



Tips for traveling with lithium metal and rechargeable lithium ion batteries

(Lithium batteries are typically used in cameras, phones, laptops, tablets, and personal electronics)

- Do not leave your devices unattended while charging, including when retiring.
- Do not leave batteries in chargers when not in use.
- Do not use batteries that have been punctured, swollen, or damaged in any way.
- When storing a battery-powered device, please store in the off position.
- Protect spare batteries by leaving them in their original packaging or using a battery case or a battery sleeve.
