. 40 min). Receive snorkel instruction, equipment and required vest before heading into the water (approx. 45 min) among **Green and Hawksbill turtles**. Turtle sightings are not guaranteed. Reboard the catamaran for **complimentary cocktails** and relaxation before returning back to the pier.

B19 HARRISON'S CAVE & SCENIC DRIVE



All Ages (3+) 2.5 to 3 Hours \$77 (ages 10 and up) \$40 (ages 3 to 9)

Take a scenic drive to **Harrison's Cave** (approx. 30 min). Explore the **interpretative exhibits** and watch a short video before boarding a tram into the cave. View thousands of stalagmites and stalactites in stunning formation (approx. 40 min). Return to the pier. **Video recording is not permitted.**

B04 4X4 ADVENTURE & MONKEY ENCOUNTER



Ages 5 and Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$83 (ages 10 and up) \$58 (ages 5 to 9)

Travel via **4x4 vehicle** to the **Wildlife Reserve** (approx. 60 min). Walk through the open forests home to the **Green Monkey**. Sightings are not guaranteed. Reboard your vehicle, enjoy a photo stop and return to the port (approx. 60 min). Guests do not drive the vehicle. Vehicles hold 11 passengers and parties may be split. Guest weight may not exceed 260 pounds.

B25 CONCORDE AND ISLAND DRIVE



Ages 5 and Up 4 to 4.5 Hours \$82 (ages 10 and up) \$60 (ages 5 to 9)

Travel to **The Barbados Concorde Exhibit** (approx. 40 min) to see what it might have been like to travel on a **Concorde aircraft** (approx. 1 hour). Continue on to **St. John's Church** (approx. 30 min) for a brief stop. Travel to the **Atlantis Hotel** for a drink and photo stop (approx. 30 min). Return to the port.

B03 5-STAR CATAMARAN & TURTLE ENCOUNTER



Ages 5 and Up 5 to 5.5 Hours \$108 (ages 10 and up) \$83 (ages 5 to 9)

Take a short transfer to board your **catamaran** and cruise the coastline (approx. 40 min). Stop at the beach, receive snorkel instruction, equipment and required life vest and snorkel the clear waters. Enjoy a **buffet-style lunch** along with **unlimited beverages**. Continue sailing to the next stop, often frequented by sea turtles (approx. 40 min). Turtle sightings cannot be guaranteed. Return to the port.

SL72 WATERSIDE JOGGING AND WALKING TOUR

Ages 10 and Up 2 to 2.5 Hours \$30 (ages 10 and up)



Wake up and lace-up! Join our St. Lucia Jogging Tour for a unique tour of this Beautiful Island! Start your 3-mile run along Castries Harbor and on to Vigie, one of the island's longest stretches of beach. Head to the Vigie Lighthouse, where you can view the ruins of barrack buildings that were used during the 18th-century battles. Enjoy a break at the lighthouse to hydrate and experience one of the best views of the Harbor before running back to the pier.

SL24 NATURAL LATILLE WATERFALL

Ages 5 to 70 (10+) 4.5 to 5 hours \$48 (Ages 10 to 70) \$33 (Ages 5 to 9)



Scenic travel to Latille Waterfall Gardens and Waterfall (approx. 1 hour) and explore the gardens before walking down the trail to the waterfall. Walking sticks will be provided to walk down to the waterfall. Explore, swim and hike before enjoying local refreshment (approx. 2 hours). Return to the ship (approx. 1 hour).

SL16 / SL35 CREOLE PARK AND ST. LUCIAN RHYTHMS

Ages 5 and up 3 to 3.5 hours \$50 (Ages 10 and up) \$30 (Ages 5 to 9)



Travel to the colonial house of St. Marks for a guided tour, drink and Creole snacks (approx. 30 min). SL02 TROPICAL WATERFALL EXPERIENCE

Board on a air-conditioned motor coach (Approx. 90 mins) for a spectacular view of the majestic Pitons. (approx. 45 min). Explore the area and enjoy a refreshment of local juices and snacks (approx. 1 hour). Return to the port (approx. 30 min).

SL01 4X4 BEACH SAFARI

Ages 8 and up 4 to 4.5 hours \$56 (Ages 10 and up) \$30 (Ages 8 to 9)



Board 4x4 vehicles to Morne Fortune Viewpoint for a photo stop before off-roading (approx. 1 hour) to Anse la Voute Beach for a chance to swim, relax and walk along the beach (approx. 2 hour) Return to the port. Guests must weigh less than 270 pounds.

