



# Debarkation Day: Know Before You Go

## Breakfast

Breakfast will be served on the last day of your cruise before you debark the ship. Here are the things you'll need to know.

### Reserved Breakfast Time

On the final morning of the cruise, Guests will enjoy a farewell breakfast in one of our themed restaurants. Breakfast will be scheduled using assigned, staggered seating times to promote physical distancing. Locations and dining times can be found on the [Disney Cruise Line Navigator app](#). As an alternate option, [Cove Café](#) will be open for specialty coffees from 6:30 AM to 8:30 AM. Remember to bring your luggage with you, as you'll be asked to debark the ship following breakfast.

## Getting Off the Ship

Here's what you need to know as you debark the ship on the last morning of your cruise.

### Debarkation Time

Debarkation times are based on your dining time and will be available via the [Disney Cruise Line Navigator app](#).

### Face Coverings

All Guests (ages 2 and up, including those who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19) are required to wear appropriate [face coverings](#) indoors, except when in their staterooms or actively eating or drinking (while stationary and maintaining an appropriate physical distance). Face coverings are not required for Guests outdoors while on board the ship

and at Disney Castaway Cay. Face coverings may be required in ports of call based on local government requirements.

All face coverings should fully cover an individual's nose and mouth and allow the Guest to remain hands-free; fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face; be secured with ties or ear loops; and be made of 2 layers of breathable material, either disposable or reusable, that is not elastic in nature, such as spandex and elastane. At this time based on guidance from health authorities, neck gaiters, open-chin triangle bandanas and face coverings containing valves, mesh material or holes of any kind are not acceptable face coverings. Costume masks are not considered appropriate and are prohibited from being worn.

### **Picking Up Your Luggage**

You may take your luggage with you when you debark the ship or place your luggage outside your stateroom on the last night of your voyage between 8:30 PM and 10:30 PM for delivery to the ship's terminal. Color-coded luggage tags featuring Disney characters are provided to assist you in locating your luggage in the terminal. You will need to write your stateroom number, name, address and number of bags on these tags and attach the tags to your luggage. Luggage will be placed in colored zones, according to stateroom number, for easy recognition in the port terminal on debarkation day.

### **US Customs and Border Protection**

After collecting your luggage, all Guests in your party must present themselves for inspection to US Customs and Border Protection. Porters will be available in the terminal to assist you as you proceed through Customs.

### **Express Walk-Off**

Guests debarking the ship have the option to take their luggage off the ship once the ship has been cleared by the local authorities. Guests will be responsible for their own luggage; no assistance will be provided by onboard Crew or shoreside representatives. If you'd like to take advantage of Express Walk-Off, you should be ready to debark the ship as early as 7:00 AM, and be listening for announcements as to when the ship has been cleared by local authorities.



## Exiting the Port

Learn about what you need to know when leaving the cruise terminal.

### Transportation

- **To Orlando International Airport:** Continuous motorcoach transfers to the airport will be available upon arrival at Port Canaveral for all Guests who have purchased ground transfers through Disney Cruise Line. If you've purchased transfers, you will need to claim your luggage in the terminal building and proceed through US Customs and Border Protection, after which time you will board the bus with your luggage to the Orlando International Airport. Airline check-in will be done at the airport. You will need to present your Key to the World Card to board the motorcoach.
- **To Walt Disney World Resort:** Guests continuing their vacation with transfers to the Walt Disney World Resort hotels should debark the ship no later than 7:30 AM, as the motorcoach departs promptly at 9:00 AM.
