- The Guest Services Desk is open 24 hours, located Deck 3, to assist with your tour bookings when the Port Adventures Desk is closed.
- Some excursions may not be appropriate for expectant mothers and Guests under medication or Guests who have previous or current heart, neck or back injuries.
- Guests are advised that all Port Adventures, pricing, itinerary, availability, duration and timing are subject to change without notice.
- Tour duration times are estimated and may vary considerably due to circumstances such as traffic or overcrowding of venues.
- Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase extras such as souvenirs.
- On certain tours, electric wheelchairs are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in electric scooters. Several tours are restricted for collapsible wheelchairs.
- On Port Adventures that are stroller accessible, lightweight strollers are recommended.
- You should never feel that gratuities are expected from you. However, it is customary to leave a few extra dollars in recognition of exceptional excursions guides and drivers. It is always up to you to determine the amount.
- For the consideration of your fellow Guests please ensure you are punctual for all Port Adventure meet times.
- Passports, with applicable VISA/ESTA, are required for any tour entering another country. It is mandatory for all Guests participating on this excursion to bring their government issued passport. This requirement is for Guests of All Ages. **Guests without passports will not be able to participate in these Port Adventures.**

Mild These excursions involve periods of walking for short distances over relatively level surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestone and limited steps. Standing or sitting for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Boarding tour vehicles via gangway or steps will be required. Distance from gangway to tour vehicle will vary port to port.




























Moderate Uneven/steep terrain or water activity in slight current. These excursions are fairly active and involve periods of walking over even and uneven surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestones, steps, and in some cases steep terrain. Standing for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Moderate water activities involve extended periods in a slight current, and may require climbing a ladder during beach or swimming stops.

Active Good physical condition required. These excursions are considered active and may involve constant effort or extended periods of walking long distances, numerous steps, inclines, cobblestone surfaces, and other rough terrain throughout the excursion. Participants should be in good physical condition to fully enjoy these excursions.

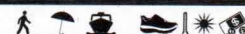
SYMBOLS

-  **GUESTS MUST BE AMBULATORY** Wheelchairs (collapsible or electric) are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in wheelchairs or electric scooters.

CK18 SPIKE ISLAND DISCOVERY

All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$45 (ages 10 and up) \$34 (ages 3 to 9)



Board a boat to nearby Spike Island. Learn about its history and settlements on this guided tour of the island (approx. 70 min) with a history of monks, pirates and convicts. Enjoy free time on the island (approx. 1 hour). Return to the boat for your journey back to Cobh where you're on your own to explore Cobh Town or make your way back to the ship.

CK03 CHARLES FORT ADVENTURE

All Ages 4.5 to 5 Hours \$54 (ages 10 and up) \$39 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Summercove (approx. 60 min) and Charles Fort, a 17th century, star-shaped fort. Tour the fort (approx. 75 min) including an "Army Jobs Trail" for children exploring working life of those living at the fort at the time. This is a fun challenge for children of all ages. Continue on to Kinsale, where bodies from the tragic RMS Lusitania were brought in 1915. Enjoy free time exploring original 18th-century buildings, including Desmond Castle. Return to the pier.

CK10/CK24 KINSALE AND CORK'S COUNTRYSIDE

Travel via coach to Kinsale (approx. 75 min) with photo stops along the way. Explore Kinsale (approx. 30 min). Return to Cork, stopping at Charles Fort for photos of views over Kinsale Harbour. Return to the ship. ADULT ONLY and SMALL GROUP DEPARTURES ALSO AVAILABLE.

CK07 CORK CITY AND UNIVERSITY TOUR

All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$59 (ages 10 and up) \$44 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Cork, the second largest city in the Republic of Ireland. Travel though the city on a 30-minute narrated drive past Merchant's Quay, St. Patrick's Street, Grand Parade, the Mall and City Hall. Head to University College Cork for a guided tour of the university grounds, a brief history of the college and time for photos. Continue to The Bridge Bar for a beverage of your choice. Return to the ship.

CK01 A STROLL THROUGH SUMMERCOVE

All Ages 4.5 to 5 Hours \$68 (ages 10 and up) \$49 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Kinsale (approx. 60 min) before stopping for photos at Charles Fort, a 17th century, star-shaped fort. Arrive in Summercove for a walking tour before stopping for light refreshments at The Spaniard Pub. Head to Kinsale for free time (approx. 60 min) before heading back to the ship.

