FACTS TO KNOW

The Guest Services Desk is open 24 hours, located Deck 3, to assist with your tour bookings when the Port Adventures Desk is closed.

Guests are advised that all Port Adventures, pricing, itinerary, availability, duration and timing are subject to change without notice.

Tour duration times are estimated and may vary considerably due to circumstances such as traffic or overcrowding of venues.

Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase extras such as souvenirs.

On Port Adventures that are stroller accessible, lightweight strollers are recommended.

On certain tours, electric wheelchairs are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in electric scooters. Several tours are restricted for collapsible wheelchairs.

You should never feel that gratuities are expected from you. However, it is customary to leave a few extra dollars in recognition of exceptional excursions guides and drivers. It is always up to you to determine the amount. For the consideration of your fellow Guests please ensure you are punctual for all Port Adventure meet times.

Passports, with applicable VISA/ESTA, are required for any tour entering another country.

It is mandatory for all Guests participating on this excursion to bring their government issued passport. This requirement is for Guests of All Ages. **Guests without passports will not be able to participate in these Port Adventures.**

Although street and beach vendors may appear loud and pushy as they attempt to sell their goods to vacationing families, Guests should not feel in any way intimidated by this typical behavior.

Guests that are prone to sea sickness should take precautionary measures before embarking their vessels.

TRAVEL SAFETY TIPS

As in any tourist destination, you will want to take some basic precautions to make the most of your time ashore. Be aware of your surroundings, especially in crowded areas and avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators. Leave your valuables in your stateroom safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs. Cameras and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight. People who carry handbags or backpacks are particularly vulnerable to purse snatchers on scooters. Guests should take their passport with them when ashore. If a passport check is required by local authorities, photo copies are no longer a valid form of identification. In general, use the same level of precaution you would use in any tourist destination. Please remember that while in a foreign country, you are subject to its laws.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Port Adventures are operated by independent contractors that are neither agents of, nor supervised or controlled by, Disney Cruise Line. Disney Cruise Line does not maintain their facilities or modes of transportation and is not responsible for any injury or property damage/loss that Guests may incur in connection with a Port Adventure.

All Port Adventures are subject to the Disney Cruise Line Cruise Contract. All Port Adventures are subject to availability and/or cancellation based on weather, itinerary changes, and attendance. Cancellations can be made up to 3 days prior to cruise departure date. After that time all reservations are final and non-refundable. All prices are subject to change without notice.

SECURITY NOTICE

All Guests (including children) who wish to disembark or embark the ship are required to present their Key to the World card at the gangway. A photo ID is also required for those Guests who are 18 years of age and older.


Guests under the age of 18 are required to have a parent, guardian or other responsible adult sign an authorization form if they wish to go ashore unaccompanied. Authorization forms are available at Guest Services.


Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult on Port Adventures, except for specific "teen only" Port Adventures.

PORT ADVENTURE ACTIVITY LEVEL

 **Mild** These excursions involve periods of walking for short distances over relatively level surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestone and limited steps. Standing or sitting for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Boarding tour vehicles via gangway or steps will be required. Distance from gangway to tour vehicle will vary port to port.


 **Moderate** Uneven/steep terrain or water activity in slight current. These excursions are fairly active and involve periods of walking over even and uneven surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestones, steps, and in some cases steep terrain. Standing for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Moderate water activities involve extended periods in a slight current, and may require climbing a ladder during beach or swimming stops.



⤴ All Ages 1.5 to 2 hours \$47 (Ages 10 and up) \$22 (Ages 3 to 9)



Travel via trolley to Saxman Native Village (approx. 20 min) to learn the legends of the Totem Poles and explore Totem Park on your own (approx. 40 min). Reboard the trolley to Ketchikan's Creek Street, for free time.

KE49 KETCHIKAN DUCK TOUR

⤴ All Ages 1.5 to 2 hours \$49 (Ages 10 and up) \$30 (Ages 0 to 9)



Board your "Duck Boat" for a fully narrated bus and boat tour (approx. 90 min) through Ketchikan and the harbor of Tongass Narrows including The Salmon Ladder on Ketchikan Creek, Totem Poles, Whale Park and the waterfront community. Return to the pier.

Watch chopping, sawing, chainsaw events, the death-defying speed climb, log rolling and more (approx. 90 minutes). Meet the lumberjacks after the show and get autographs and photos.

