- If you would like to purchase air from a city not listed above, please consult *Disney Cruise Vacations* Air Department for further details (additional charges may apply).
- *Disney Cruise Vacations* offers a day-before option at a non-Disney resort. Please consult your Travel Agent or *Disney Cruise Line* Reservations for further details.

Disney Cruise Vacations acts as sales agent for contracted air carriers. *Disney Cruise Vacations* Air Program is not included in the 3-, 4- or 7-night vacation pricing. The Air Program consists of roundtrip economy air transportation, motor coach transportation, and baggage transfers. Motor coach transportation for 3-, 4- or 7-night cruise vacation includes transfers to and from a Central Florida airport and Port Canaveral. The 7-Night Land and Sea Vacation also includes motor coach transportation to the *Walt Disney World*® Resort. Air transportation will be arranged to and from a Central Florida airport in accordance with the scheduled vacation dates. "Central Florida airport" means one of the following airports: Orlando, Melbourne, Daytona Beach, Tampa or, during peak travel periods, Jacksonville.



GATEWAY CITIES

Space may be limited for certain gateway cities and availability of any gateway city may be restricted or withdrawn without prior notice. *Disney Cruise Vacations* reserves the right to designate any air carrier, including commuter and charter services, connections, routing, and schedule from each gateway city.

FLIGHT CONFIRMATION AND SEAT ASSIGNMENTS

Flight schedules are confirmed by *Disney Cruise Vacations* 30 days prior to vacation commencement. Guests are advised to reconfirm flights and times within 48 hours of departure directly with the assigned air carrier. ***Disney Cruise Vacations* is NOT responsible for seat assignments, special meal requests, frequent flyer information or other similar airline-related matters and recommends that these be handled by the Guest or Travel Agent directly with the airline.**

FLIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Airfares may include contract, promotional, nonrefundable, or group fares. Tickets issued are highly restrictive and may not be reissued, revalidated, or exchanged for another carrier or routing. Penalties for cancellations or rebookings resulting from a change made by the Guest must be paid by the Guest. Tickets are refundable only to *Disney Cruise Vacations*. Travel is on a round-trip, economy-class basis. Guests traveling together may be ticketed on a different airline or routing.

FLIGHT SCHEDULE CHANGES/LAYOVER/REROUTING

Disney Cruise Vacations is not responsible for airline schedule changes, cancellations, rerouting or any disruptions of scheduled services once air documents have been issued. *Disney Cruise Vacations* will not be responsible for flight schedules or penalties resulting from changes made directly with the airline. Consult your Travel Agent for assistance.

AIRLINE BAGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

It is the right of each air carrier to limit the number and size of articles checked onto the aircraft and to assess excess baggage charges where deemed appropriate. The Guest will be responsible for these charges upon check-in at the airport. Consult your Travel Agent or specific air carrier for details.

SPECIAL AIR REQUESTS

Special air requests will be made subject to availability and confirmation, for a nonrefundable fee of \$50 per person (subject to change). Additional airline charges and certain restrictions may apply. Requests must be made in writing to *Disney Cruise Vacations* Special Air Request Desk at least 60 days prior to departure for individual reservations and 90 days prior to departure for group bookings. Guests deviating from our standard air program may forfeit ground transfers and will forfeit hotel accommodations if applicable. Please contact the *Disney Cruise Vacations* Air Service Desk for further details.

OVERNIGHT HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Due to arrival/departure times and availability, it may be necessary for Guests to stay overnight en route to or from their vacation at a location other than their destination. In such an event, *Disney Cruise Vacations* reserves the right to offer complimentary accommodations at its discretion. Guests will be responsible for their own meals, incidentals and all other expenses.

MISCELLANEOUS

No changes will be permitted to any air booking 30 days or less prior to departure. Children under the age of 2 can travel for free sitting on an adult's lap. Guests have the option to purchase a seat for the infant at the air add-on rate. Infants under 12 weeks of age will not be allowed to travel aboard *Disney Cruise Line* ships.

We recommend you allow a minimum of four (4) hours at the beginning and end of your cruise for travel time, customs clearances and security checks at Port Canaveral and the airport.



GROUND TRANSFERS

You can leave the driving to us! Ground transfers can be purchased for \$69 per person (7-Night Land and Sea Vacation Package) or \$49 per person (3-, 4-, or 7-Night Cruise Vacation Package). When transfers are purchased, you will receive the following benefits*:

- Airport pickup – you'll be met at the airport by a *Disney Cruise Line* representative who will escort you to your motor coach.
- Round-trip ground transportation in special *Disney Cruise Line* motor coaches that include helpful videos on what to expect during your vacation.
- Baggage handling – from the plane, to the hotel, to the ship.
- *Provided you arrive during standard *Disney Cruise Line* airport pick-up operating hours.

DISNEY CRUISE VACATIONS PROTECTION PLAN

When planning a *Disney Cruise Line* vacation, the only thing you'll want to worry about is which suntan lotion to pack! Just as we have created a vacation that anticipates your every need, we have also planned for the unexpected by arranging the *Disney Cruise Vacations* Protection Plan.

It's designed to give you peace of mind by protecting your vacation investment, health and belongings. The Plan is a combination of travel insurance benefits and emergency hotline services created and provided by World Access Service Corporation. Below is a brief summary of what is included.

