MARVEL STUDIOS 10 YEARS OF FANDOM SWEEPSTAKES – PHASE 2 OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY. A PURCHASE WILL NOT ENHANCE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. MANY WILL ENTER, FEW WILL WIN.

1. Eligibility: The Marvel Studios 10 Years Of Fandom Sweepstakes – Phase 2 ("Sweepstakes") is only open to entrants who, at the time of entry, are: (a) natural persons who are legal residents of one of the 50 United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, or Canada (excluding Quebec), (b) 13 years of age or older, and (c) members of Disney Movie Rewards Loyalty Program ("DMR"). If an entrant is a minor, as defined by the jurisdiction of the entrant's primary residence ("Minor"), permission of a parent or guardian is required to participate in the Sweepstakes. Entrants must not be an employee or director, or IRS dependent, immediate family member or individual residing in the same household of, an employee or director, of Buena Vista Home Entertainment, Inc. ("BVHE"), its parent, and any subsidiaries, related and affiliated companies of each, Prize Logic, LLC, or their respective parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies, advertising, promotion, or production agencies, web masters, web suppliers and any prize provider. Void where prohibited by law and subject to all applicable federal, state, provincial, municipal, territorial, and local laws and regulations. Participation constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to these official rules ("Official Rules") and Sponsor's and Administrator's decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes. Non-winning entries in Entry Period 1 do not carry forward to Entry Period 2. Entry Period 1 and Entry

Period 2 will consist of two entirely separate entry pools. Sponsor's computer is the Sweepstakes' official clock.

5. How to Enter: As noted in the eligibility requirements set forth in Section 1, you must be a member of DMR at the time of entry to enter the Sweepstakes. If you are not a member of DMR you may become a member by visiting <http://www.disneymovierewards.go.com/promotions/sweepstakes/marvel10sweeps> (the "DMR Website"). Membership is free. You must register for each Entry Period of the Sweepstakes initially through the DMR Website. Standard internet access and usage charges imposed by your online service provider will apply. Once you are logged into your DMR member account, you may enter the Sweepstakes by navigating to the "Sweepstakes" tab and following the links and instructions to enter. Once you click where indicated, you will automatically receive 1 entry into the Sweepstakes drawing.

6. Additional Sweepstakes Entries Using DMR points: After entering the Sweepstakes as described above, you may redeem DMR points for up to 99 additional Sweepstakes entries during an Entry Period. For each additional Sweepstakes entry you will receive 1 additional entry into the Sweepstakes drawing. For each additional entry you redeem, 5 DMR points will be deducted from your account. To redeem DMR points for Sweepstakes entries, visit the DMR Website and follow the online instructions to select the number of additional entries into the Sweepstakes you wish to earn using DMR points. Free Alternate Method of Entry for Additional Sweepstakes Entries: To receive up to 99 additional Sweepstakes entries into the applicable Entry Period drawing without redeeming DMR points hand print your name, address, day and evening phone numbers, the e-mail address associated with your DMR account, your age, and the current Entry Period (i.e. "Entry Period 1" or "Entry Period 2") on a 3½" x 5" card and mail it with proper postage to Marvel Studios 10 Years Of Fandom Sweepstakes – Phase 2, P.O. Box 1029, Neenah, WI 54956-1029. Entries must be postmarked by the Entry Period End Date for the applicable Entry Period. You will be entered into the Entry Period 1 time for each 3½" x 5" card received by the Entry Period's Mail-In Entry Deadline, for up to 99 mail-in entries. Mail-in entries mailed in an envelope will not be accepted. All mail-in entries must be handwritten. Mechanical reproductions will not be accepted. Proof of sending or mailing of mail-in entries will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by Sponsor. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, illegible, misdirected or postage-due mail-in entries, which will be disqualified.

7. General Conditions on Entry: Once submitted, all entries become the exclusive property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned, nor will any correspondence be exchanged with any entrant. Limit: An entrant may receive up to 100 Sweepstakes entries in total during an Entry Period through a combination of the methods described above. Limit 1 prize per entrant/household during the entire Sweepstakes Period. Multiple entrants are not permitted to share the same e-mail address. Any attempt by any entrant to obtain more than the stated number of entries by using multiple/different e-mail addresses, identities, registrations, logins, or any other methods will void entrant's entries and that entrant will be disqualified. Any use of any micro, robotic, automatic, programmed, or like entry methods will void all such entries affected by such methods and entrants using such methods will be disqualified. 8. Winner Selection: The odds of winning a Sweepstakes prize depend on the number of eligible entries received during the applicable Entry Period. Administrator is an independent judging organization whose decisions regarding the administration and operation of the Sweepstakes and the selection of the potential winners are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes. Administrator will randomly select 10 potential Entry Period 1 prize winners (each, an “Entry Period 1 Prize Winner”) from among all eligible entries received during Entry Period 1, on or around August 20, 2018. Administrator will randomly select 1 potential “Entry Period 2 Prize Winner” from among all eligible entries received during Entry Period 2, on or around November 19, 2018.

