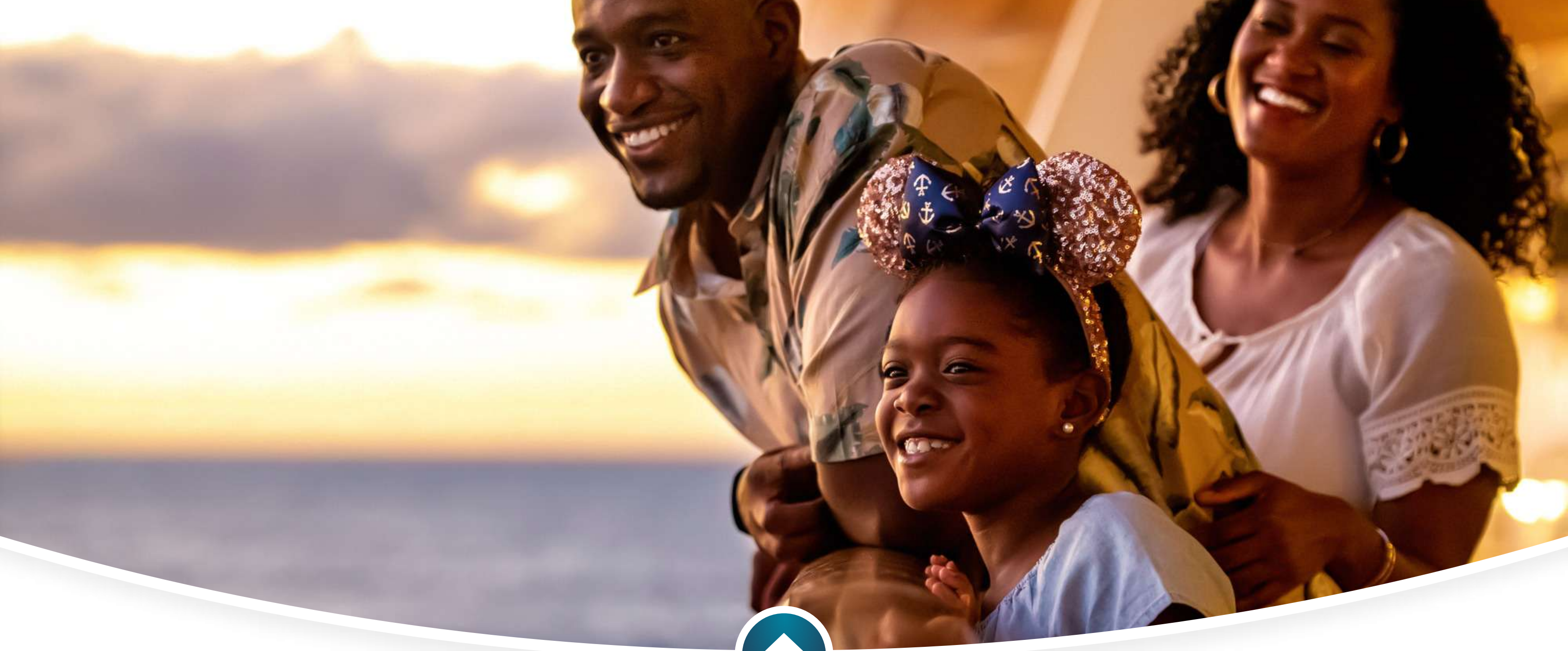

Pre-Cruise Checklist: Know Before You Go

ONCE YOU'VE BOOKED YOUR CRUISE

- Download the [Disney Cruise Line Navigator app](#).
- Reserve premium activities—adult-exclusive dining, Port Adventures and more—[online via My Reservations](#), or through the [Disney Cruise Line Navigator app](#).

15 DAYS BEFORE SETTING SAIL

- Every Guest 18 years of age and older must individually create an account associated with their reservation on the [Safe Passage website](#) by Inspire Diagnostics and upload their proof of vaccination or COVID-19 test results. Additionally, a parent or legal guardian will need to use their own account to provide this information on behalf of all minors.
- Guests choosing to order a testing kit from Inspire Diagnostics should order one so that they have it in hand at least 4 days before setting sail
- Complete [Online Check-In](#). Be sure to select a Port Arrival time.

BETWEEN 3 DAYS AND 24 HOURS BEFORE SETTING SAIL

- Guests who are not vaccine-eligible because of age must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test result (paid for by the Guest) taken between 3 days and 24 hours before their sail date. Guests ages 4 and under must complete the testing requirements. The test should be a NAAT test, rapid PCR test or lab-based PCR test. Rapid antigen tests are not accepted. Disney Cruise Line has secured a special rate of \$98.33 per PCR test (which includes a 3.5% processing fee) through our third-party vendor, Inspire Diagnostics. Guests may also obtain their test from any independent testing supplier. - Upload your pre-trip COVID-19 PCR test results or proof of vaccination to the [Safe Passage website](#) by Inspire Diagnostics and ensure your account indicates those in your travel party are clear to arrive at the port. A parent or legal guardian must use their own account to submit test results or proof of vaccinations on behalf of minors.
- In some cases, people who have recently recovered from COVID-19 may still test positive for the SARS-CoV-2 virus. If Guests have tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 within 11 to 90 days of their sail date, they may qualify to be considered as "90-Day-Recovered." With the appropriate documentation and subsequent approval, Guests considered "90-Day-Recovered" are not required to participate in COVID-19 testing during the Pre-Sail, Embarkation or Disembarkation phases of their voyage. EMBARKATION DAY

All Guests (adults and children, regardless of age) must:

- Complete the pre-trip Health Questionnaire (available via the Disney Cruise Line Navigator app and online).
- All Guests, regardless of age and vaccination status, are required to take a COVID-19 test (paid for by Disney Cruise Line and administered by Inspire Diagnostics) at the terminal before boarding.
- Bring proof of your COVID-19 results and vaccination status along with your Port Arrival form with QR codes.
- Please be aware that Guests will not be permitted at the terminal or in parking areas before their scheduled arrival time. Guests who arrive early will be asked to return at their scheduled arrival time, and Guests arriving after their scheduled time may be delayed and asked to wait behind those arriving at their scheduled time.

BACK-TO-BACK SAILINGS

All Guests on consecutive, back-to-back sailings, regardless of age and vaccination status, will be required to undergo a COVID-19 test administered by Inspire Diagnostics at the terminal after debarking the ship following their first cruise and before reboarding the ship for their second cruise.

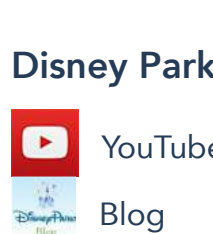