- Trip Cancellation/Interruption Protection* for any nonrefundable fees if you must cancel or interrupt your trip due to a covered medical condition or other specified cause.
- Travel Delay Protection* for reasonable, additional traveling expenses incurred by you up to \$500 due to a covered travel delay.
- Emergency Medical/Dental Benefits* if you suffer a covered accidental injury or illness while on your trip. You will be reimbursed up to \$10,000 for covered emergency medical and dental expenses.
- Emergency Medical Transportation to the nearest appropriate medical facility due to a covered illness or injury incurred by you for up to \$30,000.

Questions & Answers

Not sure what to pack? When is dinner? What is travel insurance anyway? We've found the questions (and the answers) that can help make your Disney cruise more carefree than you ever imagined. These are things you definitely want to know before you cruise.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME

"We've never been on a cruise. What do we need to know?"

First, relax — that's the point of your vacation. With *Disney Cruise Line*®, you'll find your ticketing, air transportation and transfers (if you choose the *Disney Cruise Vacations* Air Program), your stateroom accommodations, meals and entertainment on board have all been arranged. All you need to do is pack — and you don't need to bring much, because the atmosphere is casual and informal. And if necessary, you can purchase almost anything you need right on board.

"What's already included in the basic price?"

On board, your vacation package price includes almost everything — from your stateroom itself to snacks and ice cream, to breakfast, lunch and dinner every day. All the onboard programming and entertainment are included. While you're sailing, there are only a few things that will require an additional charge; for example: spa or salon visits, phone calls, video games, internet usage, soft drinks (other than those served with breakfast, lunch or dinner) and all alcoholic beverages. If you're not sure whether something is included, just call us or ask your Travel Agent.

"Should I buy travel insurance?"

Yes. We strongly recommend the purchase of *Disney Cruise Vacations* Protection Plan that provides baggage, trip cancellation/interruption and medical expense coverage for your vacation. Remember, most major medical policies do not provide coverage outside the U.S. See *Disney Cruise Vacations* Protection Plan section on page 65.

"What documentation do I need to bring?"

All U.S. and Canadian citizens must travel with proof of citizenship, which is a valid passport, or certified birth certificate (with official raised seal) and picture identification, or a certified naturalization certificate with a picture

identification. Acceptable forms of picture identification are state or provincial driver's license, or federal, state, province or local government photo I.D. card. Guests age 17 and under who are U.S. or Canadian citizens are only required to have proof of citizenship, excluding picture identification. These guidelines are based on U.S. government regulations which are subject to change at any time. It is the Guest's responsibility to check with their Travel Agent, government agencies, embassies or consulates prior to their vacation to ensure that they have proper documentation. Any Guest traveling without proper documentation will not be allowed to board the vessel and no refund of cruise fare will be issued.

New security guidelines require all adult Guests to show a picture I.D. to embark and disembark the ship in all ports, excluding *Castaway Cay*. Please be advised that anyone under the age of 18 wishing to go ashore unaccompanied will be required to have a consenting parent, guardian or other responsible adult with them at the gangway, to provide their signature as authorization.

"What if I'm not from the U.S. or Canada?"

All Guests who are not U.S. or Canadian citizens must have valid passports and necessary visas at time of embarkation. Travel documents required throughout the vacation are the responsibility of the Guest. Please consult with your Travel Agent, government agencies, embassies or consulates to determine necessary documentary requirements. For all non-U.S. citizens, including Canadian citizens, travel documents will be collected at check-in by a *Disney Cruise Line* representative and a receipt will be issued for presentation to Immigration Inspectors upon return to Port Canaveral. Any Guest traveling without proper documentation will not be allowed to board the vessel and no refund of cruise fare will be issued.

"Should I bring cash? Credit cards? Foreign currency?"

You won't really need cash on the Disney ships, but when you get to port, you'll probably want to have some money with you. In the Bahamas and the Caribbean, U.S. dollars and major credit cards are accepted almost everywhere. On board our ships, all transactions are in U.S. dollars. However, you won't need cash while we're at sea because *Disney Cruise Line* has a convenient "cash-free" system on board the ship. When you arrive at the *Walt Disney World*® Resort or at the *Disney Cruise Line* terminal at Port Canaveral, your signature will be requested for check-in. At this time you may also present a credit card (Visa®, MasterCard®, American Express®, Discover® Card, Diners Club®, Japanese Credit Bureau or The Disney Credit Card) which will give you charging privileges at both the *Walt Disney World* Resort and aboard the ship. Any purchases on the ship, including beverage services, spa, salon services, photography, medical and laundry services, purchases from our retail shops, gratuities and any item of service of a personal nature must be charged to your room. All charges must be settled before your Resort departure and debarkation from the ship by cash, travelers checks, Disney Dollars or by the credit cards mentioned above.



"What should I pack?"

Pack for comfort. Pack for style. The *Disney Cruise Line*® and *Walt Disney World*® Resort offer a casual, informal Resort atmosphere. During the summer months, lightweight shorts, slacks, sundresses, jeans and tops are all appropriate daytime attire in the Bahamas, the Caribbean and Central Florida.

In the winter, a light jacket, sweater and socks may be needed for cooler days and nights. Bring comfortable shoes — like boatshoes, sandals, or sneakers. And don't forget swimwear, sunglasses, a sunhat or visor and sunscreen — especially for the kids.

All cruises host a tropical deck party. You are invited to join in the fun by wearing festive island wear including colorful shirts, dresses, shorts or pants.

Other things to remember:

Bring your prescription medicines in their original containers. Don't forget an extra pair of glasses or contact lenses and your camera. A limited number of strollers are available for rental on board.

Of course, if you do forget something, odds are you can buy it on board or when we get to port.