SL20 SNORKEL BENEATH THE PITONS

Ages 13 and up 4 to 4.5 hours \$60 (Ages 13 and up)



Board a powerboat and head toward the Pitons (approx. 1 hour) relaxing onboard with soft drinks and snacks. Arrive at Sugar Beach for snorkeling and relaxing on the beach (approx. 2 hours). Return to the port (approx. 1 hour).

SL04 CRUISE TO THE PITONS

Board your catamaran and travel to Petit and Gros Pitons from Soufriere Bay before heading to a calm bay for swimming and relaxing (approx. 45 min). SL23 FUN ONBOARD A SPANISH GALLEON

Be a buccaner. Board the 16th-century Spanish galleon Black Magic for a one-hour cruise, heading up the St. Lucia's northern coast to Pigeon Island and Rodney Bay. Drop anchor in Rodney Bay for a 2-hour break. Spend time swimming in the crystal-clear Caribbean waters. Relax and enjoy your cruise back to the Castries Harbor with rum punch, juices and soft drinks provided. Enjoy Caribbean music and take photos of the island as you sail back to the pier.

Travel to **Pigeon Island** (approx. 30 min) to receive a safety briefing and equipment overview. Put on your **Sea Trek** gear and explore underwater on foot (approx. 30 min). Sea Trek is a helmet system designed for breathing and seeing underwater by walking on the sea floor. Relax at the park and beach (approx. 1 hour). Return to the port.


SL25 LAND AND SEA TO SOUFRIERE

 Ages 5 and up (10+) 7 to 7.5 hours \$100 (Ages 10 and up) \$60 (Ages 5 to 9)



Travel to **Anse La Raye** to explore the village (approx. 30 min) before heading on to Soufriere (approx. 30 min) to view the **Pitons** and experience the **sulphuric mud baths** (approx. 30 min). Travel on to **Morne Coubaril Estate** for a tour and full **buffet lunch** (approx. 60 min). Board your catamaran to a calm bay for swimming and relaxing (approx. 1 hour). Return to the ship (approx. 45 min).


SL26 RAINFOREST MOUNTAIN BIKE ADVENTURE

 Ages 12 to 70 4.5 to 5 hours \$100 (Ages 12 to 70)



Scenic travel through St. Lucia to the rainforest welcome center (approx. 1 hour) to be briefed on the journey, receive your required helmet and choose your bike. Ride through the rainforest to the **Dennerly waterfall** for a dip to refresh yourself before heading back to the port.


SL17 LUCIAN STYLE SEGWAY

 Ages 12 to 70 3 to 3.5 hours \$132 (Ages 12 to 70)



Travel to the **Segway Center** (approx. 30 min) for your safety briefing, instruction and practice. Board your Segway personal transporter up Mount Primard (approx. 2 hours). Take a short break to enjoy some local juices and fruits before returning to the center and the port.


SL71 MARIGOT BAY TO ROSEAU RIVER KAYAKING ADVENTURE

 Ages 8 and Up 4 to 4.5 Hours \$133 (ages 10 and up) \$122 (ages 8 to 9)



Transfer from the pier to the dive shop at Marigot Bay. Receive (approx. 30 min) of instruction on the safety equipment and kayaking technique. Paddle out from Marigot Bay, kayaking to the open sea. Follow the west coast for 20 min to the Roseau River. Travel 30 min along a lagoon then go upstream a short distance before turning back toward the sea. Head back to Marigot. On the way to and from the river, there are a number of places to snorkel—water conditions permitting—before heading back to the pier.

SL06 GOLF IN ST LUCIA

 Ages 12 and up 5 to 6.5 hours \$169 (Ages 12 and up)



Travel to the **St. Lucia Golf and Country Club** (approx. 30 min) and tee off on this 6,829 yard, **par 71** course. Package includes green fees, a shared cart and roundtrip transportation. 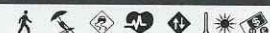

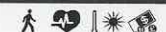

SK02 CATAMARAN FANTASEA

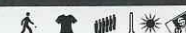

SK15 ST KITTS SCENIC RAILWAY AND SAIL CRUISE

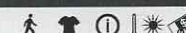
