## FACTS TO KNOW

- The Guest Services Desk is open 24 hours, located Deck 3, to assist with your tour bookings when the Port Adventures Desk is closed.
- Guests are advised that all Port Adventures, pricing, itinerary, availability, duration and timing are subject to change without notice.
- Tour duration times are estimated and may vary considerably due to circumstances such as traffic or overcrowding of venues.
- Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase extras such as souvenirs.
- On Port Adventures that are stroller accessible, lightweight strollers are recommended.
- On certain tours, electric wheelchairs are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in electric scooters. Several tours are restricted for collapsible wheelchairs.
- You should never feel that gratuities are expected from you. However, it is customary to leave a few extra dollars in recognition of exceptional excursions guides and drivers. It is always up to you to determine the amount.
- For the consideration of your fellow Guests please ensure you are punctual for all Port Adventure meet times.
- Passports, with applicable VISA/ESTA, are required for any tour entering another country. It is mandatory for all Guests participating on this excursion to bring their government issued passport. This requirement is for Guests of All Ages. **Guests without passports will not be able to participate in these Port Adventures.**
- Although street and beach vendors may appear loud and pushy as they attempt to sell their goods to vacationing families, Guests should not feel in any way intimidated by this typical behavior.
- Guests that are prone to sea sickness should take precautionary measures before embarking their vessels.

## TRAVEL SAFETY TIPS

As in any tourist destination, you will want to take some basic precautions to make the most of your time ashore. Be aware of your surroundings, especially in crowded areas and avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators. Leave your valuables in your stateroom safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs. Cameras and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight. 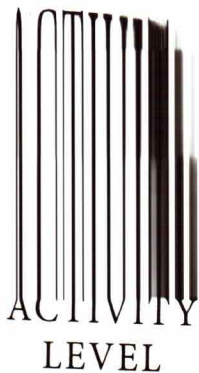

# CADIZ, SPAIN


## CD02 CADIZ CITY WALKING TOUR

 All Ages      3.5 to 4 Hours      \$35 (ages 10 and up)      \$26 (ages 3 to 9)



Take a walking tour through Cadiz, stopping at the Plaza de España, to see a massive monument commemorating the meeting of the Cortes in Cádiz. Pass the 17th-century San Felipe Neri Oratory, the Plaza San Antonio and the Plaza Mina. Stroll to Torre Tavira, the tallest and most significant watch tower and then proceed to the Camera Obscura for a unique view of the city projected on a screen within a dark room. Have free time to experience the sights, sounds and scents of the picturesque Plaza Flores. Arrive at the cathedral for an exterior visit. Walk through Pópulo, passing Town Hall, on your return to the pier.

## CD01 A TASTE OF CADIZ AND JEREZ

 All Ages (10+)      4 to 4.5 Hours      \$46 (ages 10 and up)      \$36 (ages 3 to 9)



Take a tour around Cadiz, passing the 18th-century baroque cathedral and the Plaza de España. Drive to the historic town of Jerez de la Frontera, home to dozens of wineries. View some of the most important landmarks of Jerez de la Frontera. Stop at Gonzalez Byass, Spain's most well-known sherry bodega, for a guided tour and wine-tasting. Sample 3 varieties of their renowned sherry wine. Return to the pier.


## CD10 WHITE VILLAGES OF ANDALUCIA

 All Ages      6 to 6.5 Hours      \$74 (ages 10 and up)      \$59 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel to Vejer de la Frontera for a guided walking tour of this national monument. Explore the cobblestone streets, passing the beautiful Plaza España. Have free time to explore on your own. Drive through La Breña y Marismas del Barbate Natural Park, on your way to the Cape of Trafalgar. Explore outside the lighthouse marking the bleak headland. Drive to Conil de la Frontera, a small town with narrow cobblestone streets, historical monuments, tapas bars and shops for free time. Drive back to the pier.