"What do I bring for evenings?"

Let's talk about dinner clothes: We kindly request that no shorts, T-shirts or jeans be worn in any of our restaurants in the evening. Evening attire for the *Animator's Palate* and *Parrot Cay* dining rooms is casual. Button-down, open collar shirts or polo shirts and slacks are recommended for men. Pants and a blouse or a casual dress are appropriate for ladies. For *Lumière's* and *Triton's* restaurants and our adults-only alternative dinner restaurant, *Palo*, it is suggested that men wear jackets or a button-down shirt and tie and ladies wear dresses or pantsuits.

Aboard our seven-night cruises one dinner is semi-formal. Another evening requires more formal — or "black-tie-optional" — attire. Tuxedo rentals are available, in advance. Other themed evenings aboard our seven-night cruises that adults might want to pack for include salutes to the 1950s, 1970s and 1980s.

"Can I park at Port Canaveral?"

The parking facility is operated by the Canaveral Port Authority. Cash, MasterCard® and Visa® are the only acceptable forms of payment. Personal checks will not be accepted. Outdoor parking at the pier is \$24 for the three-night cruise, \$32 for the four-night cruise, and \$56 for the seven-night cruise. Rates are subject to change. Transfers are available at select *Walt Disney World* Resorts and Orlando International Airport. See page 65 for details.

AT SEA

"There's so much to do on the ship. How will I know what's going on when?"

Simple. A complete listing of all activities, adventures and entertainment will be available upon arrival in your stateroom. Guest Services and the programming counselors will be happy to assist you to develop a customized itinerary for your one-of-a-kind voyage.

"What's an assembly drill—do I have to go?"

Everyone on board the ship must participate in a compulsory safety drill before departure to comply with Coast Guard and International safety regulations. All passengers are required to attend.

"Will we get to see Disney characters on board?"

We thought you'd never ask! On board, the beloved Disney characters appear like magic in an array of different settings including lively stage shows, plenty of meet-and-greet and photo opportunities, and other special programs, especially in kids' areas at *Disney's Oceaneer Club* and on *Castaway Cay*. These are magical moments to remember forever — on *Disney Cruise Line*!



"Can all children participate in kids' programming?"

Supervised children's programs and activities are available on the ship from 9:00 a.m. to midnight for children ages 3-12. Children must be age 3 or older and potty trained in order to participate. Children must be able to interact comfortably within our counselor-to-child ratios of 1:15 (ages 3-4) and 1:25 (ages 5-12) and within our established age groupings of 3-4, 5-7, 8-9, 10-12. We are

unable to provide one-on-one care. A child who becomes disruptive within the group may be excluded from participation. Parents sign their children (ages 3-12) in and out of the programs. Events have been designed for teens as well, ages 13-17. Teens do not need to be signed in and out by parents. There is no additional charge for these planned events.

"Is there babysitting?"

Group babysitting is available for children 12 weeks to 3 years old in *Flounder's Reef Nursery*, located on Deck 5, Midship. Guests must sign up their children between 1:30 and



3:30 p.m. on embarkation day. There is a fee of \$6 per child per hour and \$5 per additional child per hour, 2-hour minimum required. The facility is open for select hours every day. Rates and times subject to change. Space is limited. Services are subject to availability.

"What if someone gets sick?"

For your convenience, a physician and nurse are on call 24 hours a day to provide basic medical services on every cruise. The physician and nurse are employed by a company independent from *Disney Cruise Line*. Standard prevailing fees will be charged for all physician and nurse services. If you require any prescription drug, be sure to bring an adequate supply in its original container. You should keep it in your carry-on luggage so it is easily at hand. *Please keep in mind that a child who shows symptoms of physical illness such as fever, vomiting, diarrhea, unexplained rashes or discharge from the nose or eyes may be excluded from participation in programming as well as from babysitting services in Flounder's Reef Nursery.*

DINING ON BOARD



"Is there something unique about dining on a Disney cruise?"

There sure is. In addition to famous Disney service, only *Disney Cruise Line*® features three spectacular main restaurants where dining is a total artistic experience: *Animator's Palate*, *Parrot Cay*, *Lumière's* (Disney Magic®), and *Triton's* (Disney Wonder®). Each evening, Guests rotate to one of the three restaurants and dine with the same table Guests and servers. You can also enjoy a variety of convenient meals and snacks poolside during the day or grab a bite for lunch at our tasty buffet restaurant.



"When is dinner?"

Each night, there are two separate seatings for dinner. When you book your vacation, be sure to inform your Travel Agent of whether you prefer an early or late seating. However, we regret that requested seating times cannot be guaranteed. Generally, adults without children will dine with other adults, while families dine with other families. Children's menus are available in the restaurants. In addition,

a dinner buffet will be offered for children who participate in the supervised programs during the dinner hour.

"What should I wear to dinner?"

For more specific suggestions, look under "What do I bring for evenings?" on page 67. The attire for *Animator's Palate* and *Parrot Cay* is casual. *Lumière's*, *Triton's* and *Palo* are more formal. We kindly request that no shorts, swimsuits, T-shirts or jeans be worn in any of our restaurants in the evening.

"Is there a romantic restaurant just for adults?"

The ship features an adults-only alternative restaurant called *Palo*. Dining hours for *Palo* are 6:00 p.m. - 11:00 p.m. Reservations are required, and taken (once on board) on a first-come first-served basis. *Palo* dining is limited to Guests 18 and older. There is a service charge of \$5 per Guest.