KE11 RAINFOREST WILDLIFE SANCTUARY, RAPTOR CENTER AND TOTEMS

⤴ All Ages 2.5 to 3 hours \$99 (Ages 10 and up) \$55 (Ages 3 to 9)



Narrated travel to Herring Cove and the Alaska Rainforest Sanctuary (approx. 30 min). Walk along the approx. 1-mile gravel trail alongside the Whitman Hatchery looking for birds, black bears, deer, mink, marten and seals (approx. 1 hour). Visit the Raptor Center and with a master totem carver. Shop and enjoy hot chocolate, coffee and tea along with some smoked salmon dip on crackers or cookies before returning to the pier.

KE02 SAXMAN NATIVE VILLAGE & EXCLUSIVE LUMBERJACK SHOW

⤴ All Ages 4 to 4.5 hours \$115 (Ages 10 and up) \$58 (Ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Saxman Native Village to learn about the Tlingit culture through video and live presentations. See Cape Fox Dancers perform in the clan house, learn about totem pole carving in the carving shed and enjoy free time for shopping (approx. 2 hours). Walk to the The Great Alaskan Lumberjack Show and experience some of the world's top timber sport athletes. Watch chopping, sawing, chainsaw events, the death-defying speed climb, log rolling and more (approx. 1 hour). Meet the lumberjacks after the show and get autographs and photos.

KE39 LIGHTHOUSE, TOTEMS AND EAGLES

⤴ All Ages 3 to 3.5 hours \$117 (Ages 10 and up) \$57 (Ages 0 to 9)



Narrated travel to a local dock (approx. 25 min) to board your boat for your voyage to look for eagles, harbor seals, sea lions, moon jellies, whales and other wildlife (binoculars included). View Loggerville, a floating Ghost Town, Totem Bight State Park, and the Guard Island Lighthouse with drinks and snacks included (approx. 2 hours).

KE08 RAIN FOREST CANOE ADVENTURE AND NATURE TRAIL

⤴ Ages 5 and up (10+) 3.5 to 4 hours \$133 (Ages 10 and up) \$80 (Ages 5 to 9)



Scenic travel to a mountain lake (approx. 40 min) to board Indian-style 37-foot canoes as you watch for wildlife in the Tongass National Forest (approx. 1 hour). Stop for an Alaskan-style snack and nature walk (approx. 30 min). Be a part of a canoe race back to the dock. Return to the pier. Minimum weight is 40 pounds.

KE22 MOUNTAIN POINT SNORKELING ADVENTURE

⤴ Ages 8 to 70 3 to 3.5 hours \$141 (Ages 8 to 70)



Get fitted in a state-of-the-art 1/4-inch (7mm) wetsuit complete with hood, boots and gloves in a heated dressing room (swimsuits must be worn under your clothes) and then enter the approximate 65 degree water at Mountain Point for your marine life tour (approx. 1 hour). Secure storage for your belongings and all equipment is provided. Equipment includes prescription masks, Scubapro Twin Jet fins and optional weight belts for free-diving. Complete instruction, in-water supervision and entertaining in-water narrative. Return to the shop for a hot beverage before returning to the pier. Guests must be between 80 and 260 pounds and in good physical condition.

KE61 RAINFOREST EXPLORATION AND RAPTOR EXPERIENCE

⤴ All Ages 2.5 to 3 hours \$159 (Ages 10 and up) \$79 (Ages 3 to 9)



Enjoy an (approx. 25-min), 8-mile narrated drive along the Tongass Narrows to Herring Cove, home to the Alaska Rainforest Sanctuary. Take an (approx. 30-min), guided walk along a gravel trail in the Tongass National Rainforest. Continue to an elevated boardwalk that stretches above Eagle Creek and alongside the Whitman Hatchery, home to major runs of pacific salmon throughout different periods of the summer. Look out for wildlife that frequent the area. Enter the flight auditorium for a presentation by handlers from the Alaska Raptor Center that will feature various raptors and a bald eagle. Explore the historic saw mill, visit a totem park with a 40-ft totem pole and shop for souvenirs in the General Store. Return to the pier.