## CD09 BEEKEEPER FOR A DAY

 Ages 5 and Up      5 to 5.5 Hours      \$85 (ages 10 and up)      \$59 (ages 5 to 9)



Travel to Jerez (approx. 60 mins) and the Museum of Honey and Bees at Rancho Cortesano. Learn about the remarkable history of beekeeping, one of the oldest forms of food production, during an eye-opening guided visit. Gear up in a protective suit and gloves for an intimate glimpse at life inside a real beehive. Enjoy a cup of green tea or lemonade and a sampling of snacks during a relaxing break. Children will be invited to bottle their own honey pot and enjoy a bit of fun in the playground. Learn how to make candles out of beeswax and rosemary in a fun-filled experience. Receive a complimentary wax candle souvenir. Return to the pier.


## CD07 SEVILLE ON YOUR OWN

 All Ages      8 to 8.5 Hours      \$74 (ages 10 and up)      \$49 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel to Seville (approx. 105 mins) and receive a map of the area and a list of places of interest. Have 3 hours to explore the magnificent city of Seville at your very own pace. Discover the 14th-century royal palace of Alcazar, visit the resting place of Christopher Columbus, marvel at the luminous Capilla Mayor altar at the age-old cathedral or have a refreshment at a local cafeteria. Meet back with your guide and return to Cadiz and the pier.


## CD14 MOUNTAIN VILLAGES

 All Ages      5.5 to 6 Hours      \$67 (ages 10 and up)      \$52 (ages 3 to 9)



Drive through the Andalusian countryside to the village of Medina Sidonia (approx. 60 mins). Ascend the narrow cobblestone streets to the ruins of the medieval castle and fortress walls. Wander the delightful main square and admire in the Arab and Roman ruins that remain throughout town. Travel to Arcos de la Frontera (approx. 60 mins), one of the most picturesque white-washed villages of Spain. Tour Arcos, including a stop for a refreshment at the beautiful Parador Casa del Corregidor. Take the scenic route back to the pier.


## CD13 HIKING IN LA BREÑA NATURAL PARK

 Ages 10 and Up      5.5 to 6 Hours      \$91 (ages 10 and up)



Travel to Barbate (approx. 75 mins) near La Breña National Park. Hike along the stunning coastline bordered by pine forests, sand dunes, marshes and the gold-colored beaches of the Atlantic. Stop at Torre del Tajo and the watchtower before arriving at Los Caños de Meca, a sleepy Bohemian seaside village with sandy beaches. Head to the Cape of Trafalgar for free time and a refreshment. Return to the pier.


## CD20 WHALES AND DOLPHINS IN TARIFA

 All Ages      7 to 7.5 Hours      \$90 (ages 10 and up)      \$68 (ages 0 to 9)



Take a panoramic drive along the coast to Tarifa (approx. 105 mins). Board your boat for a trip to the Strait of Gibraltar. Enjoy the 1hr 30mins nature cruise and be on the lookout for a dolphin or a whale. At its most narrow point, the Strait of Gibraltar is only 11 kilometers wide. This region, where the Mediterranean Sea meets the Atlantic Ocean, has spectacular views of the Rif Mountains on the African Continent, across the water. Enjoy free time in Tarifa to have lunch on your own in one of the local restaurants. Return to Cadiz. NOTE: Animal views are not guaranteed.


## CD12 BIKE ADVENTURE AT LA BREÑA NATURAL PARK

 Ages 10 and Up      5.5 to 6 Hours      \$109 (ages 10 and up)



Drive to Vejer de la Frontera (approx. 75 mins) and gear up with a provided mountain bike and helmet. Take a 2-2.5-hour ride through the evergreen pine forests at La Breña y Marismas del Barbate Natural Park. La Breña has one of the most spectacular stretches of rocky cliffs along the Andalusian Atlantic coastline. At the internationally known Cape of Trafalgar, you will have free time to visit the lighthouse and enjoy a refreshment. Return to Cadiz and the pier.


