Debarkation Day: Know Before You Go

Discover what you'll need to do on the final morning of your cruise—as you make your way off the ship.

Breakfast

Breakfast will be served on the last day of your cruise before you debark the ship. Here are the things you'll need to know.

Reserved Breakfast Time

On the final morning of the cruise, Guests will enjoy a farewell breakfast in one of our themed restaurants. Locations and dining times can be found on the Disney Cruise Line Navigator app. As an alternate option, Cove Café will be open for specialty coffees from 6:30 AM to 8:30 AM. Remember to bring your luggage with you, as you'll be asked to debark the ship following breakfast.

Getting Off the Ship

Here's what you need to know as you debark the ship on the last morning of your cruise.

Debarkation Day COVID-19 Antigen Testing

All unvaccinated Guests on 5-night and longer sailings are required to take a COVID-19 antigen test (paid for by Disney Cruise Line) on the ship the day before debarking.

Post-Cruise Testing Service for Guests Returning Home

Some Guests may be required by their home country or state public health authorities to show proof of a negative COVID-19 antigen or PCR test result before returning home by air. Inspire Diagnostics, Disney Cruise Line's third-party testing provider, offers this optional service for \$98.33 per person for PCR testing, and \$41.40 per person for antigen testing. Guests are responsible for knowing what type of test their home country/state requires (PCR or antigen), and the window of time in which it must be conducted. Testing is conducted at the terminal after disembarking the ship. Results take approximately 45 minutes to 2 hours, depending on the type of test. This service is available for cruises beginning on or after January 31, 2022. For more information and to book an appointment, visit the Safe Passage website.

Back-to-Back Sailings

Unvaccinated Guests on consecutive back-to-back sailings are required to submit the results of only one pre-trip COVID-19 test taken between 3 days and 24 hours before their first sail date. The test should be a NAAT test, rapid PCR test or lab-based PCR test. All Guests on consecutive, back-to-back sailings, regardless of age and vaccination status, will be required to undergo a COVID-19 test (paid for by Disney Cruise Line and administered by Inspire Diagnostics) at the terminal after debarking the ship following their first cruise and before reboarding the ship for their second cruise. Vaccinated Guests must upload their proof of vaccination to the Safe Passage website for each voyage.

Debarkation Time

Debarkation times are based on your dining time and will be available via the Disney Cruise Line Navigator app. Guests do not need to join our virtual queue to debark the ship.

Express Walk-Off

Guests debarking the ship have the option to take their luggage off the ship once the ship has been cleared by the local authorities. Guests will be responsible for their own luggage; no assistance will be provided by onboard Crew or shoreside representatives. If you'd like to take advantage of Express Walk-Off, you should be ready to debark the ship as early as 7:00 AM, and be listening for announcements as to when the ship has been cleared by local authorities.

Picking Up Your Luggage

You may take your luggage with you when you debark the ship or place your luggage outside your stateroom on the last night of your voyage between 8:30 PM and 10:30 PM for delivery to the ship's terminal. Color-coded luggage tags featuring Disney characters are provided to assist you in locating your luggage in the terminal. You will need to write your stateroom number, name, address and number of bags on these tags and attach the tags to your luggage. Luggage will be placed in colored zones, according to stateroom number, for easy recognition in the port terminal on debarkation day.

US Customs and Border Protection

After collecting your luggage, all Guests in your party must present themselves for inspection to US Customs and Border Protection. Porters will be available in the terminal to assist you as you proceed through Customs.

Face Coverings

All Guests (ages 2 and up, including those who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19) are required to wear appropriate face coverings while in the cruise terminal.

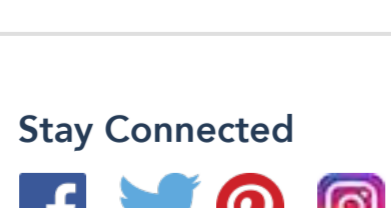

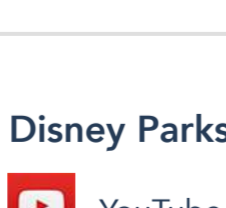

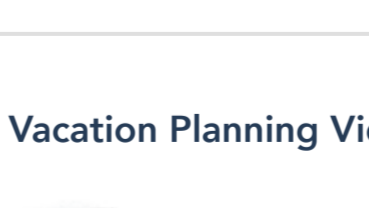
