

## **BAR HARBOR OVERVIEW**

In the mid-1800s, Bar Harbor became the playground of U.S. tycoons, who visited each summer to "rusticate," as they called it, in the wilds. There was a limit, however, to how rustic they were willing to get, as evidenced by the palatial Newport-like "cottages" they built. The Great Fire of 1947, which leveled most of the mansions, wiped out this lavish lifestyle. Bar Harbor was rebuilt as a more middle-class resort with hotels and motels largely replacing the summer palaces. Some of those same inns are chock full these days during the brief Maine summer, when the village's permanent population of 4,000 swells tenfold with present-day rusticators.

John D. Rockefeller promoted the preservation of the island, as well as the establishment of the National Park in 1919. The Park Loop Road provides access to some of the most memorable features, including the Otter Cliffs and the striking Thunder Hole. Bar Harbor presents a unique example of ocean and mountain scenery. It's a quiet, beautiful resort village, worlds away from the hustle and bustle of the big cities.

Surrounded by Acadia National Park on the east side of Maine's Mt. Desert Island, Bar Harbor has welcomed visitors for more than a hundred years. While summer remains Bar Harbor's high season, today, many people visit the town to witness the blazing colors of fall foliage, which reach a colorful crescendo in early October.

Visitors with a thirst for adventure and love of the outdoors will find plenty to do in Bar Harbor. Sailing, canoeing, and kayaking are popular pursuits, while climbing Acadia's jagged peaks and cliffs offers an opportunity to see the island from a different perspective. Adventurers can also work up a sweat while enjoying the scenery as they bike along any of the 55 miles of trails that run through the park.

Other options include scenic trolley rides; a visit to the local brewery, Bar Harbor Brewing company; or the Mount Desert Oceanarium and its lobster museum. Golfers can enjoy a few holes at the country's eighth-oldest club, Kebo Valley Golf Club. Shoppers can snag something unique in the many charming boutiques that line West, Cottage, Mt. Desert, and Main Streets. building now houses artifacts depicting Sydney's history





Travel Safety Tips

- Be aware of your surroundings at all times. Obey local traffic and pedestrian laws and signage. Please use crosswalks and mind
  the traffic signals or crossing guards if present. Avoid short cuts, narrow alleys and poorly lit streets.
- Avoid wandering from the main shopping and tourist areas into unfamiliar territory. If venturing out independently, have a plan, use only licensed taxi operators.
- Identity/Credit Card theft can occur anywhere. Please remain vigilant in monitoring the safe keeping of your personal information.
- Leave valuables in your room safe and avoid carrying large amounts of cash. Exercise caution when using ATMs. Cameras and handbags should be carried close to your body or concealed out of sight.
- Leave air transportation tickets and other travel documents in your room safe. When going ashore, each adult is required to carry a Driver's license, passport or other government-issued photo ID. Note: Some ports may require Guests to carry passports ashore.
- Most crimes are easier to commit in dark unlit areas. When going ashore at night, please be extra vigilant about your personal safety.

  All Greats (including shidesp) who wish to disample the philosophysis are required to propert their Key To The World card at the gargaway.
- All Guests (including children) who wish to disembark the ship are required to present their Key To The World card at the gangway. A photo ID is also