Each potential winner will be notified by mail, e-mail and/or telephone. If any potential winner cannot be contacted, fails to execute and return all documentation within the required time, fails to pass a skill test (Canadian residents only – see Section 11 for more details), is found to be ineligible or is non-compliant with the Official Rules for any reason, then the potential winner forfeits the prize and Administrator may select another potential prize winner, as time permits. In the event that a potential winner is disqualified for any reason, Sponsor will award the prize to an alternate winner selected by random drawing from among all remaining eligible entries. Within 2 to 3 weeks from verification of the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner, the Sponsor’s designee will contact the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner to book Entry Period 2 Prize travel. If the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner is a minor in his/her state, province or territory of residence, then the Sponsor’s designee will contact the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner’s parent/legal guardian to book Entry Period 2 Prize travel.

1 ENTRY PERIOD 2 PRIZE: The 1 Entry Period 2 Prize Winner will receive will receive a 5-Night Bahamian Disney Cruise Line vacation including Marvel Day at Sea for four persons (Entry Period 2 Prize Winner and 3 guests) to be taken aboard the Disney Magic (“Entry Period 2 Prize”). The 5-Night Cruise shall consist of the following:

2) Vacation is for the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner and up to 3 "Guests" of the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner's choosing.

3) Each Guest must be at least 18 or the age of majority in his/her jurisdiction of residence, unless such Guest is the child or legal ward of the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner. If a Guest is a minor and not the child or legal ward of the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner, the parent/legal guardian of such Guest must also accompany the minor Guest. Any minor child must be accompanied at all times by his/her parent/legal guardian who is at least twenty-one (21) years of age. Entry Period 2 Prize Winner and all Guests must travel together on specified itinerary. All travel dates and arrangements are subject to change based on availability and providers approval. Any portion of the Entry Period 2 Prize not accepted by Entry Period 2 Prize Winner will be forfeited.

Please note: The Entry Period 2 Prize Winner will not receive difference between actual and approximate retail value. Sponsor will determine airline and flight itinerary in its sole discretion. Tickets issued in conjunction with this Sweepstakes have zero cash value. No refund or compensation will be made in the event of the cancellation or delay of any flight. Travel may not be permitted on any dates other than listed above. All travel dates are subject to approval by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Positive identification will be required at time of check-in. Checked luggage fees may apply, fees are charged each way, and are subject to change. Changes to reservations, once made, are not permitted. A per ticket surcharge will apply for paper tickets issued in markets where electronic ticketing is available. Substitutions will not be allowed. Federal, state, provincial, territorial, and local taxes and all other expenses not specified herein are the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner's sole responsibility. Should the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner elect to travel with fewer than 3 Guests, no additional compensation will be provided.

The Entry Period 2 Prize Winner and his/her Guests hereby acknowledge that Sponsor has not and will not obtain or provide travel insurance or any other form of insurance for any part of the Entry Period 2 Prize. It is the responsibility of the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner and his/her Guests to arrive at the designated gateway airport in time for each flight that is part of the Entry Period 2 Prize. The Entry Period 2 Prize Winner and his/her Guests shall be subject to all terms and conditions printed on any ticket issued in conjunction with the Entry Period 2 Prize. In the event the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner and/or Guest(s) is denied entry into any ticketed location or is removed or barred from any ticketed location for any other reason, Sponsor is not responsible and no further compensation or award will be provided

Additional Terms and Conditions: Prizes may not be declined once awarded to and accepted by a winner. Prizes may not be bartered, transferred, sold, or redeemed for cash value in whole or in part. Sponsor, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to substitute a listed prize for one of equal or greater value if the designated prize should become unavailable for any reason or unreasonably difficult to fulfill. Winners must pay all applicable taxes and fees for prizes accepted.

