
PORT OVERVIEW

Los Cabos (The Capes) is not actually a town. It is the name Mexican tourism officials bestowed upon two once-remote Baja California communities: Cabo San Lucas and San Jose del Cabo as well as the stretch of coast that connects them known as "the Corridor." Because the area was remote and difficult to reach, it remained the private hideaway of a few well-heeled travelers until the 1970s, when the Mexican government completed the Transpeninsular Highway. The highway gave Californians a straight shot to the tip of Baja California. It's one of the most popular destinations of the region and boasts fine beaches, luxurious surroundings, lively nightlife and some of the best sportfishing in the world.

Seafarers have long been attracted to the shores of what is now Los Cabos. In the late 16th-century and early 17th-century, according to legend, notorious pirates such as Sir Francis Drake and Thomas Cavendish concealed themselves in the bays and coves along the southern coast of the Baja Peninsula, slipping out to ambush passing Spanish galleons.

In the past few years, swanky new hotels and condos have filled the landscape along the 20 mile corridor separating the two towns. Superb sport fishing put Cabo San Lucas on the map, but nonfishermen will enjoy the thriving beach community as well. The Coastal Highlights tour highlights dramatic desert terrain and showcases resort developments.




Buyer's Guarantee

Because of this limitation, some of the recommended stores in port may restrict the amount of U.S. dollars they will accept in settlement of your purchases. Please remember to take your credit card into port so that you may be able to take advantage of all the bargains these stores have to offer.

Safety Ashore Information

While you will find many great experiences ashore, please remain vigilant about your personal safety and the safety of your belongings. As in any large urban tourist destination, you'll want to take some basic precautions to make the most of your time ashore.

• Be aware of your surroundings at all times. Avoid short cuts, narrow alleys and poorly lit streets.

Avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators.

• Identity/Credit Card theft can occur anywhere. Please remain vigilant in monitoring the safe keeping of your personal information.

Leave valuables in your room safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs. Cameras
and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight.

Leave air transportation tickets and other travel documents in your room safe. When going ashore, each adult is required to carry
a Driver's license, passport or other government-issued photo ID. – Note: Some ports may require Guests to carry passports ashore.
