



Dear Guests,

We are glad that you are sailing with us and want to give you an update on your cruise itinerary.

Hurricane Dorian moved through The Bahamas last week significantly impacting some islands. We have been working diligently on preparing Castaway Cay for guests, as well as supporting our Bahamian Crew Members who were affected by the storm and contributing to relief efforts. We anticipate re-opening Castaway Cay to guests on Thursday, September 12, as long as all necessary work is completed.

Given this information, we will modify your cruise itinerary to visit Castaway Cay on Thursday instead of Wednesday. The ship's Captain will update you on our progress during your cruise.

Guest going ashore will see signs of the recent storm's passing and some experiences on the island may be unavailable. In addition, your selected Port Adventures may not be available. Please check with the onboard Port Adventures staff for availability.

As you may be aware, Disney Cruise Line has committed \$1 million to support the efforts of non-profit organizations involved in the relief efforts and is providing supplies to those in the affected areas. Last week, the Disney Dream and the Disney Fantasy dropped off food and water at Castaway Cay for distribution in Sandy Point on Great Abaco Island, which was heavily impacted by Hurricane Dorian and is home to many of our Crew Members. Both ships are scheduled to drop off supplies at Castaway Cay for delivery to Abaco over the coming weeks, including during your sailing.

We appreciate your understanding regarding this change as we work to re-open Castaway Cay and assist nearby islands in their recovery efforts.