KE09 RAINFOREST ISLAND ADVENTURE

⤴ Ages 5 and up 4 to 4.5 hours \$160 (Ages 10 and up) \$107 (Ages 5 to 9)



Scenic travel to Knudson Cove to board a Seahawk RIB style vessel (approx. 30 min) for a sightseeing ride (approx. 30 min). Exit at Orca Beach in the Tongass National Forest for a mile-long guided walk. Gather around the campfire for an Alaskan snack (approx. 90 min). Sightseeing-focused return to the cove looking for whales, Stellar sea lions, harbor seals, porpoise, bald eagles and migrating seabirds. Return to the pier. Wildlife sightings are common but not guaranteed. Minimum Guests weight is 40 pounds.

KE62 ALASKA FAMILY FUN AND EXCLUSIVE LUMBERJACK SHOW

⤴ All Ages 4 to 4.5 hours \$169 (Ages 10 and up) \$119 (Ages 3 to 9)



Take a short ride to Saxman Native Village, where you'll have a guided tour of the carving center. Learn how totem poles are made and see the largest collection in Ketchikan at the totem park next door. Ride back to Ketchikan and visit the Southeast Alaska Discovery Center, featuring interactive displays. Learn about the life, history and industries that have been a part of Southeast Alaska and the Tongass National Forest. Walk to nearby Great Alaskan Lumberjack Show where you'll participate in a rollicking good time. This unique, Disney-exclusive show will offer kid-friendly activities before the show as well as a special Character appearance. After the show, take a 5-min walk back to the pier or explore the town at your leisure.

KE31 WILDERNESS EXPLORATION AND CRAB FEAST

All Ages 4 to 4.5 hours \$175 (Ages 10 and up) \$120 (Ages 0 to 9)



Narrated coastal drive to George Inlet Lodge (approx. 30 min) and board your boat for the 7-mile trip to the crab fishing grounds (approx. 90 min). Enjoy the scenery, including wildlife, before volunteering to pull crab pots and learn about the Dungeness crabs. Return to the lodge for a Dungeness crab feast. Finish with a crab shell stacking contest before returning to the pier.

KE26 TATOOSH ISLANDS SEA KAYAK ADVENTURE

Ages 10 and up (36" tall) 4.5 to 5 hours \$174 (Ages 10 and up)



Scenic travel to the boat dock (approx. 30 min) to gear up and board your high-speed boat across the water to the beach. Board your 2-person sea kayak and travel through the Tatoosh Islands (approx. 90 min) as you look for seals, sea lions and the intertidal life. Return to the beach for a snack and hot beverage. Return to the ship. Minimum height is 36" tall.

KE30 ALASKA COASTAL EXPEDITION

Ages 7 and up 2 to 3 hours \$195 (Ages 10 and up) \$182 (Ages 7 to 9)



Get outfitted in gear, sign a waiver and watch a safety instructional video before boarding a 15-foot motorized inflatable boat and head "off the grid" (approx. 2 hours). Look for bears, eagles, whales, seals and much more. Maximum Guests weight is 350 pounds. Drivers must be at least 25 years old and provide a valid drivers license. Rain gear, socks, hats, gloves, boots, binoculars and dry bags will be provided.

KE59 SEAFOOD SAMPLING AND WILDLIFE CRUISE

All Ages 3.5 to 4 hours \$204 (Ages 10 and up) \$152 (Ages 0 to 9)



Board a boat at the pier and explore the rugged coastline of the Tongass Narrows and George Inlet. Visit Walden Rocks, a gathering place for seals, bald eagles and marine birds. Taste your way through Alaska's commercial fishing industry at the Libby Cannery. Begin with a hearty bowl of chowder, then follow your guide on an interactive experience connecting the fishermen to the fresh catch. Enjoy tasting smoked salmon, halibut, oysters, crab and more at sampling stations. Board a Motorcoach and take a scenic drive back to Ketchikan, with views along the way of the world's largest collection of totem poles and historic Creek Street. Return to the pier.

KE60 GEORGE INLET LODGE TASTING TABLE

Ages 14 and Up 2.5 to 3 hours \$204 (Ages 14 and up)



Start with a private 30-min narrated drive through Ketchikan. This drive will take you along the coast before arriving at the rustic George Inlet Lodge for an entertaining culinary experience. Participate in a once-in-a-lifetime crab catching experience. Next, head to your private dining room, where you will meet the executive chef. Follow along as the chef goes through the recipe, explaining each step and cooking technique. Enjoy the delicious meal and save room for dessert!

