TRAVEL SAFETY TIPS



- Mild These excursions involve periods of walking for short distances over relatively level surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestone and limited steps. Standing or sitting for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Boarding tour vehicles via gangway or steps will be required. Distance from gangway to tour vehicle will vary port to port.
