## FACTS TO KNOW

- The Guest Services Desk is open 24 hours, located Deck 3, to assist with your tour bookings when the Port Adventures Desk is closed.
- Guests are advised that all Port Adventures, pricing, itinerary, availability, duration and timing are subject to change without notice.
- Tour duration times are estimated and may vary considerably due to circumstances such as traffic or overcrowding of venues.
- Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase extras such as souvenirs.
- On Port Adventures that are stroller accessible, lightweight strollers are recommended.
- On certain tours, electric wheelchairs are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in electric scooters. Several tours are restricted for collapsible wheelchairs.
- You should never feel that gratuities are expected from you. However, it is customary to leave a few extra dollars in recognition of exceptional excursions guides and drivers. It is always up to you to determine the amount.
- For the consideration of your fellow Guests please ensure you are punctual for all Port Adventure meet times.
- Passports, with applicable VISA/ESTA, are required for any tour entering another country. It is mandatory for all Guests participating on this excursion to bring their government issued passport. This requirement is for Guests of All Ages. **Guests without passports will not be able to participate in these Port Adventures.**
- Although street and beach vendors may appear loud and pushy as they attempt to sell their goods to vacationing families, Guests should not feel in any way intimidated by this typical behavior.
- Guests that are prone to sea sickness should take precautionary measures before embarking their vessels.

## TRAVEL SAFETY TIPS

As in any tourist destination, you will want to take some basic precautions to make the most of your time ashore. Be aware of your surroundings, especially in crowded areas and avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators. Leave your valuables in your stateroom safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs. Cameras and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight. People who carry handbags or backpacks are particularly vulnerable to purse snatchers on scooters. Guests should take their passport with them when ashore. If a passport check is required by local authorities, photo copies are no longer a valid form of identification. In general, use the same level of precaution you would use in any tourist destination. Please remember that while in a foreign country, you are subject to its laws.

Disney Cruise Line does not maintain their facilities or modes of transportation and is not responsible for any injury or property damage/loss that Guests may incur in connection with a Port Adventure.

All Port Adventures are subject to the Disney Cruise Line Cruise Contract. All Port Adventures are subject to availability and/or cancellation based on weather, itinerary changes, and attendance. Cancellations can be made up to 3 days prior to cruise departure date. After that time all reservations are final and non-refundable. All prices are subject to change without notice.

### SECURITY NOTICE





All Guests (including children) who wish to disembark or embark the ship are required to present their Key to the World card at the gangway. A photo ID is also required for those Guests who are 18 years of age and older.

Guests under the age of 18 are required to have a parent, guardian or other responsible adult sign an authorization form if they wish to go ashore unaccompanied. Authorization forms are available at Guest Services.

Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult on Port Adventures, except for specific "teen only" Port Adventures.

**Mild** These excursions involve periods of walking for short distances over relatively level surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestone and limited steps. Standing or sitting for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Boarding tour vehicles via gangway or steps will be required. Distance from gangway to tour vehicle will vary port to port.




























**Moderate** Uneven/steep terrain or water activity in slight current. These excursions are fairly active and involve periods of walking over even and uneven surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestones, steps, and in some cases steep terrain. Standing for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Moderate water activities involve extended periods in a slight current, and may require climbing a ladder during beach or swimming stops.

**Active** Good physical condition required. These excursions are considered active and may involve constant effort or extended periods of walking long distances, numerous steps, inclines, cobblestone surfaces, and other rough terrain throughout the excursion. Participants should be in good physical condition to fully enjoy these excursions.

## EN01/EN02 CITY & SHOPPING TOUR

Travel through the city to Plaza Civica for a brief tour on your way to the Civic and Cultural Center Riviera del Pacifico. Travel along the Baja California coast to the village of Bufadora (approx. 60 mins). Along the way enjoy narration of the sights. Enjoy time on your own to shop, have a snack and visit the largest blowhole in the world (approx. 90 min). Head to Riviera del Pacifico in Ensenada for a margarita or non-alcoholic beverage (included) and shopping (approx. 30 min). Return to the pier.