"What about breakfast and lunch?"

Breakfast and lunch are served in *Parrot Cay*, *Lumière's* and *Triton's*. And there's an indoor/outdoor buffet or casual poolside dining during breakfast and lunch.

"I'm on a special diet. Can I get it on board?"

Low-sodium meals, kosher meals and certain other special diet-restricted meals will be available. Dietary requests should be made at the time of booking. At the *Walt Disney World*® Resort, certain dietary needs may be accommodated at most full-service restaurants if requested 24 hours in advance.

"What is the policy on alcoholic beverages?"

The drinking age aboard ship is 21. Valid photo I.D. required. *Disney Cruise Line* reserves the right to refuse sale and/or service to anyone.

IN PORTS OF CALL

"Could the ports of call ever change unexpectedly?"

Very rarely. We only divert from our scheduled ports in cases of extreme weather (such as hurricanes) or during other circumstances that may challenge safety. When time permits, we always try to alert Guests to possible port changes prior to sailing.

"Can I bring visitors on board the ship?"

Sorry, but for security and safety reasons, we can't allow any visitors aboard.

"Are there limits to the amount of duty-free merchandise that I may bring into the U.S. from the Bahamas?"

You'll find lots of exciting duty-free shopping right on board in our shops as well as on shore in Nassau! Each U.S. resident aboard *Disney Cruise Line* returning from the Bahamas to the U.S. can bring back up to U.S. \$600 worth of duty-free merchandise (retail price) per Guest, provided at least \$200 of the allotment is purchased in the Bahamas. Each Guest 21 years of age and older is limited to 2 liters of alcohol, of which one 1 liter (33.8 ounces) must be produced in the Bahamas, 200 cigarettes and up to 100 cigars (excluding Cuban cigars). These limits are mandated by U.S. law and are subject to change.



"Are there limits to the amount of duty-free merchandise that I may bring into the U.S. from the Western Caribbean?"

The exemption for returning residents is \$400 per person. This amount may be grouped from the ship, Grand Cayman, or Cozumel. An additional \$200 is allowed from *Castaway Cay*, or a total of \$600 may be purchased in *Castaway Cay*. Each person 21 years of age or older may acquire 1 liter of alcohol; 100 cigars (excluding Cuban cigars) and 200 cigarettes duty-free. These limits are mandated by U.S. law and are subject to change.

"Are there limits to the amount of duty-free merchandise that I may bring into the U.S. from the Eastern Caribbean?"

There sure are. Each U.S. resident aboard *Disney Cruise Line* returning from the Caribbean to the U.S. can bring back up to \$1,200 per traveler. However, no more than \$400 in purchases can be made on board the ship and St. Maarten, while \$600 in purchases can be made on *Castaway Cay* alone. Or, the entire \$1,200 allowance may be used on purchases from St. Thomas alone. Each Guest 21 years of age or older is limited to: 5 liters of alcohol (only 1 liter can be acquired in St. Maarten or on the ship, with an additional 4 liters being exempt if purchased on St. Thomas, providing at least 1 liter is produced in the U.S. Virgin Islands); 5 cartons of cigarettes (only 1 carton can be acquired in St. Maarten or on the ship, with an additional 4 cartons being exempted if purchased on St. Thomas); and 100 cigars (excluding Cuban cigars). These limits are mandated by U.S. law and are subject to change.



SERVICES AND AMENITIES

"Can I call home from the ship?"

You can direct dial anywhere in the world right from your stateroom. Ship-to-shore rates apply and will be posted in your stateroom.

"Can I work away from home?" (Business Services)

Sure! You'll find a full range of business services at the *Walt Disney World* Resort and on board the ship available for an additional charge, including facsimile transmission, copies and AV equipment, when booked prior to debarkation. On the ship, ship-to-shore calling rates apply.

"Do I need an electric converter?"

All stateroom outlets are 110 V/60 Hz. Standard U.S. electrical appliances will work on board. There's a hair dryer in every stateroom bathroom.

"Is there a photographer on board?"

Don't feel pressured to keep your camera handy. Disney photographers wander the ship, putting your fun and excitement on film every day. You'll find their photos displayed for purchase at the photo shop.

"Is there onboard shopping?"

Lots! You'll have the opportunity to get exclusive *Disney Cruise Line* logo merchandise available on board and nowhere else. From beautiful clothes to towels to fine watches – this is your chance to keep the memories alive long after your cruise. You'll also find unique and exclusive Disney collectibles, and if someone forgot their toothpaste or bathing suit – we've got that too! You'll even find duty-free items right on board.

"What kind of services does the Spa offer?"

Disney Cruise Line offers an elaborate spa and fitness center at sea, with programs ranging from a simple facial to an indulgent array of full-body treatments. Spa, hair salon, massage and beauty shop charges are additional and may be charged to your room.

"Is there a laundry service?"

Laundry services are available at your *Walt Disney World* Resort and we suggest you take advantage of them if you have a lot of laundry to do during your stay. On board, laundry and dry-cleaning services (with stateroom pickup) are available for a charge. There is also a self-service Guest Laundry Room with coin-operated washers, dryers, detergent and ironing equipment. For safety reasons, irons or steamers may be used in the laundry room only.

"What about gratuities?"

We'll make it easy. Of course, you should never feel that a reward is automatically expected from you. But it is customary to give gratuities in recognition of service, which you will most likely be treated to in abundance aboard the ship. As a guideline, may we suggest the following:

For your convenience, a 15% gratuity is automatically added to bar, beverage, wine and deck service tabs. All gratuities can be charged to your room charge.