CK08 CORK CITY DRIVE AND WHISKEY CENTRE

All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$69 (ages 10 and up) \$52 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Cork, the second largest city in the Republic of Ireland, and start your narrated drive (approx. 45 min) down Merchant's Quay, St. Patrick's Street, Grand Parade, the Mall and City Hall. Travel to Midleton and the Jameson Distillery. Your guided tour explores the distillery's historic buildings, where you will view Old Midleton's restored machinery, displays of period photographs and recreations of the distilling process. CK02/CK23 A VISIT TO BLARNEY CASTLE

Travel via coach to Blarney Village (approx. 45 min) and Blarney Castle, a romantic ruin from 1446. Upon choosing, and time permitting, climb to the top of the castle for the view and to see the Blarney Stone, and if the wait isn't too long, participate in the tradition of kissing the Blarney Stone. Enjoy free time before heading to Christy's Bar or the Mills Hotel for an Irish coffee before visiting the Blarney Woolen Mill shop. Return to the pier. ADULT ONLY DEPARTURE ALSO AVAILABLE.

CK22 WHISKEY TALK, TASTING AND CORK CITY TOUR

Ages 21 and Up 4 to 4.5 Hours \$97 (ages 21 and up)



Travel via coach to Cork (approx. 30 min) and arrive at the Bridge Bar for a presentation by Jameson Distillery to learn and sample a variety of whiskeys. Take a narrated drive down Merchant's Quay, St. Patrick's Street, Grand Parade, the Mall and City Hall. Enjoy self-exploration (approx. 45 min) before returning to the ship.

CK20 TITANIC STORY WALKING TOUR

All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$99 (ages 10 and up) \$75 (ages 3 to 9)



Start your walking tour (approx. 3 hours) of Cork Harbor and head to the pier where the RMS Titanic begin its journey on April 11, 1912. See the preserved offices of the White Star and Cunard Lines before heading into town with your guide. Visit St. Colman's Cathedral and a traditional pub to enjoy a traditional Irish coffee. Walk back to Cork for an interactive encounter at the Titanic Experience. Following your tour of the Titanic Experience, you'll have free time to explore Cork and return to the ship on your own.

CK25 KINSALE AND CORK'S COUNTRYSIDE SMALL GROUP DEPARTURE

All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$109 (ages 10 and up) \$79 (ages 3 to 9)



In your small group, travel via coach to Kinsale (approx. 75 min) with photo stops along the way. Explore Kinsale (approx. 30 min). Return to Cork, stopping at Charles Fort for photos of views over Kinsale Harbour. Return to the ship.

CK26 CORK CITY DRIVE AND WHISKEY CENTRE - SMALL GROUP DEPARTURE

All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$120 (ages 10 and up) \$91 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Cork, the second largest city in the Republic of Ireland, and start your narrated drive (approx. 45 min) down Merchant's Quay, St. Patrick's Street, Grand Parade, the Mall and City Hall. 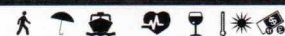

Arrive at the 19th century Muckross House for exploration (approx. 1 hour). If there is availability, you may choose to independently join an inside house tour. Drive to Killarney for lunch and self-exploration. Return to the pier.

CK09 CORK HARBOR SEA SAFARI

Ages 12 and Up 3 to 3.5 Hours \$129 (ages 12 and up)



Don a lifejacket, receive a safety briefing and board your 12-person Rigid Inflatable Boat to explore Cork Harbor at high speed. Learn about the town, the harbor and local marine and birdlife as you tour the scenic coastal areas. Stop for an Irish coffee-making demonstration, a cocktail of sweetened coffee and Jameson whiskey. CK13 FAMILY FUN DISCOVERY AT FOTA

Travel via coach to Fota Island, a sprawling 780-acre isle that sits in Cork Harbor. Stop at Fota House to uncover the conundrum of Mrs. Kevin's missing cat. Families will enjoy a children's tour through the House with a dedicated guide, solving the kitten's disappearance by learning about the House and the people who lived here. Enjoy a cup of tea or coffee while the kids enjoy a cookie. Travel to the Fota Wildlife Park and explore. Return to the pier.