10. Limitations on Liability: By entering, entrants agree that Sponsor, Administrator, and their respective parents, subsidiaries and affiliated companies, advertising and promotion agencies, and all of their respective officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents (collectively "Released Parties") will have no liability whatsoever, and shall be released and held harmless by entrants, for any injuries, claims, losses or damages of any kind to persons, including death, or property resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from acceptance, possession, misuse or use of any prize or participation in this Sweepstakes or participation in any Sweepstakes-related activity, or entrant's failure to comply with the Official Rules. The Released Parties shall not be liable to any winner or any other person for failure to supply any prize(s) or any part thereof, by reason of any acts of God, any action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-governmental entity (whether or not the action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) prove(s) to be invalid), equipment failure, terrorist acts, earthquake, war, fire, flood, explosion, unusually severe weather, hurricane, embargo, labor dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal), labor or material shortage, transportation interruption of any kind, work slow-down, civil disturbance, insurrection, riot, or any other cause beyond the Released Parties' control. The Released Parties are not responsible for illegible, lost, late, damaged, incomplete, misdirected, or stolen entries; or for typographical or other errors in the offer or administration of this Sweepstakes, including but not limited to: errors in advertising, Official Rules, selection and announcement of the winners and distribution of prize; or for lost, interrupted or unavailable network, server, satellite, Internet Service Provider (ISP), website or other connections, availability or accessibility; or for miscommunications, failed computer, telephone or cable transmissions, lines, or technical failure; or jumbled, corrupted, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected transmissions, computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties; or for any other errors of any kind whether human, mechanical, electronic, technical or network; or for the incorrect or inaccurate capture of entry or other information or the failure to capture any such information; or for any misdirection or delay of any e-mail to be received on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet, DMR Website, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation in or downloading or uploading any materials in connection with the Sweepstakes; or for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by site users, tampering, hacking, or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Sweepstakes; or for any personal injury, death, or

damage to or loss of property, arising out of receipt or use or misuse of any prize produced and/or manufactured by a prize provider or other third party.

11. General Conditions: Persons who tamper with or abuse any aspect of the Sweepstakes as solely determined by Sponsor, will be disqualified, and Sponsor reserves the right to terminate such entrant's eligibility. Sponsor may also disqualify any person that acts in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person or for any other good cause reason solely determined by Sponsor. Should any portion of the Sweepstakes be, in Sponsor's sole opinion, compromised by virus, worms, bugs, non-authorized human intervention or other causes which, in the sole opinion of Sponsor, corrupt or impair the administration, security, fairness or proper play, or submission of entries, Sponsor reserves the right at its sole discretion to suspend, modify or terminate the Sweepstakes, and select winners from entries received prior to action taken or as otherwise deemed fair and appropriate by Sponsor. In the event of a dispute regarding prize claims or entries received from multiple users having the same address, the authorized subscriber of the address at the time of entry used to enter, and not the name on the entry form, will be deemed to be the entrant and must comply with these Official Rules. Authorized account subscriber is the natural person who is assigned the address by the Internet Service Provider (ISP), on-line service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses.

Except where legally prohibited, each winner grants (and agrees to confirm in writing) permission for the Released Parties to use his/her name, photograph, voice, likeness, and/or statements made by, or attributed to a winner in all media now known or hereafter discovered, worldwide, including, without limitation, on the World Wide Web, without notice, review or approval or compensation and in perpetuity. To claim a prize, the winner (or if a Minor, Minor's parent or legal guardian) may be required to sign and return to Administrator, within 10 days of the date the notice is sent an affidavit of eligibility, liability release, publicity release (if winner is a Canadian resident, a declaration of compliance) and other paperwork. If a potential winner is a Canadian resident, he/she will be required to correctly answer a time-limited skill testing question without any assistance in order to be eligible to receive the prize or the prize will be forfeited. The Entry Period 2 Prize Winner's Guests (or if a Minor, Minor's parent or legal guardian) may also be required to sign and return a liability and/or publicity release(s) and other paperwork at the same time the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner returns his/her affidavit of eligibility, liability release, publicity release (if the Entry Period 2 Prize Winner is a Canadian resident, the declaration of compliance) and other paperwork.

If any prize notification or prize is returned as non-deliverable, the prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner may be selected as further described in Section 8 above. Noncompliance with any of the foregoing or any portion of these Official Rules may result in disqualification and awarding of the prize to an alternate winner. Federal, state, provincial, territorial, and local taxes and all other expenses not specified herein are winner's sole responsibility. If a winner is a U.S. resident, he/she may receive an IRS Form 1099 reflecting the actual value of his/her prize. Sponsor may assign all rights granted by entrants and winners hereunder to any party at Sponsor's sole discretion.

12. Disputes/Choice of Law: Except where prohibited, entrant agrees that: (a) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Sweepstakes shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan (Southern Division) or the appropriate Michigan State Court located in Oakland County, Michigan, U.S.A. except as to any and all disputes, claims and

causes of action relating to the fulfillment and use of the Entry Period 2 Prize; (b) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Sweepstakes, but in no event attorneys' fees; and (c) under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim, indirect, punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased.