At the *Walt Disney World* Resort, 15% is the customary gratuity at restaurants and bars.

"Can we celebrate a special occasion?"

Whether you're celebrating an anniversary, birthday, honeymoon or other special occasion, please have your Travel Agent advise us of such occasions at least three weeks prior to departure. We will be happy to celebrate the occasion in our dining rooms. We offer a great variety of fun-filled baskets, merchandise and other goodies that will get your cruise off to a perfect start. A brochure listing all of these items can be included with your tickets.



TERMS & CONDITIONS

TICKET/CRUISE CONTRACT

Your ticket is the Cruise Contract which is enclosed in every document package. You will receive this package within 28 days of sailing. Carefully read your Cruise Contract, as it contains important terms and conditions which govern your cruise vacation. It must be signed by all Guests upon check-in at a *Walt Disney World* hotel or prior to embarkment at the *Disney Cruise Line* terminal. In the event of conflict between the terms and conditions contained in the Cruise Contract, these Terms and Conditions, the terms of any *Disney Cruise Line* advertisement or offer, and the oral or written representations of any *Disney Cruise Line* representative, the terms and conditions contained in the Cruise Contract shall control.

MINORS

Minors under the age of 18 not traveling with a parent or legal guardian must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 21 in the same stateroom. The parent or guardian of any minor not traveling with a parent or guardian must appoint an adult to have custody and control over the minor and to contract on their behalf in connection with the *Disney Cruise Line* vacation. An appointment form is enclosed in every document package and must be signed by parent or legal guardian prior to embarkment at the *Disney Cruise Line* Terminal. After 9:00 p.m. Boat Street and Route 66 are restricted to guests 18 years and older.

BAGGAGE, VALUABLES AND OTHER POSSESSIONS

Each Guest may bring aboard the ship a reasonable amount of clothing and personal effects without charge, not to exceed two bags per person. All Guest baggage must be stored in the Guest's stateroom and must be labeled with the *Disney Cruise Line* baggage tag. Dangerous or illegal articles such as weapons, explosives, oxygen, combustible substances or nonprescription controlled substances may not be brought to the *Walt Disney World* Resort or taken aboard the ship. Any such items shall be surrendered to the Master of the vessel at embarkment, and may be disposed of at the sole discretion of the Master. You should retain valuables such as cash, negotiable securities or other financial instruments, gold, silverware, jewelry, ornaments, works of art, photographic/video/audio equipment or supplies, laptop computers, cellular phones or other valuables in your personal control as *Disney Cruise Line* is not responsible for damage to or loss of these items.

DEPOSIT/PAYMENT INFORMATION

A deposit is required to confirm a reservation. Deposit amount will be determined at time of booking. Vacation and cruise packages are subject to cancellation if full deposit is not received in our office within the option period specified at time of booking. Final payment in the form of a check or credit card (*Visa*, *MasterCard*, *American Express*, *Discover*, *Card*, *Diners Club*, *Japanese Credit Bureau* or *The Disney Credit Card*) must be received at least 60 days prior to commencement of vacation package. Payment policy for group travel may vary. Please contact your Travel Agent for complete details.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

Cancellations must be made by telephone or in writing. Changes to the vacation commencement date or changes of Guest names will be considered cancellations. If the cancellation request is received 60 or more days prior to the vacation commencement date, 100% of the amount of the vacation price paid will be refunded. Cancellation requests received less than 60 days prior to the vacation commencement date will be assessed cancellation fees as follows, regardless of resale of stateroom or hotel room:

- 59-30 days prior to vacation commencement date, deposit amount per Guest
- 29-8 days prior to vacation commencement date, 50% of vacation price per Guest
- 7 days or less prior to vacation commencement date, no refund

No refunds will be made in the event of interruption or cancellation by the Guest after vacation commencement date. All appropriate refunds will be made directly to the Guest's credit card account or through the Guest's Travel Agent if the reservation is made through a Travel Agent. *Disney Cruise Vacations* is not responsible for the receipt of refund moneys by Guests from their Travel Agents. All travel documents including airline tickets must be returned before refund processing can begin. Certain Travel Agents may withhold an agency cancellation fee. For your peace of mind, we recommend the purchase of *Disney Cruise Vacations* Protection Plan.

Disney Cruise Line reserves the right to restrict any changes to a reservation. All changes are subject to availability. Please note that changes made to overall party size may result in a change to the rate.

SERVICE FEES

Any changes or cancellations to your cruise vacation or *Disney Cruise Line* air arrangements may be subject to additional fees including, but not limited to, service fees for documents. Please consult your Travel Agent or *Disney Cruise Vacations* for further details.

CLAIMS/NOTICE REQUIREMENTS/TIME LIMITS

No claim for delay, detention, personal injury, illness, emotional distress or death of a Guest, or for loss of or damage to any property of a Guest, may be brought against *Disney Cruise Line* unless written notice of such claim is provided to *Disney Cruise Line* within six (6) months after the date of the event upon which such claim is based (within 30 days after the termination of the cruise for a claim of property loss or damage); and no legal action may be brought against *Disney Cruise Line* for delay, detention, personal injury, illness, emotional distress or death of a Guest, or for loss of or damage to any property of a Guest, unless such legal action shall be commenced within one (1) year from the date of the event upon which such claim is based (within one (1) year after the termination of the cruise for a claim for property loss or damage), and legal process relating to such action is served on *Disney Cruise Line* within 120 days after filing, notwithstanding any provision of law of any state, territory, possession or country to the contrary. All legal actions arising out of or relating to a *Disney Cruise Line* vacation shall be brought, if at all, and maintained exclusively in and before any court of competent jurisdiction located in Brevard County, Florida, to the exclusion of courts located in any other country, state, territory or possession whatsoever. The only exception to this choice of forum is when and if *Disney Cruise Line* asserts a petition for exoneration from or limitation of liability. *Disney Cruise Line* liability for loss of or damage to property of any Guest is limited to the amount of \$300 per Guest per voyage,

