PORT OVERVIEW

Ensenada is a coastal city in Mexico, the third largest and 78 miles south of San Diego on the Baja California Peninsula. The area is locally referred to as La Cenicienta del Pacifico, "The Cinderella of the Pacific." One of the first settlements founded in the Californias, Ensenada has emerged as a cruise ship destination, aerospace center and with a nearby region to the northeast where wine grapes are grown. It is said that the first Vitis vinifera made it to the region's San

Ignacio Mission in 1703, when Jesuit Padre Juan de Ugarte planted the first vineyards. Situated on the coastline of Bahía de Todos Santos — an inlet of the Pacific Ocean on the peninsula's Gold Coast — the Port of Ensenada is an important commercial, fishing, and tourism destination. The city is home to a navy and army base as well as Ensenada Airport, a military airfield which doubles as an airport of entry into Mexico.

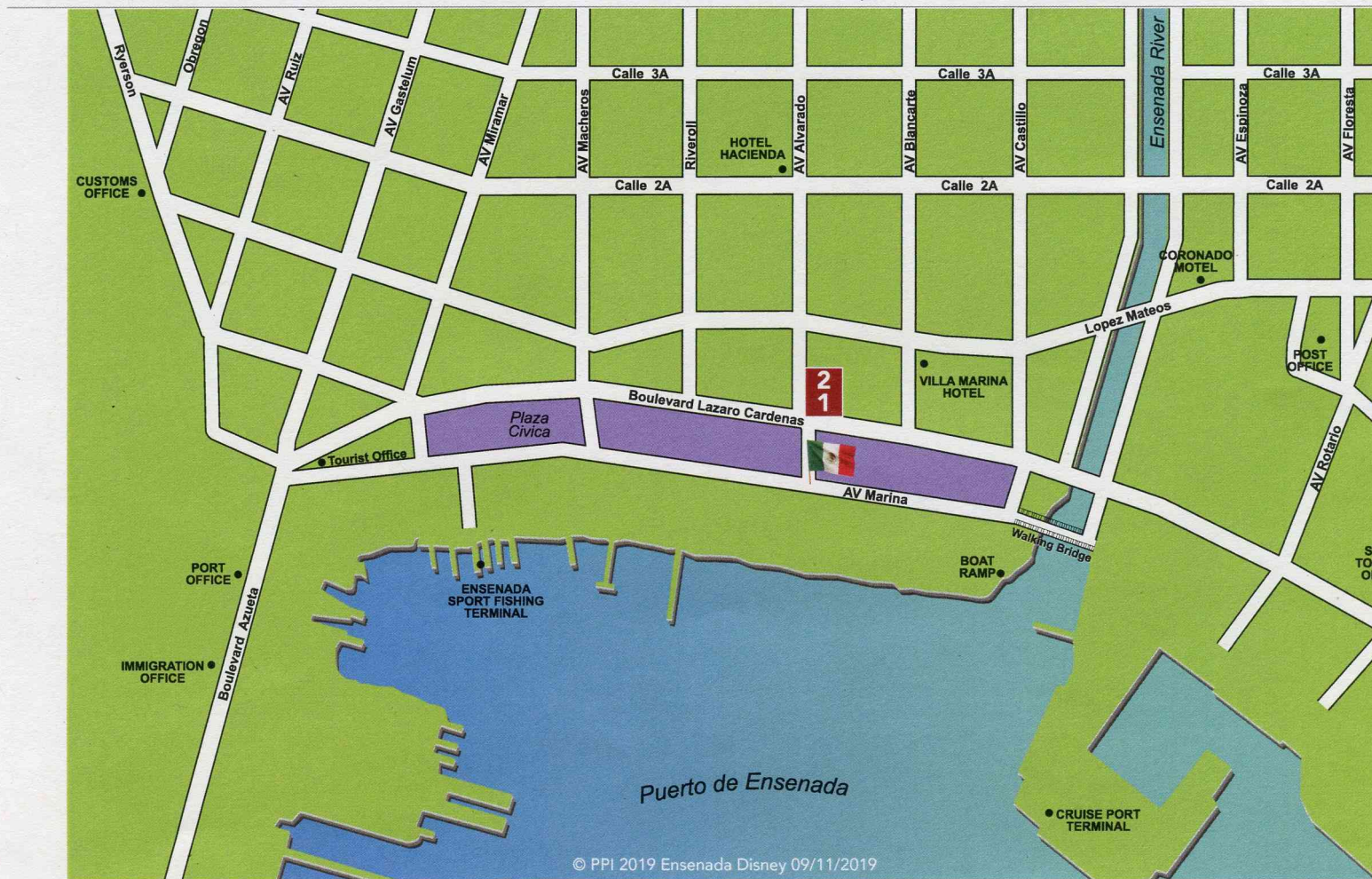

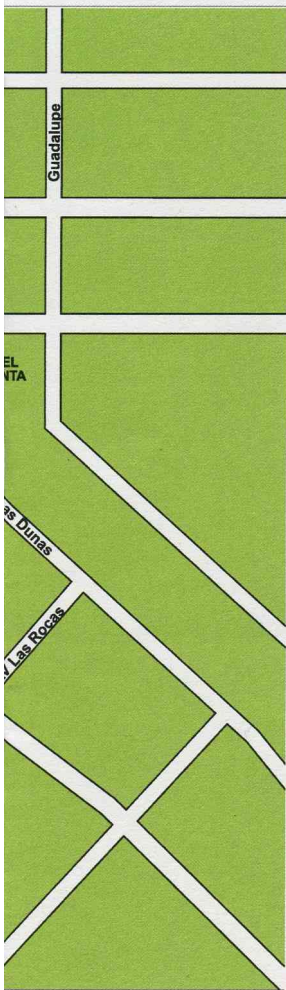

About Ensenada

The Aztecs believed that the **FIRE OPAL** represented all the virtues of the sun - **ENERGY, LIGHT, WARMTH AND LIFE ITSELF.**

The Mayans and Aztecs **USED FIRE OPALS IN MOSAICS** and for ritualistic purposes.

The **MOST VALUED** fire opal is **RED OR REDDISH ORANGE, TRANSPARENT**, and has a bright intense play-of-color with multiple hues.

The longest **INTERNATIONAL OFF ROAD RACE** in the world called the Baja 1000, taking place in November – on even numbered years, it **ENDS IN ENSENADA.**

Witness the **GRAY WHALE'S** annual migrations from **ALASKA** to Baja California, and **BACK AGAIN.**

Control of Baja California shifted between various groups in its early history, and it was **NOT ADMITTED INTO MEXICO** until 1952.

Ensenada is part of Baja and the region has 32 **UNIVERSITIES** with 19 serving as **RESEARCH CENTERS** in fields such as **PHYSICS, OCEANOGRAPHY, and AEROSPACE.**

LOGGERHEAD TURTLES travel all the way from their **NESTING PLACES IN JAPAN** to feed in the Sea of Cortez.