## EN03/EN08 WINE COUNTRY TOUR

## EN09 TASTE OF MEXICO

Travel to downtown Ensenada for a guided walking tour (approx 50 min) including the Malecon (the main boardwalk area), Flag Plaza and Ventana al Mar. Reboard your coach to a restaurant to eat and learn how to make traditional Mexican Salsa. Head downtown for shopping and free time (approx. 1 hour). Return to the ship.

## EN04 HORSEBACK RIDING

## CL06 HARBOR CRUISE & SCENIC STOP

 All Ages      3 to 3.5 hours      \$50 (ages 10 and up)      \$33 (ages 0 to 9)



Board a motorized catamaran to Land's End. Listen to an informative narration by J.M. Cousteau as you head to the Los Arcos rock formation. Enjoy the sites passing Lover's Beach, a sea lion colony at the Los Frailes rock islets and the Arch of Poseidon as you head back toward the ship. Drive to a hilltop restaurant for a drink and sightseeing break. Travel back to the ship.

## CL48 SAN JOSE CITY TOUR

Sail on a catamaran to Santa Maria Cove. Receive your snorkeling gear, your required snorkeling vest and safety instructions before heading into the water to snorkel (approx. 1 hour). Enjoy a drink on your way back to the pier (approx. 1 hour).

## CL59 LAND'S END COASTAL CRUISE AND BEACH BREAK

Board a power catamaran and pass pristine beaches, towering rock formations and the famed "Los Arcos" (approx. 40 min). Board a 65-foot catamaran (approx. 45 min) to Chileno Bay. After a safety and equipment briefing, don your required snorkel vest and snorkel (approx. 1 hour). Enjoy a snack and beverage before spending additional time snorkeling. Return to the pier.

## CL58 SNORKEL & SEA ADVENTURE

Meet your guide, receive a safety briefing and your equipment. Don your required life vest, board an inflatable APEX watercraft and cruise past the famous Land's End Arch and Lover's Beach. Drop anchor in a spectacular cove to power-snorkel with water scooters and kayak (approx. 75 min). Return to the ship.


## CL05 PACIFIC SIDE HORSEBACK RIDE

Travel to a seaside ranch (approx. 30 min) to meet your guide and your horse. Start your ride on the beach and explore the coast (approx. 1 hour). Relax after the ride and return to the pier. Helmets and closed-toe shoes are required, long pants are recommended. Maximum Guests weight is 240 pounds.

Take a short drive to the ME Cabo Hotel and the sandy shores of the world famous Nikki Beach Club. Take a dip in the ocean or head to the swim-up bar, listen to music, enjoy the stunning views of the renowned El Arco rock formation or relax on a lounge chair while enjoying the South Pacific breezes. Return back to the pier. Lunch included.



**CL21 CABO CANYON ADVENTURE**

Travel to Boca de la Sierra, A UNESCO-protected site in the High Sierras (approx. 75 min). Meet your guide for an overview and safety instructions. Zip through the trees from 200 feet above the ground. Walk across hanging rope bridges and ladders, and rappel down the canyon walls. Conclude by flying high on an exciting 800-foot zip line back to the base camp (approx. 2.5 hours). Return to the pier. Guests must be at least 48" tall and weigh a maximum of 250 pounds.

**CL63 RESORT, SHOPPING AND LUNCH**

All Ages      5.5 to 6 hours      \$124 (ages 10 and up)      \$89 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel (approx. 15 min) around the historic main square in Cabo San Lucas before your coastal drive (approx. 30 min) to the all-inclusive Holiday Inn Resort in San Jose del Cabo. Enjoy a buffet lunch, a dip in the resort's pool or walk on the beautiful beach (approx. 3 hours). Note: like other beaches on Cabo's Pacific side, the resort's beach experiences strong undertow and is therefore closed to swimming. Travel via coach (approx. 10 min) to the 18th-century Spanish-colonial San Jose town square. Explore on your own (approx 45 min). Return back to the pier.

