FACTS TO KNOW

- The Guest Services Desk is open 24 hours, located Deck 3, to assist with your tour bookings when the Port Adventures Desk is closed.
- Guests are advised that all Port Adventures, pricing, itinerary, availability, duration and timing are subject to change without notice.
- Tour duration times are estimated and may vary considerably due to circumstances such as traffic or overcrowding of venues.
- Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase extras such as souvenirs.
- On Port Adventures that are stroller accessible, lightweight strollers are recommended.
- On certain tours, electric wheelchairs are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in electric scooters. Several tours are restricted for collapsible wheelchairs.
- You should never feel that gratuities are expected from you. However, it is customary to leave a few extra dollars in recognition of exceptional excursions guides and drivers. It is always up to you to determine the amount.
- For the consideration of your fellow Guests please ensure you are punctual for all Port Adventure meet times.
- Passports, with applicable VISA/ESTA, are required for any tour entering another country. It is mandatory for all Guests participating on this excursion to bring their government issued passport. This requirement is for Guests of All Ages. **Guests without passports will not be able to participate in these Port Adventures.**
- Although street and beach vendors may appear loud and pushy as they attempt to sell their goods to vacationing families, Guests should not feel in any way intimidated by this typical behavior.
- Guests that are prone to sea sickness should take precautionary measures before embarking their vessels.

TRAVEL SAFETY TIPS

As in any tourist destination, you will want to take some basic precautions to make the most of your time ashore. Be aware of your surroundings, especially in crowded areas and avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators. Leave your valuables in your stateroom safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs. Cameras and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight. People who carry handbags or backpacks are particularly vulnerable to purse snatchers on scooters. Guests should take their passport with them when ashore. If a passport check is required by local authorities, photo copies are no longer a valid form of identification. In general, use the same level of precaution you would use in any tourist destination. Please remember that while in a foreign country, you are subject to its laws.

SECURITY NOTICE

PORT ADVENTURE ACTIVITY LEVEL

Mild These excursions involve periods of walking for short distances over relatively level surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestone and limited steps. Standing or sitting for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Boarding tour vehicles via gangway or steps will be required. Distance from gangway to tour vehicle will vary port to port.

Moderate Uneven/steep terrain or water activity in slight current. These excursions are fairly active and involve periods of walking over even and uneven surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestones, steps, and in some cases steep terrain. Standing for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Moderate water activities involve extended periods in a slight current, and may require climbing a ladder during beach or swimming stops.

Active Good physical condition required. These excursions are considered active and may involve constant effort or extended periods of walking long distances, numerous steps, inclines, cobblestone surfaces, and other rough terrain throughout the excursion. Participants should be in good physical condition to fully enjoy these excursions.

PD06 FOGO LAKE, RIBEIRA GRANDE AND PINEAPPLE PLANTATION



All Ages **3.5 to 4 Hours** **\$26 (ages 10 and up)** **\$23 (ages 3 to 9)**



Scenic travel by coach to Ribeira Grande for a brief visit (approx. 30 min), home to narrow streets lined with urban architecture from the 17th and 18th centuries. Reboard the motorcoach and head toward Barrosa Mountain stopping on the way to visit Caldeira Velha monument, a scenic waterfall and steaming hot spring. Stop at Fogo Lake with views over the highest lake above sea level on São Miguel Island. Drive to the southern side of the island to a local pineapple plantation. Return back to the pier.

PD01 SETE CIDADES LAKE VISTAS, BOTANICAL GARDEN AND PINEAPPLE PLANTATION



All Ages **4 to 4.5 Hours** **\$29 (ages 10 and up)** **\$24 (ages 3 to 9)**



Travel via coach (approx. 40 min) along a mountain road to Vista do Rei to enjoy the marvelous landscape at the bottom of Sete Cidades' extinct volcano. Continue to the Santiago Lake viewpoint (approx. 25 min) for a brief photo stop of Crater Lake before heading on to Antonio Borges Garden (approx. 30 min) for a walking visit. Next stop at a pineapple plantation before re-boarding the motorcoach and returning to the pier.