## CD06 SEEING SEVILLE

 All Ages (8+)      8 to 8.5 Hours      \$145 (ages 10 and up)      \$106 (ages 3 to 9)



Drive to the city of Seville (approx. 2 hours) for a guided tour of the 12th-century gothic Seville Cathedral, the third largest church in Europe, home to the tomb of Christopher Columbus. Wander through a bevy of winding, narrow cobblestone streets and gaze upon myriad delightful, whitewashed houses during a walking tour of the Barrio de Santa Cruz. Visit the quaint Callejón del Agua and spend some time at the Hostería del Laurel for a beverage and snack. Have free time to explore the city on your own. Take a scenic drive through Seville before returning to Cadiz.

## CADIZ BY PRIVATE VEHICLE

Embark on an unforgettable excursion throughout Cadiz and surrounding areas, and experience the freedom of following your own itinerary at your own pace. # LISBON, PORTUGAL

## EXPLORE ALFAMA ON FOOT AND GLORIA FUNICULAR

**L102** All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$56 (ages 10 and up) \$36 (ages 3 to 9)

Drive to downtown Lisbon, passing Liberdade Avenue, Restauradores Square and the bustling Rossio area. Stop in Alfama, the oldest and most fascinating district of the city to begin your guided walking tour. Walk along the Rua Augusta to Praça do Comércio. Pass the landmarks of St. George Castle, the Lisbon Cathedral, St. Anthony Church and the Augusta Street Arch. Take a ride on the Gloria Funicular, inaugurated in 1885 and classified as a National Monument in 2002. Drive back to the pier.

## 4X4 EXPEDITION

**L104** Ages 12 and Up 4 to 4.5 Hours \$150 (ages 12 and up)

Travel by 4x4 to the historic town of Sintra (approx. 45 mins). Enjoy free time for shopping and sightseeing. Leave the paved roads behind and discover the hidden places of the Sintra Hills while plunging through mud and water, and through the lush vegetation of Sintra's National Park. Drive to Penedo, a typical country village, and then visit a wine lodge in Colares. Enjoy a wine tasting and a light snack. Stop at Fojo da Adraga, an impressive natural well dug out of the cliffs. Arrive at Cabo da Roca, the westernmost point of Mainland Europe, for a photo stop on cliffs that stand 467 feet above the sea. Return to the pier.

## LISBON CITY TOUR AND OCEANARIUM

**L105** All Ages 6.5 to 7 Hours \$135 (ages 10 and up) \$95 (ages 3 to 9)

Drive to the Belém Quarter for a photo stop at the Monument of Discoveries and the Belém Tower. Continue to the Jerónimos Monastery for inside visits. Travel through the town of Praça do Comércio on a scenic 30 minute drive to Alfama. Enjoy a Tapas style snack. Drive to Lisbon's Oceanarium, Europe's largest aquarium, for a visit (approx. 60 mins). Return to the pier.

## LISBON BY TRAM AND COACH

**L108 / L17** All Ages 4 Hours \$130 (ages 10 and up) \$95 (ages 3 to 9)

Drive to Estrela Square (approx. 30 mins) and board a traditional Portuguese tram for a ride passing the Parliament, the cathedral and the Santa Luzia Belvedere. Catch a glimpse of the Old City and the Tagus River while enjoying port wine and pastéis de Belém, a traditional Portuguese pastry. End at Blackhorse Square to start your panoramic tour to the Belém Quarter. Visit the Church of the Jerónimos Monastery before returning to the pier. **ALSO AN ADULT ONLY DEPARTURE.**

## LISBON HIGHLIGHTS

**L109 / L118** All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$55 (ages 10 and up) \$30 (ages 3 to 9)

Drive to Alfama, passing by Praça do Comércio, for a guided walking tour through Alfama, one of the oldest, most fascinating and characteristic quarters of Lisbon.