unless upon embarkment a Guest declares the true value of the property in writing and pays 5% of the true value declared in excess of \$300 to *Disney Cruise Line*, in which case *Disney Cruise Line* liability will be limited to the true value declared not to exceed \$5,000. All settlements will be made based on actual cash value (replacement cost, less depreciation) up to the U.S. \$300/\$5,000 limits to *Disney Cruise Line* liability. Losses due to ordinary wear and tear, perils of the sea and acts of God are not reimbursable. *Disney Cruise Line* provides an in-room safe for your convenience; however, *Disney Cruise Line* shall in no event be liable for the loss of or damage to cash, negotiable securities, gold, silverware, jewelry, ornaments, works of art, photographic/video/audio equipment or supplies, laptop computers, cellular phones or other valuables unless the same have been deposited with the Master or other designated representative who issued a written receipt therefor. In the event of such deposit *Disney Cruise Line* liability for loss or damage thereof shall be limited as otherwise provided in this paragraph. Additional coverage may be purchased through the *Disney Cruise Vacations* Protection Plan which is provided through World Access Service Corporation.

WALT DISNEY WORLD RESORT CHECK-IN; SHIP EMBARKATION

Check-in time for *Walt Disney World* Resort hotels is normally after 4:00 p.m. For Guests arriving early, luggage arrangements can be made so Guests can visit Theme Parks or enjoy Resort amenities. It is recommended that necessary items including: proof of citizenship, valuables, medications, (in their original containers) and any other personal items or other items required for check-in or embarkment be packed in your day bag. *Walt Disney World* Resort check-out time is normally before 11:00 a.m. Ship's embarkment begins at 1:00 p.m. Guests are required to be on board the ship at least one hour before scheduled sailing time.

INCLUDED IN VACATION FARE

Cruise vacation fares include shipboard accommodations on a per-Guest basis, and all meals and entertainment as provided on board the vessel. For 7-Night Land and Sea Vacation Packages, the fare also includes resort accommodations, unlimited admission to all *Walt Disney World* Theme Parks and attractions, except where separately priced, and unlimited use of the *Walt Disney World* transportation system for the length of the Resort stay. For parties reserving a Category 1 or 2 suite for more than 5 Guests, an additional *Walt Disney World* Resort hotel room will be required at additional cost.

EXCLUDED FROM VACATION FARE

The Resort portion of the fare does not include meals, beverages, or any other item of a personal nature. The cruise portion of the fare does not include shore excursions (including excursions to St. John), sightseeing or meals ashore in the ports of call, gratuities, alcoholic beverages, soft drinks, bottled water, laundry or valet services, or any other items not specifically included. The fare also does not include airfare, ground or baggage transfers or Government Taxes and Fees, which consist of all taxes and fees imposed by U.S. and foreign governmental and quasi-governmental authorities, including without limitation U.S. Customs and Immigration fees, ship passengers international departure tax, airport passenger facility charge, flight segment fees, international arrival and departure taxes, and sales, use and excise taxes.

THEME PARK ADMISSION

For Guests who purchase a 7-Night Land and Sea Vacation Package, all applicable admission media will be provided at the front desk of their *Walt Disney World* Resort upon check-in. Admissions for the *Magic Kingdom* Park, *Epcot*, *Disney-MGM Studios*, *Disney's Animal Kingdom* Theme Park, *Blizzard Beach*, *Typhoon Lagoon*, *Downtown Disney's* *Pleasure Island*, and *DisneyQuest* Indoor Interactive Theme Park are valid from the day of Resort check-in through the day of Resort check-out. Admission media are not valid for special ticket events or separately priced attractions. The type and features of admission media are subject to change.

GROUP TRAVEL

Policies for group travel may vary. Please contact your Travel Agent for specifics.

CRUISE HEALTH CONSIDERATIONS

By boarding the *Disney Magic* or *Disney Wonder*, Guests represent themselves as physically and otherwise fit to travel. If you have a medical condition which requires you to take prescription medication or may require you to obtain medical care during the course of your cruise vacation, please consult with your personal physician prior to traveling. For your convenience, a physician and nurse are on call 24 hours a day on every cruise to provide basic medical services. The physician and nurse are not employees or representatives of *Disney Cruise Line* and will charge their prevailing fees for services provided at your request. Decisions regarding medical care and treatment are personal and confidential and as such are strictly between the Guest and physician and nurse. *Disney Cruise Line* is not liable for any death, personal injury, illness or emotional distress caused by reason of any treatment, diagnosis, advice, examination, prescription or other service provided by such medical personnel or by the failure of such medical personnel to provide any treatment, diagnosis, advice, examination, prescription or other service. The ship's Master has the right at any time to require any Guest to disembark for medical reasons, and compliance is mandatory.

HOLIDAY SHOPPING

Retail establishments in destination ports may be closed for certain holidays.