PD04 FURNAS HOT SPRINGS AND BOTANICAL GARDEN



All Ages **4.5 to 5 Hours** **\$39 (ages 10 and up)** **\$35 (ages 3 to 9)**

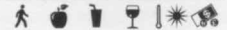


Scenic travel (approx. 60 min) along the south side of the island, passing by Franca do Campo, on your way to Furnas Lake. Visit Terra Nostra Garden and the hot springs before continuing to Caldeiras, an area with several mineral water pools, thermal springs and fumaroles. Reboard the coach and travel to the Pico do Ferro lookout point for a photo stop, and on to the Santa Iria lookout point before returning to the pier.

PD08 BEST OF WEST WITH WINE AND CHEESE



All Ages **4 to 4.5 Hours** **\$52 (ages 10 and up)** **\$45 (ages 3 to 9)**



Travel from Ponta Delgada toward the western part of São Miguel (approx. 45 min) for a photo stop at Escalvado to enjoy views over Mosteiros. Continue to the village of Sete Cidades (approx. 15 min) for a bit of free time before heading to the Santiago vantage point. Travel to Vista do Rei for a photo stop before continuing to Pico do Carvão vantage point. Return to Ponta Delgada and enjoy a selection of some of the region's best wines and cheeses. Conclude your tour with a short walk back to the pier.

PD05 HIGHLIGHTS OF RIBEIRA GRANDE



All Ages **4.5 to 5 Hours** **\$65 (ages 10 and up)** **\$58 (ages 3 to 9)**



Scenic travel towards the central part of the island to Serra de Água de Pau and Barrosa Mountain (approx. 30min). After a brief photo stop, travel toward the north coast and visit Caldeira Velha monument. Continue to Ribeira Grande for a brief stop before heading to a local farm known for breeding the Lusitano horses. Enjoy wine-and-cheese tasting at the farmhouse and visit the horse stables. Return to the pier.

PD02 SETE CIDADES BIKING AND KAYAKING



Ages 8 And Up **3.5 to 4 Hours** **\$79 (ages 10 and up)** **\$59 (ages 8 to 9)**



Scenic travel to Sete Cidades (approx. 45 min) for a photo stop before arriving at your base to get instructions. Guests will be split into two groups - kayaking or biking. Receive equipment and a safety briefing. Bike through the village and kayak around the shoreline, following your own navigation or a road map at own your discretion. Return to the pier.

PD07 4 X 4 FOGO LAKE AND TEA FACTORY

Board a 4x4 vehicle and embark on a ride where you'll discover why Sao Miguel Island is known as the green island on your drive (approx. 30-min) to Barrosa Mountain. Continue (approx. 15 min) down the northern coast to Caldeira Velha. Next, journey to Monte Escuro, where you can take in the views of the beautiful coastline and the Lombadas Waterfall. Travel (approx. 30 min) to a local tea plantation, drive (approx. 15-min) to the Santa Iria viewpoint for another amazing view of the deep blue ocean and bright green landscapes. Return back to the pier.

PD03 FURNAS AND COZIDO DAS CALDEIRAS



All Ages **7 to 7.5 Hours** **\$91 (ages 10 and up)** **\$80 (ages 3 to 9)**



Scenic travel to Ribeira Grande (approx. 30 min) for a brief stop to stroll through the town's charming historic center and narrow streets. Reboard the coach and travel to one of the island's tea plantations (approx. 30 min) to discover how the tea is created and try a sip. Drive to the Pico de Ferro for a photo stop before continuing on to the fumaroles where lunch is cooked. A sealed pot with assorted meats and vegetables is buried underground, and in 5 to 7 hours, the Cozido das Caldeiras is ready to eat. Eat, explore the local area of Caldeiras and return to the pier.

PD10 WHALE AND DOLPHIN WATCHING IN THE AZORES ON A CATAMARAN



Ages 6 And Up **3.5 to 4 Hours** **\$94 (ages 10 and up)** **\$84 (ages 6 to 9)**



Walk to the base area for a briefing by an expert prior to setting off for the marina. Board a catamaran and venture into the open sea in search of whales and dolphins. Although common, wildlife sightings are not guaranteed. The crew will answer any questions regarding the Azores' marvelous marine life. Return to the pier.

PD09 CANYONING IN THE AZORES



Ages 12 And Up **5 to 5.5 Hours** **\$95 (ages 12 and up)**



Travel via van to Parque Natural de Ribeira dos Caldeiros (approx. 60 min) and receive your gear before walking to the site (approx. 20 min). Receive a safety briefing on the use of your climbing gear and safety precautions. Note: this tour includes jumping from heights and maneuvering around slippery or rocky surfaces. Safety is guaranteed with proper use of harnesses, ropes and the presence of qualified guides/instructors. Return back to the pier.

