FACTS TO KNOW

- The Guest Services Desk is open 24 hours, located Deck 3, to assist with your tour bookings when the Port Adventures Desk is closed.
- Guests are advised that all Port Adventures, pricing, itinerary, availability, duration and timing are subject to change without notice.
- Tour duration times are estimated and may vary considerably due to circumstances such as traffic or overcrowding of venues.
- Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase extras such as souvenirs.
- On Port Adventures that are stroller accessible, lightweight strollers are recommended.
- On certain tours, electric wheelchairs are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in electric scooters. Several tours are restricted for collapsible wheelchairs.
- You should never feel that gratuities are expected from you. However, it is customary to leave a few extra dollars in recognition of exceptional excursions guides and drivers. It is always up to you to determine the amount.
- For the consideration of your fellow Guests please ensure you are punctual for all Port Adventure meet times.
- Passports, with applicable VISA/ESTA, are required for any tour entering another country. It is mandatory for all Guests participating on this excursion to bring their government issued passport. This requirement is for Guests of All Ages. **Guests without passports will not be able to participate in these Port Adventures.**
- Although street and beach vendors may appear loud and pushy as they attempt to sell their goods to vacationing families, Guests should not feel in any way intimidated by this typical behavior.
- Guests that are prone to sea sickness should take precautionary measures before embarking their vessels.

TRAVEL SAFETY TIPS

As in any tourist destination, you will want to take some basic precautions to make the most of your time ashore. Be aware of your surroundings, especially in crowded areas and avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators. Leave your valuables in your stateroom safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs. Cameras and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight. People who carry handbags or backpacks are particularly vulnerable to purse snatchers on scooters. Guests should take their passport with them when ashore. If a passport check is required by local authorities, photo copies are no longer a valid form of identification. In general, use the same level of precaution you would use in any tourist destination. Please remember that while in a foreign country, you are subject to its laws.

Cancellations can be made up to 3 days prior to cruise departure date. After that time all reservations are final and non-refundable. All prices are subject to change without notice.







SECURITY NOTICE

All Guests (including children) who wish to disembark or embark the ship are required to present their Key to the World card at the gangway. A photo ID is also required for those Guests who are 18 years of age and older.

PORT ADVENTURE ACTIVITY LEVEL

 **Mild** These excursions involve periods of walking for short distances over relatively level surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestone and limited steps. Standing or sitting for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Boarding tour vehicles via gangway or steps will be required. Distance from gangway to tour vehicle will vary port to port.


 **Moderate** Uneven/steep terrain or water activity in slight current. These excursions are fairly active and involve periods of walking over even and uneven surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestones, steps, and in some cases steep terrain. Standing for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Moderate water activities involve extended periods in a slight current, and may require climbing a ladder during beach or swimming stops.


 **Active** Good physical condition required. These excursions are considered active and may involve constant effort or extended periods of walking long distances, numerous steps, inclines, cobblestone surfaces, and other rough terrain throughout the excursion. Participants should be in good physical condition to fully enjoy these excursions.

CZ81 MAYAN CHOCOLATE EXPERIENCE & ISLAND TOUR

🚶 All Ages 3 to 3.5 hours \$47 (Ages 10 and up) \$36 (Ages 3 to 9)

Travel to **The Mayan Cacao Company** for a **chocolate workshop** (approx. 60 mins) including tastings and demonstrations. Explore the on-site Mayan housing replication and botanical gardens. Continue with a **scenic drive** around the island of Cozumel with a photo stop at **El Mirador**. Return to the pier.

CZ22 OCEAN VIEW EXPLORER TOUR

🚶 All Ages 2 to 2.5 hours \$49 (Ages 10 and up) \$38 (Ages 0 to 9)

Travel via taxi to the boat dock where the Ocean View Explorer submarine is waiting. Board the semi-submarine and sit **4 feet below the water's surface** for an underwater tour of **Paradise Reef** (approx. 75 min). Return to the pier by taxi.

CZ25 DOLPHIN DISCOVERY OBSERVER, LUNCH, DRINKS AND BEACH

🚶 All Ages 3 to 3.5 hours \$51 (Ages 3 and up)

Travel via taxi to **Chankanaab National Park**, home of Dolphin Discovery (approx. 20 min), for orientation and observe your family member or friend approximately 90 to 110 feet away (approx. 40 min). Enjoy free time at Chankanaab National Park including a sea lion show, beach, pool, gardens and archaeological site replicas. Return to the pier via taxi on your own (included in the price of the tour).