KE13 RAINFOREST ZIP, SKYBRIDGE AND RAPPEL ADVENTURE

Ages 10 and up (60" tall) 3 to 3.5 hours \$208 (Ages 10 and up)



Narrated travel to Alaska Canopy Adventures (approx. 30 min) and board a Unimog to your orientation and equipment suit-up. Experience 8 dual cable zip lines and 3 aerial suspension bridges before a photo op and free time in the shop, with coffee, tea, hot chocolate, smoked salmon dip and cookies. Return to the port. **Minimum height is 60" tall and Guests must weigh between 90 and 250 pounds.**

KE10 BACK COUNTRY JEEP AND CANOE ADVENTURE

Ages 6 and up 4 to 4.5 hours \$208 (Ages 10 and up) \$121 (Ages 6 to 9)



Board a 4-wheel drive Jeep Wrangler® through the rugged back roads of Revillagigedo Island and into the Tongass National Forest (approx. 80 min). Board a guided canoe at Lake Harriet Hunt and travel to the other side for a nature hike before an Alaskan-style snack. Enjoy a short narrated transfer back to base and the pier. Guests must weigh at least 40 pounds. Drivers must be 25 or older and present a valid driver's license. Vehicles accommodate 4 passengers and parties may be combined or split.

KE14 AERIAL ZIP AND RAPPEL ADVENTURE

Ages 10 and up (50" tall) 3 to 3.5 hours \$208 (Ages 10 and up)



Narrated travel to Alaska Canopy Adventures (approx. 30 min) and board a Unimog to your orientation and equipment suit-up. Experience 8 dual cable zip lines varying in length from 100 feet to 600 feet, before rappelling on the platforms and finish with free time in the shop, with coffee, tea, hot chocolate, smoked salmon dip and cookies. Return to the pier. **Minimum height is 50" tall and Guests must weigh between 70 and 250 pounds.**

KE19 MISTY FJORDS AND WILDERNESS EXPLORER

All Ages 4.5 to 5 hours \$214 (Ages 10 and up) \$129 (Ages 0 to 9)



Board a catamaran for narrated travel looking for wildlife into Behm Canal and Misty Fjords to see a bald eagle's nest, a Tlingit pictograph and New Eddystone Rock. Enjoy a selection of snacks and beverages while watching for whales, seals, eagles and other wildlife. Return to the pier.

KE56 WILDLIFE SAFARI AND BEACH BONFIRE

5 and up 3.5 to 4 hours \$214 (Ages 10 and up) \$159 (Ages 5 to 9)



Join an intimate wildlife viewing adventure aboard a deluxe waterjet-powered expedition vessel, in search of whales, harbor seals, bears and eagles as you explore wilderness passages and rugged coastlines. (Approx 2 hours) Then, step ashore on a remote beach with Alaska Native camp hosts to enjoy Alaskan cuisine alongside a crackling beach bonfire. (Approx 1 hour).

KE15 ADVENTURE KART EXPEDITION

Ages 8 and up (50" tall) 3 to 3.5 hours \$235 (Ages 10 and up) \$154 (Ages 8 to 9)



Travel to the Adventure Kart base camp (approx. 30 min) for your safety briefing and gear. Go off-roading on a guided trek through the Tongass National Forest, with views of the Behm Canal and Inside Passage (approx. 90 min). Snack and beverages included. Each Kart accommodated 2 Guests and parties may be separated. Minimum height is 50" tall and Guests must weigh between 40 and 300 pounds. Drivers must be at least 18 years of age and present a valid driver's license.

KE28 BERING SEA CRAB FISHERMEN'S TOUR

Ages 5 and up 3 to 3.5 hours \$239 (Ages 10 and up) \$139 (Ages 5 to 9)



Board the Aleutian Ballad boat and head to the inside passage to watch the Bering Sea crab fishermen bait and drop long line fishing gear in search of halibut, rock fish, shark and more. Watch for Aleutian including bald eagles, whales, sea lions and seals as you watch the fishermen haul in 700-pound king crab pots and into the on-deck aquarium. Witness Dungeness crab and prawn and shrimp fishing before heading back to the pier. Return to the pier.

