  - A professionally administered or observed negative antigen test taken outside of Canada no more than one day before your scheduled flight or entry to Canada by land or water.

• A valid negative molecular test taken outside of Canada within

72 hours of your scheduled flight's departure time to Canada or your entry to Canada by land or water. Guests who have recovered from COVID-19 recently may submit a previous positive molecular test result taken at least 10

calendar days and no more than 180 calendar days before

entering Canada. Counting starts the day after your test. Guests must not be experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms. For sailings longer than 72 hours, Guests will need to submit this information during their voyage or on arrival day. 


