In preparation for our arrival to Victoria, Canada, we want to let you know that the Canadian Border Services Agency requires that all Guests turn in a Canadian Customs Declaration form upon entering Canada. Members of the same household address may complete one Customs Declaration form (up to four Guests). Additional household members will need to complete an additional form. Additional forms can be obtained upon check in, from your Stateroom Host or at the Guest Services Desk, located Deck 3, Midship.

Completed Customs Declaration forms will be presented to Canadian Border Services upon arrival into Victoria on Tuesday morning, July 16. Please be certain to complete the form after visiting Sitka on Sunday, July 14, and deposit it in the box outside of the Guest Services Desk, located Deck 3, midship.

**Your Canadian Customs Declaration form must be completed and turned in at the Guest Services Desk on Deck 3, Midship, before 6:00 pm on Sunday, July 14.** It is mandatory that all Guests sailing with us complete a form in order to avoid any delay in the clearance of the vessel on Tuesday morning.

**Your Canadian Customs Declaration form must be completed and turned in at the Guest Services Desk on Deck 3, Midship, before 10:00 pm on Sunday, July 14.** It is mandatory that all Guests complete a form in order to avoid any delay in the clearance of the vessel on Tuesday morning.