RIGHT TO CHANGE ITINERARY/DETENTION

Disney Cruise Line may in its sole discretion and without prior notice change, substitute, postpone, cancel or deviate from any scheduled sailing, itinerary or call at any port, and may substitute another vessel for the ship, and shall not be liable for any loss or damage incurred by a Guest as a result of any such change, substitution, postponement, cancellation or deviation. The Guest shall pay any and all expenses incurred if a Guest is detained on board ship or elsewhere at any stage of a voyage because of quarantine, port regulations, prevailing applicable law, illness or other cause.

PASSENGER SERVICES ACT

The United States Passenger Services Act requires *Disney Cruise Line* to embark and disembark its Guests at the same U.S. port. Therefore, we regret that we are unable to allow Guests to board in our first Western Caribbean port of call, Key West.

PETS

No animals are allowed on board the ships except for service animals.

REFUSAL OF PASSAGE

Disney Cruise Line may refuse to transport or may disembark at any port any Guest who may be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease, ill health or whose presence in the opinion of the Master may be detrimental to the comfort or safety of other Guests or the crew, or who, in the Master's opinion, might be excluded from landing at destination by Immigration or other governmental authorities. In such cases the Guest shall not be entitled to any refund of fare or compensation whatsoever.

Women who have entered their 24th week of pregnancy as of their embarkation date will be refused passage due to safety concerns. Neither a physician's medical statement nor a waiver of liability will be accepted. In addition, *Disney Cruise Line* cannot be held responsible or liable for any complications relating to pregnancy at any stage. Infants under 12 weeks old will not be allowed to travel aboard *Disney Cruise Line* ships.

STATEROOM OCCUPANCY

Occupancy of stateroom on board the ships is limited to the number of berths in that stateroom. *Disney Cruise Line* reserves the right to limit the number of berths and single staterooms sold.

SHIPS' REGISTRY

Ships' Registry: The Bahamas.

TRANSFER INFORMATION

For Guests who purchase the *Disney Cruise Vacations* Air Program, ground and baggage transfers are included in your vacation package to and from the *Walt Disney World* Resort (if 7-Night Land and Sea Vacation has been purchased), Port Canaveral and a Central Florida airport.

Guests who make their own air arrangements may purchase ground and baggage transfers from *Disney Cruise Vacations*, which transfers include transportation between the *Walt Disney World* Resort (if 7-Night Land and Sea Vacation has been purchased), Port Canaveral and a Central Florida airport.

Please note that those Guests who do not purchase the *Disney Cruise Vacations* Air Program or ground transfers from *Disney Cruise Vacations* are responsible for all ground and baggage transportation to and from the airport, Port Canaveral and their *Walt Disney World* hotel, if applicable. We recommend that you allow a minimum of four hours at the beginning and end of your cruise for travel time, customs clearances and security checks at Port Canaveral and the airport.

TRAVEL AGENTS

We invite you to visit your local Travel Agent to make your *Disney Cruise Vacations* reservation. Travel agencies are not owned or operated by *Disney Cruise Vacations* and act on the Guest's behalf in arranging vacations.

TERMS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Disney Cruise Vacations reserves the right to change all prices and other terms and conditions which appear in this brochure without prior notice. Price changes will not affect bookings with paid deposit or timely final payment, except where the increase results from increases in Government Taxes and Fees.

SINGLE OCCUPANCY RATES

Single occupancy fares are available upon request, subject to availability. Guests booking categories 4 through 12 will be charged 175% of the package price. Guests booking categories 1 through 3 will be charged 200% of the package price.

SMOKING/NON-SMOKING POLICY

For the comfort and enjoyment of our Guests, *Disney Magic* and *Disney Wonder* have been primarily designated as non-smoking ships. However, we recognize that some of our Guests smoke. Therefore, to provide an onboard atmosphere that also satisfies smokers, we have designated smoking areas in many of our lounges and on all open-air decks and private verandahs. *Disney Cruise Line* requests that all Guests observe the non-smoking areas and refrain from smoking pipes and/or cigars in any of the public areas. These requests are made to provide a comfortable shipboard living atmosphere for everyone.

Magical Cruise Company, Limited (doing business as *Disney Cruise Line*—Registered Office: 3 Queen Caroline Street, Hammersmith, London, W6 9PE, England), DCL Island Development, Ltd., and *Disney Cruise Vacations* are each separate entities and are indirect subsidiaries of The Walt Disney Company. *Disney Cruise Line* is the operator of the *Disney Magic* and *Disney Wonder* ships. DCL Island Development, Ltd. is the operator and provider of facilities on *Disney's Castaway Cay*. *Disney Cruise Vacations* acts as the sales agent for *Disney Cruise Line* in booking or confirming arrangements for passage on the *Disney Magic* and the *Disney Wonder*. In booking or confirming arrangements for: (a) air or ground transportation or travel; (b) shore excursions; (c) tours; (d) restaurants; or (e) other similar activities or services, *Disney Cruise Vacations* acts as sales agent for others who own, furnish, operate, conduct or provide such services and activities. In booking or confirming arrangements for theme parks, entertainment and other services at the *Walt Disney World* Resort, as well as hotels, *Disney Cruise Vacations* acts as a purchaser/reseller of such accommodations, services and activities. *Disney Cruise Vacations* shall not be liable or responsible in any way for any act or omission arising from or in connection with such accommodations, services or activities. The liability of the provider of such accommodations, services and activities may be governed by and determined in accordance with limitations contained in applicable tariffs, laws, conventions or contracts governing a Guest's relationship with such provider.

