FACTS TO KNOW

- The Guest Services Desk is open 24 hours, located Deck 3, to assist with your tour bookings when the Port Adventures Desk is closed.
- Guests are advised that all Port Adventures, pricing, itinerary, availability, duration and timing are subject to change without notice.
- Tour duration times are estimated and may vary considerably due to circumstances such as traffic or overcrowding of venues.
- Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase extras such as souvenirs.
- On Port Adventures that are stroller accessible, lightweight strollers are recommended.
- On certain tours, electric wheelchairs are not permitted. Tour operators will deny participation to Guests arriving in electric scooters. Several tours are restricted for collapsible wheelchairs.
- You should never feel that gratuities are expected from you. However, it is customary to leave a few extra dollars in recognition of exceptional excursions guides and drivers. It is always up to you to determine the amount.
- For the consideration of your fellow Guests please ensure you are punctual for all Port Adventure meet times.
- Passports, with applicable VISA/ESTA, are required for any tour entering another country. It is mandatory for all Guests participating on this excursion to bring their government issued passport. This requirement is for Guests of All Ages. **Guests without passports will not be able to participate in these Port Adventures.**
- Although street and beach vendors may appear loud and pushy as they attempt to sell their goods to vacationing families, Guests should not feel in any way intimidated by this typical behavior.
- Guests that are prone to sea sickness should take precautionary measures before embarking their vessels.

TRAVEL SAFETY TIPS

As in any tourist destination, you will want to take some basic precautions to make the most of your time ashore. Be aware of your surroundings, especially in crowded areas and avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators. Leave your valuables in your stateroom safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs. Cameras and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight. People who carry handbags or backpacks are particularly vulnerable to purse snatchers on scooters. Guests should take their passport with them when ashore. If a passport check is required by local authorities, photo copies are no longer a valid form of identification. In general, use the same level of precaution you would use in any tourist destination. Please remember that while in a foreign country, you are subject to its laws.

All Port Adventures are subject to the Disney Cruise Line Cruise Contract. All Port Adventures are subject to availability and/or cancellation based on weather, itinerary changes, and attendance. Cancellations can be made up to 3 days prior to cruise departure date. After that time all reservations are final and non-refundable. All prices are subject to change without notice.

SECURITY NOTICE

All Guests (including children) who wish to disembark or embark the ship are required to present their Key to the World card at the gangway. A photo ID is also required for those Guests who are 18 years of age and older.

Guests under the age of 18 are required to have a parent, guardian or other responsible adult sign an authorization form if they wish to go ashore unaccompanied. Authorization forms are available at Guest Services.

PORT ADVENTURE ACTIVITY LEVEL

Mild These excursions involve periods of walking for short distances over relatively level surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestone and limited steps. Standing or sitting for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Boarding tour vehicles via gangway or steps will be required. Distance from gangway to tour vehicle will vary port to port.

Moderate Uneven/steep terrain or water activity in slight current. These excursions are fairly active and involve periods of walking over even and uneven surfaces, which may include brick, cobblestones, steps, and in some cases steep terrain. Standing for extended periods may also be necessary to fully enjoy these excursions. Moderate water activities involve extended periods in a slight current, and may require climbing a ladder during beach or swimming stops.

Active Good physical condition required. These excursions are considered active and may involve constant effort or extended periods of walking long distances, numerous steps, inclines, cobblestone surfaces, and other rough terrain throughout the excursion. Participants should be in good physical condition to fully enjoy these excursions.

AR23 BEACH TRANSFER TO ARASHI BEACH AND SNORKEL

 All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$29 (ages 10 and up) \$14 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to Arashi Beach (approx. 20 min) and relax, experiencing the powder soft white sand beach and crystal clear waters (approx. 3 hours). Enjoy plenty of swimming, beachcombing or just relax in the warm sand. Return back to the pier. **Please bring additional cash for food and rentals including: chairs, umbrellas plus bathrooms and showers.** Snorkel gear is available upon request.


AR13 BEST OF ARUBA ISLAND TOUR

 All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$44 (ages 10 and up) \$31 (ages 3 to 9)



Guided travel past Dutch colonial buildings, the Spanish Lagoon and Frenchman's Pass to the Casibari Rock formations (approx. 35 min). Head to the Natural Bridge and the Baby Bridge before reboarding your coach to Alto Vista Chapel (approx. 30 min) and visit on your own (approx. 20 min). Continue with a short drive to the California Lighthouse to admire the stunning island views and take photographs (approx. 15 min). Return back to the pier or be dropped off downtown for shopping.


