#### **MAZATLAN OVERVIEW**

Historically Mazatlan was frequented by pirates who allegedly buried their loot in the coves along the coast. The town remained sparsely populated and was not incorporated until 1806 when a group of enterprising Germans settled here. Today, Mazatlán is involved in international trade as it has the largest shrimping fleet in Mexico.

Visitors will discover that Mazatlan is not as flashy as some of the other resort towns along Mexico's coast, so it maintains its character... ...while offering guests relaxation and entertainment in a pleasant seaside setting, with its magnificent 10 mile long ocean front highway and beachfront boardwalk. Getting around is fun and easy. Taxis are plentiful however they are not metered

so be sure to agree on a price beforehand. Watch out for the open air "Pulmonias" that are a transportation tradition!





#### RESTRICTIONS ON U.S. CURRENCY TRANSACTIONS IN MEXICO

In September of 2010, the Mexican government enacted a law limiting the amount of U.S. dollars a Mexican business or individual may deposit into their bank account. Because of this limitation, some of the recommended stores in port may restrict the amount of U.S. dollars they will accept in settlement of your purchases. Please remember to take your credit card into port so that you may be able to take advantage of all the bargains these stores have to offer.




