

Port Canaveral U.S. Customs and Border Protection Inspection

Thursday Morning

Dear Disney Magic Guest,

Please be reminded that **United States Customs and Border Protection Officials** require that **ALL GUESTS** present themselves for inspection by U.S. Officials upon arrival in Port Canaveral, Florida.

Please proceed to Port Canaveral Terminal Building via Deck 3, Midship no later than 9:00 am with your citizenship documentation.

U.S. Officials require that all family members (including children) are present for inspection.

All guests must present a Passport or Birth Certificate (accompanied with Photo ID). For non-US citizens please present your I-94 or I-94 W or Alien Resident Card.

Even if you are not going ashore for the day, you are still required to pass through inspection.

Guests not looking to go out for the day will not be able to reboard until all Guests have cleared immigration and the ship has been cleared by USCBP.

Please remember to pack essential items needed for the day if you are planning to visit the Walt Disney World Resort.

This procedure is a United States law that applies to all Guests and we appreciate your cooperation and understanding.