AR09 CATAMARAN SAILING AND SNORKELING

 Ages 5 And Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$51 (ages 10 and up) \$39 (ages 5 to 9)



Sail to the west coast of the island (approx. 45 min) for a sailing and snorkeling adventure. The first stop will be at Boca Cathalina for snorkeling in approx. 15 feet of water (approx. 45 min). Sail (approx. 10 min) to the Antilla shipwreck for another chance to snorkel or swim (approx. 50 min). Sail back to the pier (approx. 45 min) while enjoying rum punch, juice or soda as you listen to music from the islands.


AR01 SEAWORLD EXPLORER

 All Ages 2 to 2.5 Hours \$51 (ages 10 and up) \$40 (ages 0 to 9)



Travel to the De Palm pier, transfer via boat to the Seaworld Explorer and embark on this semi-submarine boasting an underwater observatory for viewing the hidden world of life below the ocean surface. View the Antilla shipwreck, a 397-foot, WW2 era freighter from Germany home to a kaleidoscope of tropical fish. After your underwater expedition (approx. 40 min) return back to Oranjestad via bus (approx. 25 min) and return to the pier.


AR19 BEST OF ARUBA AND BEACH

 All Ages 5.5 to 6 Hours \$56 (ages 10 and up) \$32 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via bus through Oranjestad passing Frenchman's Pass on the way to Casibari Rock (approx. 35 min) before heading up the north coast to visit the collapsed Natural Bridge and the Baby Bridge (approx. 20 min). Continue on to Bushirbana Gold Smelter Ruins and the California Lighthouse (approx. 35 min) for a photo stop (approx. 15 min). Head to Arashi Beach to relax and explore on your own (approx. 2 hours) before reboarding your coach back to Oranjestad. Either be dropped off at the downtown shopping area or at the pier.

AR06 NATURAL WONDERS OF ARUBA

 All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$59 (ages 10 and up) \$36 (ages 3 to 9)



Travel via coach to the Butterfly Farm (approx. 15 min) and meet your guide for a tour (approx. 45 min) through the tropical gardens filled with beautiful butterflies. Drive past Divi Divi trees before heading west to Natural Bridge Ruins and Baby Bridge, one of Aruba's most famous attractions. Drive to Ayo Rock Formations (approx. 20 min) before continuing your scenic drive back to Oranjestad (approx. 35 min) to remain downtown for shopping or return to the pier.


AR05 SEA & SEE ISLAND TOUR

 All Ages 4 to 4.5 Hours \$72 (ages 10 and up) \$44 (ages 3 to 9) \$39 (ages 0 to 2)



Travel to the De Palm pier, transfer via boat to the Seaworld Explorer and embark on this semi-submarine boasting an underwater observatory for viewing the hidden world of life below the ocean surface. View the Antilla shipwreck, a 397-foot, WW2 era freighter from Germany home to a kaleidoscope of tropical fish. After your expedition (approx. 40 min) travel via coach to some of Aruba's highlights - the California Lighthouse, the Natural Bridge Ruins, Baby Bridge and Casibari Rock Formations. Return to Oranjestad (approx. 25 min) where you can be dropped off downtown or return to the pier.

AR18 DISCOVER SCUBA DIVING

 Ages 12 And Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$109 (ages 12 and up)



Take a short transfer to a pool location for an hour training session before heading out for a one-tank dive. Learn the basic rules for scuba diving and how to use the equipment. Board your dive boat and cruise (approx. 20 min) to the Pedernalis, a sunken oil tanker. The Pedernalis wreck has a depth of 25 feet and an instructor will accompany Guests at all times during this 30 minute dive. Back on the boat relax on the 20 minute return back to Oranjestad and the 20 minute bus ride back to the pier. Guests must not exceed 350 lbs to participate.


AR08 TWO TANK CERTIFIED SCUBA DIVE

 Ages 12 And Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$109 (ages 12 and up)



Guests must have dove within the last 2 years and present a valid certification card. Board the dive boat for a 2-tank dive trip. At each dive site, Guests will be split into smaller groups and guided by a dive master. Cruise (approx. 45 min) to the first dive stop at the Antilla, the second largest ship wreck in the Caribbean. This dive has a max depth of 60 feet for 40 minutes of bottom time. Re-board the boat for the 10-minute ride to the second dive on the shallow wreck Pedernalis. The Pedernalis has a depth of 25 feet for 40 minutes of bottom time. Back on the boat relax on the (approx. 45-min) return back to the pier. Guests must be a minimum of 12 years of age and hold a complete scuba certification from a recognized training agency. Depth restrictions prohibit those with the PADI Scuba Diver designation from participating in this adventure. Guests must not exceed 350 lbs to participate.