**CL24 CAMEL & MEXICAN OUTBACK ADVENTURE**

Ages 6 and Up      4 to 4.5 hours      \$126 (ages 10 and up)      \$106 (ages 6 to 9)



Travel to a paradise coastal ranch (approx. 30 min) and board a 4x4 Mercedes Unimog. Experience a narrated nature walk (approx. 30 min) before boarding a camel to ride on a secluded beach (approx. 15 min). Participate in optional workshops about how tortillas are handmade and the distillation of tequila before eating a typical Mexican lunch. Reboard your vehicle and travel back to the pier. Guests must be at least 48" tall and weigh less than 250 pounds.

Meet your Dive Masters and receive an introductory Scuba class (approx. 50 min) before boarding a boat to the dive site. Enjoy an open water scuba dive accompanied by your PADI Dive Instructor (approx. 45 min). Conclude your dive and return to the pier. **CL25 CABO DOLPHIN ENCOUNTER**

Ages 3 and up      1 to 1.5 hours      \$132 (ages 10 and up)      \$111 (ages 3 to 9)



Walk to the Cabo Dolphins Center and meet your trainer for a dolphin information session. Head into the pool to touch and pet a Pacific bottlenose dolphin (approx. 20 min). During the hands-on experience, learn some of the basics as the trainers demonstrate several techniques used to communicate with the dolphins. View your photos and walk back to the pier. Guests 3 to 7 years of age must be accompanied in the water by a paying and participating adult 18 and older, also booked on the Dolphin Encounter. **Please visit the Port Adventures Desk for additional booking information and requirements.**

**CL25A CABO DOLPHIN ENCOUNTER AT SAN JOSE**

Ages 3 and up      2.5 to 3 hours      \$132 (ages 10 and up)      \$111 (ages 3 to 9)



Drive to San Jose (approx. 30 min) and the Cabo Dolphins Center. Upon arrival, meet the dolphin trainers and receive an informative introduction to dolphins. Then, accompanied by a trainer, immerse yourself in a specially designed pool to touch and pet a Pacific bottlenose dolphin (approx. 20 min). Learn some of the basics ways the trainers use to communicate with the dolphins. Return back to the pier. This is not a swim with the dolphins experience. Expectant mothers may not participate.

**CL23 CABO DOLPHIN SWIM**

Ages 5 and up      1 to 1.5 hours      \$188 (ages 10 and up)      \$167 (ages 5 to 9)



Walk to the Cabo Dolphins Center to meet your trainer for a dolphin information session. Accompanied by a trainer, enjoy time swimming and interacting with the dolphins (approx. 40 min). Conclude your experience with a dorsal push, underwater ride, or belly ride across the pool. View your photos and travel back to the pier. Guests 5 to 10 years of age must be accompanied in the water by a paying and participating adult 18 and older, also booked on the Dolphin Swim excursion. **Please visit the Port Adventures Desk for additional booking information and requirements.**

**CL23A CABO DOLPHIN SWIM AT SAN JOSE**

Ages 5 and up      2.5 to 3 hours      \$188 (ages 10 and up)      \$167 (ages 5 to 9)



Drive to San Jose (approx. 30 min) and the Cabo Dolphins Center. Upon arrival, meet the dolphin trainers and receive an informative introduction to dolphins. Then, accompanied by a trainer, interact with the dolphins (approx. 40 min) in a specially designed pool. During the hands-on experience, learn some of the basic techniques used to communicate with the dolphins. Finally, get ready for the highlight of your experience, when your dolphin propels you across the pool (dorsal push, underwater ride, or belly ride). Return to the pier.

**CL04 CABO SAN LUCAS SPORT FISHING**

Board a 6-person cabin cruiser to your fishing spot (approx. 35 min). On this catch and release trip take turns reeling in the catch (approx. 3.5 hours). As soon as a fish bites, a crew member will set the hook and then hand the pole to you. Enjoy a boxed lunch and 3 beverages. Return to the pier.

**CL02 CABO DEL SOL GOLF**