CZ41 DOLPHIN OBSERVER AT DOLPHINARIS - ALL INCLUSIVE

🚶 All Ages 3.5 to 4 hours \$54 (Ages 10 and up) \$51 (Ages 3 to 9)

This excursion should only be booked in conjunction with one of the following excursions: **Dolphin Swim** at **Dolphinaris** or **Dolphin Kids** at **Dolphinaris** (Based on Availability). Travel to **Dolphinaris** and head to a scenic and secluded area to watch your loved ones participate in one of the many dolphin programs. Have lunch and a drink, snorkel or do water activities such as kayaking or paddle-boarding. Return to the pier. Guests must be at least 5 years or older for snorkeling and 10 years of age or older for kayaking or stand-up paddle-boarding (first-come, first-served, based on availability).

CZ64 EVERYBODY LOVES RAYS!

🚶 Ages 4 and up 3 to 3.5 hours \$57 (Ages 10 and up) \$21 (Ages 4 to 9)

Travel to **Stingray Beach** for a safety briefing about the stingrays. Enter the water for your stingray encounter where you will get to **pet the stingrays** (approx. 30 min) and then head to the **Seaside Club** for beach time on your own (approx. 60 min). Travel back to the ship.

CZ80 COZUMEL RUINS, CHOCOLATE AND BEACH BREAK

🚶 All Ages 5 to 5.5 hours \$60 (Ages 10 and up) \$47 (Ages 3 to 9)

Travel to the **ruins of San Gervasio** (approx. 30 mins) where your guide will tell you the history of the goddess Ixchel and you'll have time to explore (approx. 60 mins). Continue on a scenic drive around Cozumel to **The Mayan Cacao Company** for a **chocolate workshop** (approx. 45 mins.) Drive to **Playa Mia Beach** for beach time (approx. 90 mins.) 🚶 Ages 21 and up 2.5 to 3 hours \$60 (Ages 21 and up)

Have a **taco buffet lunch** with six **homemade salsas** and learn how to make **margaritas from scratch** while drinking margaritas, sodas or beer. Watch a **Papantla Flyers** presentation before heading back to the pier.

 All Ages 3 to 3.5 hours \$109 (Ages 10 and up) \$99 (Ages 3 to 9)



Drive (approx. 10 min) to Discover Mexico Park, once at the park meet your tour guide and begin a guided tour. Visit the Museum of Popular Arts and see the alebrijes from Oaxaca, the colorful mythical and animal-like creatures made from paper mache or carved wood, similar to those featured in Disney Pixar's "Coco". The museum boasts an original by Pedro Linare, the Mexican artist credited for inventing these brilliantly painted creatures in the 1930s. Next, it's time to go to the workshop and release your creativity, you'll receive a kit with a Mexican sabucan bag, a postcard, a carved-wood creature, paints and sponges to apply the paint. Upon completion, your creation will be packaged so you can take it home with you as a unique and handmade memento of your visit. Return back to the pier.

 Ages 8 and up 2 to 2.5 hours \$83 (Ages 8 and up)



Travel to Sunset Beach for an overview and safety briefing on Snuba. Snuba is a method of underwater swimming utilizing mask, fins weights and a breathing apparatus with air tanks that are kept on the surface. Dive to depths of approximately 15 to 20 feet (approx. 25 min). Return to the pier. A Medical Release and Waiver are required.


CZ59 ALL INCLUSIVE PASSION ISLAND BY TWISTER

 Ages 8 and up 5 to 5.5 hours \$88 (Ages 10 and up) \$52 (Ages 8 to 9)



Board the **Twister**, receive a safety briefing and life jacket for a speed ride to Blind Bay on Passion Island (approx. 30 min). After the 360-degree turns, fast stops and incredible acceleration while getting soaked, relax on the beach with lunch, drinks and time in a hammock (approx. 3.5 hours). Beach activities available for all ages. Re-board the Twister for your return speed ride back to the pier. **Guests must weigh less than 300 pounds.**


CZ09 JEEP EXPLORATION

 Ages 8 and up 4.5 to 5 hours \$88 (Ages 10 and up) \$78 (Ages 8 to 9)



Walk to your Jeep Wranglers for a safety briefing and orientation. Drive to **Punta Sur Eco Park** (approximately 45 minutes) before heading to a beach for lunch and free time (approx. 70 minutes). Volleyball, shower, beach blankets and umbrellas, tables and chairs are included in the excursion. Return to the pier. All jeeps seat four people and are manual transmission. Driver must be at least 18 years old and present a valid driver's license.