AR20 4 X 4 NORTH COAST ADVENTURE AND BEACH BREAK

 Ages 6 And Up 6.5 to 7 Hours \$114 (ages 10 and up) \$89 (ages 6 to 9)



Travel to the site for your safety briefing, meet your driver/guide and climb aboard a Land Rover. Begin with a scenic drive over the Andicuri Hills toward the Black Stone Beach. Continue to Ayo Rock Formations for a brief break (approx. 20 min) to view the formations. Travel (approx. 5 min) to the Ostrich Farm for a guided tour (approx. 30 min) before heading to the Natural Bridge and Baby Bridge. Have some time for souvenir shopping and a typical local snack called "Pastechi." Drive from Natural Bridge to Bushirbana Gold Mill Ruins and then a visit to Alto Vista Chapel. Continue on to the California Lighthouse for a short visit (approx. 10 min). Travel to Arashi Beach (approx. 5 min) and enjoy time to swim, snorkel or relax at this tranquil beach (approx. 100 min). Return to the pier. Guests must not exceed 300 lbs to participate. Guests must wear closed toed shoes.

AR30 DE PALM ISLAND BEACH & SNORKELING

All Ages 6.5 to 7 Hours \$114 (ages 10 and up) \$99 (ages 3 to 9)

Transfer to the ferry landing (approx. 20 min) before a short ride across a lagoon to De Palm Island, Aruba's only all-inclusive destination. Upon arrival receive a brief orientation before you set out to explore the thrilling waterpark and water slides and enjoy all the beach activities the island has to offer. Lounge chairs, freshwater, showers and snorkeling equipment are provided. After playing on the beach there is a complete lunch buffet along with alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages included in the price of the tour. Return back to the pier.

AR04 ATLANTIS SUBMARINE

Ages 4 And Up 2 to 2.5 Hours \$114 (ages 10 and up) \$62 (ages 4 to 9)

Travel via ferry (approx. 15 min) to the submarine Atlantis. Board the air-conditioned submarine and dive down to depths of 120 feet seeing the Barcadera reef with countless coral formations and the newly sunken ship the Morgenster as you travel feet from the wreckage (approx. 45 min). Re-surface and board your tender to return trip back to the pier (approx. 15 min). **Guests must be at least 36" tall to participate.**

AR11 4 X 4 NATURAL POOL ADVENTURE

Ages 8 And Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$124 (ages 10 and up) \$94 (ages 8 to 9)

Transfer to the site for your safety briefing before meeting your driver/guide. Climb aboard a Land Rover and begin your adventure across Aruba's countryside toward the Natural Bridge and the Baby Bridge. Next, make your wishes come true in the "Wish Rock Garden". Continue (approx. 25 min) to Natural Pool where you'll have free time (approx. 1 hr) for swimming or snorkeling in the refreshing waters. This off-road safari is the only way to access the Natural Pool. Return to the 4X4 for the exciting 25-min trip back to the pier through the Arikok National Park. **Guests must not exceed 300 lbs to participate. Guests must wear closed-toe shoes.**

AR22 UTV ANDICURI ADVENTURE

Ages 12 And Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$135 (ages 12 and up)

Transfer to the site for your safety briefing before meeting your driver/guide. Jump behind the wheel of a unique UTV vehicle as you follow a guide on an off-road safari along the Andicuri Trail. Each UTV carries a maximum of 2 Guests in a caravan formation that will take you through the wild beauty of Aruba's outback, with visits to Andicuri, the Alto Vista Chapel, the Gold Mill ruins and the historic California Lighthouse. Return back to the pier. **Drivers must be a minimum of 25 years old. Guests must wear closed toed shoes.**

AR10 SEA TREK HELMET DIVE & DE PALM ISLAND

Ages 8 And Up 6.5 to 7 Hours \$179 (ages 10 and up) \$159 (ages 8 to 9)

Travel to the ferry landing (approx. 20 min), board the ferry and cruise to De Palm Island. Receive a brief orientation of the island and to the Sea Trek. Meet an experienced dive guide who will introduce you to this helmet dive. Climb down the ladder to a depth of approx. 20 feet below the surface and follow your guide along the ocean floor. Resurface and enjoy the rest of the day. Snorkel, swim, or relax in a cozy beach chair. With more than 70 water attractions there is something for every member in the family. Enjoy lunch (included in the price of this tour). At the end of the day, return via ferry and coach to the pier. **The minimum dive weight is 80 lbs. per person; the maximum weight is 350 lbs. per person.**

AR21 SNUBA AT DE PALM ISLAND

Ages 10 And Up 6.5 to 7 Hours \$179 (ages 10 and up)

Travel to the ferry landing (approx. 20 min), board the ferry and cruise to De Palm Island. Meet your trained SNUBA guide, receive a safety briefing and then head out to discover incredible coral formations and schools of tropical fish as you glide effortlessly for 1-hr under the water surface. After your SNUBA experience, enjoy all the beach activities the island has to offer. Continue to explore the island or try the Zipline or banana boat. Enjoy a complete lunch buffet along with alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages included in the price of the tour. Return back to the pier. **Please Note: Lockers and wetsuits may be rented for an additional fee.**

B17 BARBADOS BEACH BREAK

All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$32 (ages 10 and up) \$18 (ages 3 to 9)

Travel to **Harbour Lights Beach Club** (approx. 15 min) and head to your **beach chair** and **shared umbrella** while enjoying a **welcome drink** (approx. 3 hours). Food and additional beverages are available for purchase. Return to the ship (approx. 15 min).

