AND BORDER PROTECTION INSPECTION  
THURSDAY MORNING – 03/19/20

Dear Disney Cruise Line Guest,

We would like to remind you that **United States Immigration requires that EVERY guest, including children, present themselves in person** for Immigration inspection upon arrival in San Diego.  
All guests must bring the following to the inspection:

- Passport - Birth Certificate - Alien Resident Cards - Key to the World Card (Room Key)

**Be advised that EVERY Guest will need to bring their Key to the World card (Room Key) with them, as they will be required to tap their keycard following the inspection as proof of attendance.**

**EVERY Guest must attend the inspection, regardless of whether they decide to disembark on Thursday, March 19th or on Friday, March 20th.**