Disney Cruise Line acts as sales agent for others who own, furnish, operate, conduct or provide shore excursions, tours, or similar activities or services, and shall not be liable or responsible in any way for any death, personal injury, illness or emotional distress occasioned by any Guest, or for loss of or damage to any Guest's property, which arises by reason of any act or omission by providers of air or ground transportation, shore excursions, tours, restaurants, hotels, theme parks or other similar services or activities. All concessionaires and their employees operating on the *Disney Magic* and the *Disney Wonder*, including without limitation the health club, fitness center, spa, hair salon and laundry, are independent contractors and *Disney Cruise Line* is not responsible for any such parties' acts or omissions in providing any goods or services to Guests.

GUESTS WITH DISABILITIES

WHEELCHAIR-ACCESSIBLE STATEROOMS

Disney Cruise Line offers accessible staterooms and suites, equipped for Guests with disabilities. Features include: ramped bathroom thresholds, open bed frames, added phones in the bathroom/nightstand, bathroom and shower handrails, fold-down shower seats, hand-held shower heads, lowered towel and closet bars, and emergency call buttons. All staterooms are non-smoking.

Note: Guests requiring a wheelchair throughout their cruise must make provisions for the use of that wheelchair prior to the cruise.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Transfer tiers are provided at one of our feature pools. Sand wheelchairs are available at *Castaway Cay*. Wheelchair-accessible

restrooms are available in the shipboard common areas. Assistive Listening Systems are available in the main theaters and show rooms. Closed captioning is available for stateroom televisions and selected onboard video monitors. American Sign Language interpretation is available for live performances on designated cruise dates. Stateroom Communication Kits containing door knock and phone alerts, phone amplifier, bed shaker notification, a strobe light smoke detector, and a Text Typewriter (TTY) are available.

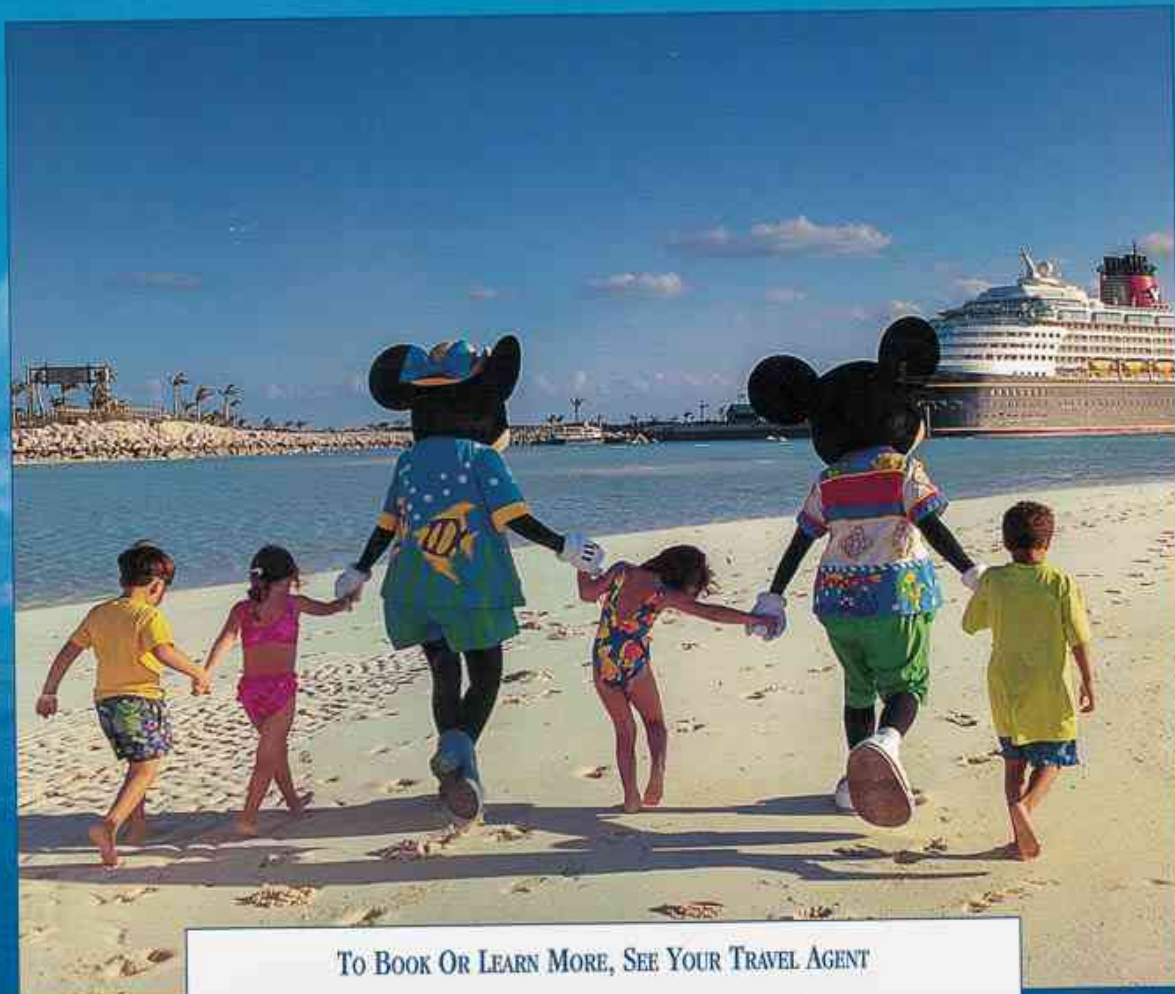