B12 MONKEY ENCOUNTER & ISLAND ADVENTURE

All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$55 (ages 10 and up) \$39 (ages 3 to 9)

Travel to the **Highland Adventure Centre** for a drink before descending into the **Wildlife Reserve** for the **Green Monkey Experience**, where monkeys and other wildlife are free to roam (approx. 60 min). Monkey sightings cannot be guaranteed. Reboard your bus and travel through **historic Holetown** and the "Gold Coast." Return to the pier.

B06/B28 BEST OF BARBADOS

All Ages 3.5 to 4 Hours \$62 (ages 10 and up) \$38 (ages 3 to 9)

Travel to **Orchid World** (approx. 35 min) for a visit before heading to **Gun Hill Signal Station** and **Sunbury Plantation House** to view the collections of antiques and memorabilia. Return to the port (approx. 40 min). **ADULT ONLY DEPARTURE ALSO AVAILABLE.**

B08 EXPLORE BARBADOS BY LAND ROVER

Ages 5 and Up 3 to 3.5 Hours \$69 (ages 10 and up) \$59 (ages 5 to 9)

Board a **Land Rover** and take the road less traveled around Barbados before stopping at **Bathsheba** for a photo stop and beverage (approx. 20 min). Continue on to **Cattlewash** for island views and travel through **Holetown** and back to **Bridgetown Harbor**. Return to the ship. **Guest weight may not exceed 280 pounds or be over 7 feet tall.**

B16 TIAMI SAIL & SNORKEL

Ages 5 and Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$72 (ages 10 and up) \$62 (ages 5 to 9)

Take a short transfer to board your **catamaran** and head along Barbados' coastline to a sheltered bay (approx. 40 min). Receive snorkel instruction, equipment and required vest before heading into the water (approx. 45 min) among **Green and Hawksbill turtles**. Turtle sightings are not guaranteed. Reboard the catamaran for **complimentary cocktails** and relaxation before returning back to the pier.

B18 SWIM WITH TURTLES

 Ages 5 and Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$77 (ages 10 and up) \$66 (ages 5 to 9)



Begin with a 15-min drive to your awaiting boat that will take you to Turtle Bay. Enjoy island views and learn about giant sea turtles before observing them close by in their natural habitat. Snorkel above a shipwreck and then recharge on a beach where you can swim or just relax. After a relaxing beach break, return to the pier.

B19 HARRISON'S CAVE & SCENIC DRIVE

 All Ages 2.5 to 3 Hours \$79 (ages 10 and up) \$42 (ages 3 to 9)



Take a scenic drive to **Harrison's Cave** (approx. 30 min). Explore the **interpretative exhibits** and watch a short vide before boarding a tram into the cave. View thousands of stalagmites and stalactites in stunning formation (approx. 40 min). Return to the pier. **Video recording is not permitted.**

B04 4X4 ADVENTURE & MONKEY ENCOUNTER

 Ages 5 and Up 3.5 to 4 Hours \$89 (ages 10 and up) \$64 (ages 5 to 9)



Travel via **4x4 vehicle** to the **Wildlife Reserve** (approx. 60 min). Walk through the open forests home to the **Green Monkey**. Sightings are not guaranteed. Reboard your vehicle, enjoy a photo stop and return to the port (approx. 60 min). Guests do not drive the vehicle. Vehicles hold 10 passengers and parties may be split. Guest weight may not exceed 280 pounds or be over 7 feet tall.

B03 5-STAR CATAMARAN & TURTLE ENCOUNTER

 Ages 5 and Up 5 to 5.5 Hours \$112 (ages 10 and up) \$85 (ages 5 to 9)



Take a short transfer to board your **catamaran** and cruise the coastline (approx. 40 min). Stop at the beach, receive snorkel instruction, equipment and required life vest and snorkel the clear waters. Enjoy a **buffet-style lunch** along with **unlimited beverages**. Continue sailing to the next stop, often frequented by sea turtles (approx. 40 min). Turtle sightings cannot be guaranteed. Return to the port.

B01 BARBADOS ATLANTIS SUBMARINE EXPEDITION

 Ages 4 and Up 2.5 to 3 Hours \$116 (ages 10 and up) \$63 (ages 4 to 9)



Travel to Shallow Draught and board a boat to the Atlantis Dive Site (approx. 10 min). Board the submarine to view underwater life and a shipwreck (approx. 45 min). Return to the pier. Guests must be at least 36 inches tall.



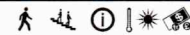