PD16 WHALE AND DOLPHIN WATCHING IN THE AZORES ON A RIB BOAT

PORTLAND, ENGLAND

PT32 LYME REGIS AND THE JURASSIC COAST

All Ages **4.5 to 5 Hours** **\$63 (ages 10 and up)** **\$49 (ages 3 to 9)**

Travel through the Dorset countryside and villages (approx. 75 min) as you see the natural beauty of the Jurassic Coast, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Arrive at Lyme Regis, a seaside town with a tangle of narrow streets leading to the 13th Century Cobb harbor and superb sandy beach. The river Lyme twists its way through the town's steep streets and visit the historic restored watermill in the heart of the town. Learn about the unique geology of this stretch of coastline covering 185 million years (approx. 90 min) before visiting West Bay (approx. 30 min) to see the towering Jurassic cliffs. Return back to the pier.

PT02 ABBOTSBURY SWANNERY AND GARDENS

All Ages **4 to 4.5 Hours** **\$83 (ages 10 and up)** **\$49 (ages 3 to 9)**

Travel to the historic village of Abbotsbury Swannery (approx. 30 min), established in the 1040s by Benedictine monks, who farmed swans as delicacies for their lavish Dorset banquets. The swans are still bred there, but now have legal protection, with the habitat sometimes supporting more than 600 of these majestic birds. An official keeper dispatches swans all over the world as gifts in the Queen's name. After the unique 90-min guided swannery tour, proceed to nearby Abbotsbury Subtropical Gardens, one of the finest gardens in the country. Free time (approx. 90 min) to view the many species of exotic and unusual flowers. The gardens also offer stunning views of the Dorset Jurassic Coast. Return to the pier.

PT03 GLASTONBURY TOR AND THE CATHEDRAL CITY OF WELLS

All Ages **7.5 to 8 Hours** **\$89 (ages 10 and up)** **\$65 (ages 3 to 9)**

Travel (approx. 2 hr) north through green rolling farmlands and arrive at Wells, the smallest city in England. Located on the southern edge of the Mendip Hills, Wells is visually dominated by its stunning cathedral—famous for its magnificent west front with over 300 statues and carvings. Next take a short drive to the mystical Glastonbury Tor, which is said to be a mysterious entrance to the Otherworld and also has connections to the legend of King Arthur. The tor offers spectacular views over Somerset, Dorset and Wiltshire. Walk (approx. 20 mins) up the hill to the tor and enjoy 360-degree panoramic views over the lovely acres of green marshlands. Return back to the pier. Note: Guests, including children wishing to visit churches are respectfully requested to ensure that shoulders and knees remain covered. Guests can wear shorts that reach below the knees and tank tops, as long as they bring a sweater or scarf to wrap around their shoulders.

PT07 PORTLAND LIGHTHOUSE WALK

All Ages **4 to 4.5 Hours** **\$95 (ages 10 and up)** **\$89 (ages 3 to 9)**

Take a short 15-min transfer from the pier to Portland Bill. Visit one of Britain's most iconic lighthouses and meet the lighthouse keeper. After visiting the lighthouse, your walking tour (approx. 195 min) begins along the rugged, sunlit cliffs of Hardy's Wessex. Along the way, see the world-famous Fleet Lagoon and learn about Portland stone, the limestone used to construct many of the UK's most important buildings. Next, visit one of Britain's rare Georgian churches, constructed of Portland stone. Along the way, explore the work of the renowned British sculptor Anthony Gormley at a local sculpture park. Make a final stop at Portland Castle and go inside to one of Henry VIII's finest coastal forts, built to defend England against foreign invasion. Return to the pier on foot from the castle. Note: Guests must wear comfortable, closed toe walking shoes.

