





KEY WEST OVERVIEW

The U.S. government acquired Key West from Spain in the early 1800s. During those days, most of the isolated islanders made their living as wreckers and pirates, diving for the booty from ships that wrecked on the coral reefs offshore. In the mid-1800s, the economy turned to shrimping, fishing, sponging and cigar-making-with the help of Cuban dissidents who had fled their island and Spanish rule. In the 1920s much of the local economic base began to fade as the military left and the cigar industry moved northward to Tampa. In the early 1930's Key West was recognized as a resort town and hotels, restaurants and bars sprang up around the island. For about six months business was wonderful until a hurricane tore up the railroad and rendered the island helpless. The State of Florida and the Federal Government took over and began the work of rehabilitation, particularly directed toward development of tourist facilities and attractions. In 1940, the naval station was recommissioned. Now, the number one business here is tourism and a laid back kind of fun. With its balmy weather and crystal blue skies, the island is famous among the outdoors set for its diving, fishing, watersports and golfing. But only in Key West does the sun shine the brightest when it sets. Everyone gathers for the never planned, always varied Sunset Celebration on the Mallory Dock. Once the sun is safely tucked away by jugglers, mimes, musicians and street artists, the city moves to a different beat. A night beat. The streets, filled with sidewalk cafes, open air bars, legendary pubs and world-class restaurants, come alive. Visitors discover that modern Key West is a warmhearted place where all are welcome.





Safety Ashore Information

- Leave air transportation tickets and other travel documents in your room safe. When going ashore, each adult is required to carry a Driver's license, passport or other government-issued photo ID. Note: Some ports may require Guests to carry passports ashore.
- Most crimes are easier to commit in dark unlit areas. When going ashore at night, please be extra vigilant about your personal safety.