KE34 KNUDSON COVE SALMON FISHING

Ages 5 and up 4.5 to 5 hours \$265 (Ages 10 and up) \$230 (Ages 5 to 9)



Narrated journey to Knudson Cove Marina (approx. 20 min) and put on your Alaskan-style fishing gear. Board a 24-to-29-foot fishing boat and head out to fish while watching out for seals, sea lions, otter, porpoise and even whales (approx. 3.5 hours). Return to the dock and choose, for an additional charge, if you'd like to send your fish home. Return to the pier. Guests 16 and older must purchase a fishing license (\$25) and king salmon stamp (\$15). Certain fish may not be in season and may need to be released. Your fishing captain will advise you of any restrictions as they may change.

IS29 CHICK PEA ADVENTURE PARK

Ages 4 to 6 (With Adults) 1 Hour \$39 (ages 4 to 6)



Head off the ship with your 4 – 6 year old to soar through the trees with this multiple-experience-level zipline adventure. Enjoy a day pass to the Chick Pea Adventure Park with 15 different obstacles for young Guests ages 4 to 6. Return to the ship.

Begin with an enjoyable bus ride through the largest Tlingit settlement in Alaska. With plenty of photo-stop opportunities throughout the tour, this truly is a wonderful glimpse into the past. Then, head to the Native Heritage Center Theater for a lively performance from the Huna Tlingit, who proudly share their history with you through interpretive song, dance and storytelling (approx. 45 min).

IS13 IN ALASKA'S WILDEST KITCHEN

Ages 8 And Up 1.5 to 2 Hours \$89 (ages 8 and up)



Learn about the culinary habits of Alaskans by spending a tasting session in the company of a friendly local chef, specializing in the preparation of seafood and other local delicacies. Your chef will take you through the entire cooking process before you gather around a large grill to absorb many secrets of the trade. Watch and learn, as the catch of the day is filleted and then get hands-on as you prepare and cook the fresh Alaska seafood with the guidance of your culinary host.

IS26 SEAFOOD FEAST AND TRIBAL DANCE SHOW



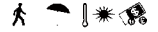

Meet your guide at the Crescent Harbor dock in Sitka, suit up in rain gear and your life jacket, and board a custom-built boat for a sightseeing trip (approx. 15 min) to a floating base camp where the kayaks are located. Upon arrival, receive a safety briefing and instructions on the use of oceangoing, two-person kayaks. Follow the tour in a group of up to 6 kayaks with your well-versed guide teaching paddling techniques and pointing out the area's marine environment. SI10 DRY SUIT SNORKEL ADVENTURE

Return to land for a short ride to the renowned Alaska Raptor Center to see some of the "Raptors-in-Residence" perched in outdoor habitats. Explore the river trail and interactive exhibits. Continue with a narrated drive along a coastal road, headed to the Fortress of the Bear, Silver Bay's one-of-a-kind rescue facility for orphaned Alaska brown bears. View and photograph brown bears up close from a raised platform. Enjoy some free time to explore beautiful Sitka on your own before returning to the pier.

SI16 ALASKA ZODIAC ADVENTURE AND FIN ISLAND LODGE

Get dressed in waterproof gear that is provided to help keep you dry during the voyage. This gear is not insulated, so layer underneath, regardless of the day's weather. Begin your voyage after a brief safety message. Observe kelp forests that disappear into the depths of the sound. In shallow water areas, inaccessible to larger craft, you may even notice sea stars, anemones and other invertebrates. This area is teeming with wildlife providing excellent photography and viewing opportunities. Stop at Fin Island Lodge for a delicious Alaska feast of either breakfast (prior to 10 a.m.) or lunch (after 10 a.m.). After the meal, beachcomb, explore the beautiful grounds of the exclusive island or relax next to the cozy beach fire. Return to your waiting vessel for the short cruise back to Sitka. Lunch is included, soft drinks are additional.

Lunch is included, soft drinks are an additional cost.

SI12 SITKA SALMON FISHING

Ages 6 and Up 4 to 4.5 Hours \$289 (Ages 10 and up) \$279 (Ages 6 to 9)



Travel via motorcoach to the starting point and boat area before boarding and heading into Sitka Sound and its adjacent waters. Depending on the time of year, fish for chinook, coho, chum or pink salmon (approx. 3 hours). Learn how to troll salmon from your knowledgeable captain. Catch and release is permitted; however, you may also choose to meet with local fish processors to have your catch sent to your home (only available to addresses in the continental U.S. Please visit the Port Adventures desk for important details about safety, fishing regulations, recommended attire and logistics).
