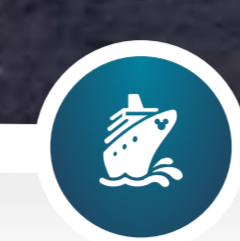

## Embarkation Day: Know Before You Go

Discover what you'll need to do when you arrive at the cruise terminal—as you make your way onto the ship.

### Port Arrival

Here's what you need to know as you arrive at the cruise terminal.

#### Arrive On Time

To reduce the time needed to board the ship, Guests should complete their [Online Check-In](#) and select a port arrival time at home.

**Please note: All Guests—including Platinum Members—are required to select a port arrival time before making their way to the cruise terminal.** Please be aware that Guests will not be permitted at the terminal or in parking areas before their scheduled arrival time. Guests who arrive early will be asked to return at their scheduled arrival time, and Guests arriving after their scheduled time may be delayed and asked to wait behind those arriving at their scheduled time.

For the health and well-being of everyone, Guests are not permitted at the terminal or in parking areas before their scheduled port arrival time and will be turned away if arriving early.

#### QR Code and Proof of Vaccination

Please be prepared to present proof of vaccination and the Disney Cruise Line QR code found on your Port Arrival Form when you reach the terminal. Guests should expect to show this code multiple times throughout the embarkation process. Proof of vaccination should document:

- Full name, matching the name on your Disney Cruise Line reservation
- Date of birth
- Name of first vaccine and the date of your first dose
- Name of second vaccine and the date of your second dose

If your information is listed in multiple documents, please bring them all with you to the port.

#### Embarkation COVID-19 Testing

All Guests, regardless of age and vaccination status, are required to take a COVID-19 test administered by Inspire Diagnostics at the terminal before boarding. This will be the second of 2 tests required for Guests ages 4 and under. Guests with positive COVID-19 test results are required to undergo a second confirmatory test. Guests with confirmed positive test results—as well as those sharing the same stateroom and other close contacts—will be denied boarding. Embarkation testing for Guests who are not vaccine-eligible because of age (4 and under) will continue to be paid for by Disney Cruise Line. Embarkation testing for fully vaccinated Guests will be paid for by Disney Cruise Line up through June 6, 2022.

For sailings departing US and Canadian ports on or after **June 7, 2022**, fully vaccinated Guests who upload their pre-trip test results to the Safe Passage website by midnight prior to embarkation day will be exempt from embarkation testing. All other fully vaccinated Guests must be tested at the terminal before boarding and will be charged for the cost of the test. The cost of embarkation tests for fully vaccinated Guests will be \$74.00 (USD) plus tax for the initial antigen test, and, if needed, \$125.00 (USD) plus tax for a confirmatory PCR test, charged at the time of service. For Canada sailings, the cost of embarkation tests for fully vaccinated Guests will be \$95.00 (CAD) plus GST for the initial antigen test, and, if needed, \$160.00 (CAD) plus GST for a confirmatory PCR test, charged at the time of service. Completing pre-trip testing prior to embarkation day enhances the efficiency of boarding the ship and confirms you are negative for COVID-19 prior to traveling to the terminal.

#### Testing Locations at Each Port

- **Cape Canaveral:** Testing is conducted at the parking garage. Guests who drove to the terminal will stay inside their cars until their testing is completed and they are cleared to park their car and board the ship. A testing site at the garage is available for Guests who have been dropped off at the terminal.
- **Miami:** Testing is conducted inside the terminal.
- **Vancouver:** After arriving at the Canada Place Cruise Terminal and dropping off your luggage, Disney Cruise Line staff will direct you to the testing location at the Fairmont Waterfront Hotel. Assistance will be available for Guests with limited mobility. Once you complete the COVID-19 test and receive your results, you will be directed back to the cruise terminal to embark the ship.

The COVID-19 test is a self-swab test. A parent or guardian should assist children who cannot perform this function on their own. Professionals will be on hand to help guide you through the process.

Test results typically take approximately 30 minutes to complete but could take longer. We recommend that you plan accordingly and consider bringing snacks, water or activities to make your wait more comfortable. A Cast Member will provide you with a telephone number to call should you have any questions while awaiting test results.

When test results are available, you will be notified by email. Next, log in to the [Safe Passage website](#) to determine whether your party is clear to embark. Once cleared, Guests should make their way to the cruise terminal. Guests receiving positive COVID-19 test results, including all members in their travel party, will not be permitted to board the ship.

### Inside the Cruise Terminal

Here's what you need to know as you make your way into the cruise terminal.

#### Luggage

We strongly recommend all bags and luggage be checked in. Guests 21 years of age and older are allowed to bring a maximum of 2 bottles of wine or one 6-pack of beer in their carry-on luggage. Additional alcohol beyond this limit or discovered in checked luggage will be discarded. Bringing liquor and spirits (including powdered alcohol) on board is prohibited.

#### Embarkation Day Health Questionnaire

All Guests are required to complete a health questionnaire prior to arriving at the terminal. The form can be found on the Disney Cruise Line Navigator App on Embarkation Day. In addition, an email will be sent out to all Guests with a link where Guests can fill out the questionnaire. A secondary screening by a health care professional may be required based on the answers provided in the health questionnaire.

#### Stateroom and Mandatory Emergency Drill

Your stateroom will be ready at 3:00 PM. Before heading there, you will need to take part in our Mandatory Emergency Drill. Using the [Disney Cruise Line Navigator App](#), everyone assigned to your stateroom must go to their assigned Assembly Station and check in before setting sail. In addition, a Safety Information video will be broadcast on monitors throughout the ship, on stateroom televisions and will also be available to view via the [Disney Cruise Line Navigator app](#).