CK21 WATERFORD, COUNTRY AND CRYSTAL

All Ages 8 to 8.5 Hours \$139 (ages 10 and up) \$104 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Waterford (approx. 2 hours) and a brief tour of the city before heading to the House of Waterford Crystal. See a reconstruction of the manufacturing process and get an idea of how the original factory worked—from the making of wooden molds to the artisanal glass-making process. Stop at the gallery showroom and enjoy free time to browse among the world's largest display of Waterford crystal, giftware, craft and jewelry collections. Enjoy lunch at a local hotel before heading to Lismore for a castle photo opportunity. Return to the ship.

CK12 EXPLORING TIPPERARY

All Ages 8 to 8.5 Hours \$145 (ages 10 and up) \$108 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Cashel via the zig-zag road, The Vee—a gap in the Knockmealdown Mountains. Stop at the Rock of Cashel and explore the settlement (approx. 1 hour). Enjoy lunch at a nearby restaurant before heading to Cahir Castle, located on the River Suir. Explore the town of Cahir. Travel through the Irish countryside on your way back to the ship.

CK16 WALKING TOUR OF CORK HARBOUR INLETS

Ages 13 and Up 4 to 4.5 Hours \$149 (ages 13 and up)



Travel via coach to the south eastern side of Cork Harbour to start your 3-hour guided walking tour following along an old railway line. Arrive at The Marina, home to the new Gaelic football and hurling stadium that hosts 2 traditional Irish sports. Trek along the banks of the river to Blackrock Castle, built in the 1600s to deter pirates. Stop for a refreshment and sweet treat in the Castle Café situated on the banks of the River Lee. Travel via coach to Blarney Castle estate (approx. 45 min) and start your tour with a short walk through the arboretums and gardens, passing the river Blarney and other stunning features in the estate. Embark on a guided tour of the house and learn the magical history of this famous home. In the stunning dining room, with views of Blarney Castle in the distance, relax with tea or coffee and homemade scones. Explore independently before re-boarding your motor coach. Return to the ship.

CK11 CYCLE THROUGH CORK CITY

Head to the Ballymaloe House for your 3-course lunch before taking an informative, historical tour of the house. Browse The Ballymaloe Shop before returning to the ship.

CK05 BEHIND THE SCENES OF MIDDLETON DISTILLERY

Ages 21 and Up 4.5 to 5 Hours \$269 (ages 21 and up)



Travel via coach to Cork, the second largest city in the Republic of Ireland, and begin your narrated tour (approx. 60 min) passing Merchant's Quay, St. Patrick's Street, Grand Parade, the Mall and City Hall. Your guide will point out the city's elegant Georgian architecture. Continue to Midleton and the Jameson Distillery for your behind-the-scenes tour including lesser seen buildings on the site, such as the Distiller's Cottage, Cooperage and the Micro Distillery. Taste 3 different premium whiskey samples, a glass of Jameson Original or Jameson Ginger and Lime. Browse the gift shop for Jameson memorabilia before returning to the pier.

CK19

STAR WARS ADVENTURE - A SKELLIG ISLAND FLYOVER



Ages 3 and Up 5 to 5.5 Hours \$3749 (ages 10 and up) \$3749 (ages 3 to 9)



Depart the pier and travel to nearby Fota Wildlife Park to meet up with your helicopter pilot to embark on a privately guided aerial adventure over Skellig Michael in a twin engine executive helicopter. After your aerial tour of the island, fly north to the Dingle Peninsula on the Irish mainland. See Sybil Head, the location of the Jedi Temple set that Lucasfilm constructed on the cliff's edge, high above the Atlantic Ocean. Fly to Dunmore Head's staggering sea views and another film location from The Last Jedi. Spend approximately 5 hours on this adventure, including about 2 hours of flight time. Enjoy free time at the Skellig Visitor Center followed by lunch and a chance to pull your own pint of Guinness (21 and older).

Continue past Merrion and Fitzwilliam squares, and stop for photos at the famous Dublin Doors. Pass the National Gallery of Ireland, Government Buildings and St. Stephen's Green. See Dublin Castle, City Hall, Christ Church Cathedral and St. Patrick's Cathedral. Arrive at Guinness Storehouse for a self-guided tour of the Storehouse. Discover what goes into making a pint of the "black stuff", learn the company's dramatic history, and spend some time in the Advertising Gallery.