PT09/PT12 THE GREEN FIELDS OF ENGLAND & CORFE CASTLE

All Ages **5 to 5.5 Hours** **\$99 (ages 10 and up)** **\$69 (ages 3 to 9)**

Travel through southern England to the village of Corfe (approx. 90 min). Walk through the village and up the hill to the namesake castle. Corfe Castle crowns the hill behind the village and is perhaps one of the most evocative ruins in England. Explore the remains, treading the same steps as kings, knights, soldiers, servants and prisoners who all visited, lived, worked in or fought over the castle during its colorful, 1,000-year history. Following your visit to the castle (approx. 1 hour), enjoy free time (approx. 45 min) to wander the village and take in the local atmosphere. Stop by a local bakery for a traditional Dorset delicacy – the "pasty," a baked pastry filled with beef and vegetables. Take the pasty with you on your drive back to the pier (approx. 90 min). **Adult only and small group departure also available.**

PT06/PT11 MEDIEVAL CATHEDRAL CITY OF SALISBURY

All Ages **6 to 6.5 Hours** **\$105 (ages 10 and up)** **\$83 (ages 3 to 9)**

Depart Portland through the English countryside before arriving in Salisbury (approx. 2 hours). Arrive in this 13th century market town to visit the majestic Salisbury Cathedral with the tallest spire in England, at 123 meters. Following a short bus tour, spend time inside the impressive cathedral. Enjoy a unique, private visit to the west window and its stunning views of the building's entire length. This tour includes an opportunity to view one of only four surviving copies of the Magna Carta. After your visit, take some free time to explore the fascinating city. Return back to the pier. **Adult only and small group departure also available.**

PT08/PT10 STONEHENGE

All Ages **5.5 to 6 Hours** **\$119 (ages 10 and up)** **\$95 (ages 3 to 9)**

Scenic travel to Stonehenge (approx. 105 min), one of the most important prehistoric monuments in Britain. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, this natural stone circle was erected between 3,000 BC and 1,600 BC (earlier than the Egyptian pyramids). Upon arriving at Stonehenge, a train shuttle service will take you to the monument. At the monument, you can choose to use the audio guides (subject to availability) or explore Stonehenge independently, including the new visitor's center. Return back to the pier. **Adult only departure and small group departure also available.**

PT04 JURASSIC RIB RIDE TO LULWORTH COVE

Ages 6 and Up **2.5 to 3 Hours** **\$165 (ages 10 and up)** **\$145 (ages 6 to 9)**

Begin with a short walk down the pier to the rigid inflatable boat (RIB) departure point for your safety briefing. Board the RIB and cruise along the beautiful Jurassic Coast while viewing the geological phenomenon that is Durdle Door and the beautiful bay of Lulworth Cove. Stop at Lulworth Cove (approx. 15 min) to purchase a locally caught crab sandwich or an ice cream if you wish. Return back to the pier.

PT15 THE GREEN FIELDS OF ENGLAND & CORFE CASTLE (SMALL GROUP DEPARTURE - 20 PEOPLE MAX)

All Ages **5 to 5.5 Hours** **\$205 (ages 10 and up)** **\$155 (ages 3 to 9)**

Travel through southern England to the village of Corfe (approx. 90 min). Walk through the village and up the hill to the namesake castle. Corfe Castle crowns the hill behind the village and is perhaps one of the most evocative ruins in England. Explore the remains, treading the same steps as kings, knights, soldiers, servants and prisoners who all visited, lived, worked in or fought over the castle during its colorful, 1,000-year history. Following your visit to the castle (approx. 1 hour), enjoy free time (approx. 45 min) to wander the village and take in the local atmosphere. DOVER, ENGLAND

D011/D018 CITY OF LONDON AND THE BRITISH MUSEUM



All Ages 9 to 9.5 Hours \$75 (ages 10 and up) \$37 (ages 3 to 9)



Drive to London (approx. 2 hours and 15 min) and begin a panoramic guided tour of this grand city. Stop near Westminster Abbey, the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben and view Parliament Square. See the statues of Winston Churchill and Nelson Mandela before catching a glimpse of Downing Street's entrance and the magnificent Mall by Buckingham Palace. Arrive at the British Museum to explore on your own (approx. 3 hours). Enjoy free time for lunch at your own expense at one of the many on-site cafes and restaurants. 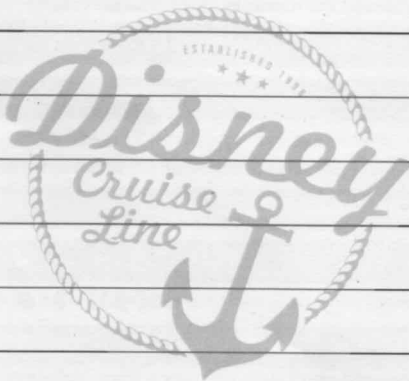
