The ship will dock at the main pier at the Joan Harriss Cruise Pavilion, look out for the large Fiddle alongside.



#### **PORT OVERVIEW**

Sydney is making the most of its rich history and its position as the major city and gateway to the beautiful Cape Breton Island. British loyalists fleeing the American Revolution founded the town in 1785, and the settlement soon prospered from its rich natural resources. In its industrial heyday, jobs in the steel factories and coal mines attracted settlers from many lands, including many who emigrated from the Scottish Highlands. Their influence is still evident. Cape Breton is one of the rare places in North America where Gaelic is still spoken, and Celtic music is heard everywhere. Visitors can have their photos taken just outside the cruise terminal with the world's largest fiddle, a 50-foot reminder of this musical heritage.



By the early 20th century Sydney became home to one of the world's largest steel plants, fed by the numerous coal mines in the area.

The name Nova Scotia is Latin for "New Scotland," reflecting the origins of some of the early settlers.

#### Travel Safety Tips

As in any tourist destination, you will want to take some basic precautions to make the most of your time ashore.

- Be aware of your surroundings, especially in crowded areas.
- Avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators.
- Leave your valuables in your stateroom safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs.
- Cameras and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight. People who carry handbags
  or backpacks are particularly vulnerable to purse snatchers on scooters.
- When going ashore, each adult is required to carry a Driver's license, passport or other government-issued photo ID. Note: Some ports may require Guests to carry passports ashore.
- In general, use the same level of precaution you would use in any tourist destination.