CZ05 MAYAN FRONTIER HORSEBACK RIDING TOUR

 Ages 12 to 65 4 to 4.5 hours \$91 (Ages 12 to 65)



Travel to Hacienda Santa Emilia (approx. 25 min) for your safety briefing and required helmet before saddling up on your horse. **Tour small replicas of Mayan Ruins**, stop at ancient caves and ride the trail (approx. 90 min). Enjoy a brief break and free time at the hacienda pool (approx. 30 min). Return to the pier. Horses are assigned based on your height, weight and riding ability. **Maximum Guest weight is 240 pounds and must wear long pants and closed-toe shoes. All equipment is provided.**


CZ32 SPEED BOAT BEACH ESCAPE

 Ages 10 and up 4 to 4.5 hours \$95 (Ages 10 and up)



Travel via taxi to Barracuda Beach (approx. 20 min) for a safety briefing and operation overview of your **2-person speed boat**. Don your life jacket (mandatory), get behind the wheel and head out through the turquoise seas (approx. 60 min). Return to Barracuda Beach for lunch. Have free time at the beach (approx. 90 min). Return to the pier (approx. 20 min). **Drivers must be 18 and up and present a valid driver's license. If booked alone, Guests will share boat with another Guest. Maximum weight limit is 550 pounds.**

CZ33 MEXICAN CUISINE WORKSHOP AND TASTING


 Ages 14 and up 5 to 5.5 hours \$84 (Ages 14 and up)



Head to **Playa Mia Grand Beach & Water Park** (approx. 25 min) to meet an **expert chef** that introduces you to authentic **Mexican cooking** from start to finish – including an open bar (approx. 2.5 hours). Finish your afternoon at the beach park (approx. 1.5 hours). Amenities include umbrella and beach chair, aquatic floating sports center, kayaks, water trampolines, aquatic iceberg, paddle boats, floating mats, water bicycles, ping pong tables, volleyball and soccer courts and an entertainment team featuring a kid's club. **Some water activities have height and weight restrictions.**

 Ages 5 and up 4.5 to 5 hours \$95 (Ages 10 and up) \$64 (Ages 5 to 9)


Travel to a **beachfront resort** (approx. 10 min) for a hands-on **cooking experience**. Learn how to make several Mexican salsas and traditional margaritas with the "dancing chefs" before they teach you how to dance the salsa. Enjoy cheese quesadillas, chicken taquitos and corn chips plus complementary lime and strawberry margaritas, Jamaica tea (hibiscus herbal tea) and bottled water. Relax on the beach or spend some time in the ocean (approx. 60 min). Return to the pier.

CZ26 DOLPHIN ENCOUNTER AT DOLPHINARIS

 Ages 5 and up 3.5 to 4 hours \$99 (Ages 10 and up) \$79 (Ages 5 to 9)


Begin with a 5-min taxi ride to Dolphinaris, upon arrival receive an overview of the facility and meet the dolphin trainers. Start with a 10-min orientation where you'll learn about the dolphins, then begin a 40-min up-close mammal meet and greet with a bottlenose dolphin, including a hug and kiss. Following your interaction, enjoy included unlimited food and non-alcoholic beverages, snorkel in a natural aquarium, or try kayaking and paddle boarding in the clear blue ocean (limited availability). Photos, videos and lockers have an additional cost. After your dolphin encounter, a taxi will take you back to the pier or Guests can easily walk to downtown Cozumel for some shopping before heading back to the pier.

CZ23 DUNE BUGGY & BEACH SNORKEL COMBO

 Ages 8 and up 4.5 to 5 hours \$100 (Ages 10 and up) \$88 (Ages 8 to 9)

Travel to your dune buggy for a safety briefing and grouping before getting out on the open road. Drive **around Cozumel Island** to your first stop at the beach. Dive into the water with provided snorkeling gear (approx. 60 min). Travel along the coastal road (approx. 50 min) to your second destination for beach fun and a snack (approx. 75 min). Volleyball, showers, beach blankets, umbrellas, tables and chairs are included. Return to the pier. **Buggies are manual transmission**, have no doors and require climbing in for entry. **Drivers must present a valid driver's license** and be at least 18 years old. Each vehicle is a 4-passenger vehicle. Guests are divided into groups of four. Guests may be required to share driving duties.

CZ61 OFF ROAD ATV AND BEACH BREAK

Head to your fully automatic All-Terrain Buggy for a comprehensive safety briefing before donning your helmet and goggles. Drive via caravan to **Punta Sur National Park** to see wildlife and the **Celarrain Lighthouse** before spending time snorkeling (approx. 60 min). Return to the pier (approx. 45 min). **Guests will be grouped by 4's and drivers must be 18 or older and present a valid driver's license. Maximum vehicle weight is 800 pounds. Closed-toe shoes required.**

CZ67 DISCOVER SCUBA DIVING COZUMEL

Head to Sunset Beach to meet your PADI certified Dive Instructor for a skills overview, pre-dive training and safety instruction (approx. 45 min).
